Introduction

The starting point for this family history is that described as Pedigree "C" in Chapter 20 of Audley Pedigrees by A. L. Reade. That document should be read in conjunction with this family history narrative, and Chapter 20 can be found in the 'Published Information' section of the Audley Family History Website, under the heading 'Audley Pedigrees'.

Whilst most of their known family history is spent in Liverpool, Lancashire, this branch of the Audley Family moved from Shotwick in Cheshire to Liverpool in Lancashire around 1800. Four Brothers left Shotwick in Cheshire around 1800 and moved to Liverpool in Lancashire. These four Brothers are the founding members of Audley Families 'AA', 'AB', 'AC' & 'AD'. The Family 'A' narrative contains the information about the family while they were living in Cheshire.

It should be noted that while the family was living in both Shotwick & Neston, Cheshire, their surname was recorded as "Allday".

{AC1} WILLIAM AUDLEY (aka) ALLDAY, of Toxteth Park, Liverpool, Book Keeper, and latterly a Victualler; Baptised 20th October 1777 (as William Allday) at Shotwick, Cheshire; Died on the 7th May 1833, aged 57. Married on the 20th October 1805, at St. Peter's, Liverpool (License granted from Diocese of Chester dated on the 19th Oct 1805) to ALICE DWERRYHOUSE (a Roman Catholic), dau. of..... Dwerryhouse. The Marriage record indicates he was a Book Keeper, and that Alice was a minor and consent was given by her Uncle. She was Born in Liverpool about 1785; perhaps had a Beer-house at 26 Parliament Street. In 1834, living as a Widow in Upper Mann Street on 31st March 1851; Died on the 4th April 1851, after 14 days of fever, at 2 Court, Lower Mann St., Liverpool, aged 67. She was Buried on the 8th April 1851 at St Michael Liverpool. William and Alice Audley had issue,

On his certificate of service he is recorded as William Hadley alias Audley (Prior to William's service aboard HMS Revenge, the ship participated in the Battle of Trafalgar 21st October 1805) Of, 2, Northumberland Place, Toxteth Park, Liverpool, a Shipwright Journeyman, in 1841. Of Beresford Road, Liverpool. A Shipwright in 1846 (from Baptism of {AC6} Stanley Audley). He died on the 15th February 1857. He Married 1st DIANA JONES dau. of......Jones, of Liverpool, on the 23rd July 1833, at St. Thomas's, Park Lane, Liverpool. She died without issue on the 9th March 1841, aged 30 years, in Portland Street, Vauxhall Road, Liverpool, of Consumption, aged 30; and was Buried on the 12th March 1841, at St. Michael's, Upper Pitt Street, Liverpool. She was buried in grave No 308 in St Michaels Churchyard having paid £4 for the grave to Liverpool Corporation on 10th March 1841. He Married 2nd. on the 13th March 1842, at St. Thomas's, Park Lane, Liverpool, ELIZABETH HARVEY, Widow of Harvey, and Dau of Samuel Ogden, a Hatter; who was born in Caernarvon Wales about 1805/06. She was of 4 Liverpool Buildings, Bebington, Cheshire, in 1861; of 18 Wye Street, a Lodging House Keeper, Tranmere in 1871 and by her, who Died on the 6th February 1884, aged 83, Of senility, at 109 Peel St., Tranmere, Birkenhead, had issue,
 - 1. {AC5} **JOHN WILLIAM AUDLEY**, born on the 26th March. 1843, at Anne's Terrace, Beresford Road, Toxteth Park; Baptised on the 16th Apr 1843 Saint Peter's Church, Liverpool; of Norfolk Street, Liverpool. Of 4, Liverpool Buildings, Bebington, in 1861; Died unmarried in 1864, in Sierra Leone, where he was Buried.
 - 2. {AC6} STANLEY AUDLEY, of Liverpool, and afterwards of Lower Tranmere, Birkenhead, a Boiler Maker; Born on the 31st December 1845, at 1 Anne's Terrace, Beresford Road, Toxteth Park. Baptised at St Thomas, Liverpool, on the 21st January 1846. Of 4 Liverpool Buildings, Bebington, in 1861; of 18 Wye Street, Tranmere, a Plater, in 1871 of 86 St Paul's Road, Tranmere, an Iron Ship Builder in 1891; of 21 Brougham Street, Birkenhead, a Boiler Maker & Iron Ship Builder in 1901. Died on the 2nd February 1911; Buried at Bebington Cemetery, Cheshire. Married on the 25th December 1874, at St. John the Baptist, Toxteth Park, to Mary JANE MARSH, Dau. of John Marsh, of Runcorn, Cheshire, a Master

In the 1841 Census of England, A. L. Reade has an Alice Audley, age not given, described 'Lady Unmarried' at Morris Court, Jamaica Street, Liverpool. Having looked at a Census image, the Alice Audley that is aged 50 and occupation is two words the first word is either Lady or Self. Do not believe the second word is unmarried. The combined words could possibly be 'Lady Annuit'. As the ages in the 1841 Census tend to be rounded to 5 years. It is proposed that this reference to Alice Audley in the 1841 Census actually refers to the Wife of {AC1} William Audley. Gores Directory 1841, 1843 and 1845 do not contain a Jamaica Street in Liverpool.

Mariner. At time of their Marriage both were living at 78, Park Street, Liverpool. Mary Jane was Born on the 29th August 1853 in Ireland. She was a General Shopkeeper in 1891. Of 21, Brougham Street, Tranmere, Birkenhead, Cheshire, a Fitter Engineer, at Soap Factory in 1911. Of 228 New Chester Road, Rock Ferry, Birkenhead, Cheshire, A Marine Engineer in 1921. Kelly's (Gores) Street Directory records him as; of 398 Old Chester Road Rock Ferry, a Marine Engineer from 1925 to 1928; During World War I he was a British Mercantile Marine, Seaman. He was awarded the 'British War' and the Mercantile Medals. During his seagoing career in the 1920's he is believed to have worked for the Liverpool based Shipping Companies of the Blue Funnel Line, Booth Steamship Co, Lamport & Holt Line, The White Star Line, and also Furness Withy & Co sailing between England and Eastern Seaboard of North and South America. In crew records he is described as a second engineer, whilst on passenger lists he is described as a Marine Engineer. (Comment: For more details of his shipping career see the Passenger& Crew List section in the 'Supporting Information'.) Of 2 Roxborough Avenue, Higher Tranmere, a Marine Engineer from 1929 to 1932; of Mark Rake, Bromborough, a Shop Keeper from 1933 to 1939. Of 105, Mark Rake, Bebington, Cheshire, an Engine Fitter, his Wife is described as a Housewife and Shop Keeper in 1939. After 1939 he is no longer recorded in the street directories and his Wife is recorded as a Shop Keeper in Mark Rake Bromborough. He Died 13th July 1948 at the Northern Hospital, Liverpool aged 68. His home address is recorded as 404 Old Chester Road, Birkenhead and occupation Marine Engineer Retired. His Death was registered by his Brother in Law, R Jones, address 400 Old Chester Road, Birkenhead at Liverpool South Registration District. He Married on the 29th January 1920, at St. Luke's, Lower Tranmere, to ETHEL JONES Dau of Henry Jones, of Prenton, Cheshire, born 21st March 1893. She is recorded in Kelly's (Gores) Street Directory as living at Mark Rake, Bromborough a Shop Keeper from 1940 to 1946; and at 404 Old Chester Road Rock Ferry from 1949 to 1960. On the 31st October 1953, Ethel is recorded in UK Incoming Passenger Lists, arriving in Liverpool on board the "Empress of Australia", from Montreal, Canada. She died aged 67, Q2 in 1960, in the Wirral. They had issue,
 - (AC9) DOREEN AUDLEY born on the 14th March 1922 at 'The Nursing Home' 3 Rock Lane East, Rock Ferry . On her Birth Certificate her parents address is given as 228, New Chester Road, Tranmere (The Lord Raglan Hotel). Of 105 Mark Rake, Bromborough, an Insurance Clerk, in 1939. She enrolled in Women's Auxiliary Air Force on 16th April 1943 in Gloucester, Service No #484116. She served at various UK locations including RAF Lossiemouth and RAF Tilstock, Whitchurch Heath, Shropshire,where she met her future Husband. From 1944 to 1946 she was based in Egypt (LAC W) until her return to the UK. She was released from service on the 4th April 1947. After her marriage she lived in Balham, London and they moved to Brentwood Essex in 1955. She Died on the 21st December 2015, aged 93 in Danbury Essex. She Married on the 19th June 1947 at St Barnabas Church, Bromborough, Cheshire, to MAURICE CLAUDE COUGHLAN. On their marriage certificate she gives her address as 105, Mark Rake, Bromborough and he gives his address as 46, Thorne Road, London SW8. He was born on the 26th August 1917 and died on the 13th September 1979 at Havering. They had issue, one son and one daughter

She was Born on the 13th September 1891 and she Died Q4 in 1955, in the Wirral. They had issue.

He Served during World War II in the Royal Corps of Signals as a Sergeant, Service Number #2343630, and He was awarded Campaign Medals of: 1939-1945 War Medal and 1939-1945 Star, also was awarded the British Empire Medal for Gallantry, London Gazette Ref No 2720 on the 15th June 1943., and he Died November 1999, aged 79 years, at East Staffs. Married Q3 in 1949, to MORFYDD ANN LEWIS, at Birkenhead, who was Born on the 17th July 1919, and Died Q2 May 1993, aged 73 years, at Birkenhead. He Died in November 1999, aged 79 years at East Staffordshire.

Of 15, Brougham Street, Tranmere, Birkenhead, Cheshire a Boiler Maker, Plater & Riveter, in 1921. He was of 61, Downham Road, Birkenhead C B, Cheshire, a Shipyard Boiler Maker at Cammell Laird Ship Builders at Birkenhead, in 1939. He never married. He Died Q4 in 1978, at Birkenhead.
- (5) {AC13} **SARAH ELIZABETH AUDLEY**, born on the 19th September 1875; of 86 St Paul's Road, Tranmere, an Apprentice Dressmaker in 1891. Of 21, Brougham Street, Birkenhead when she Married on the 12th December 1895, at St. Paul's Church, Tranmere,, to GEORGE WILLIAMS, of Rock Ferry, Cheshire, a Publican, of 53, Claughton Road, Birkenhead, and Son of Nathaniel Williams, a Wheelwright, who was born 1873, and had issue. Her younger Sister {AC14} Margaret witnessed their marriage.
- (6) {AC14} MARGARET OGDEN AUDLEY, born on the 9th May 1877, and Christened on the 20th July 1877 at St Paul's, Tranmere. Of 86 St Paul's Road, Tranmere, in 1891; of 21 Brougham Street, Birkenhead, in 1901. Of, 15, Brougham Street, Tranmere, Birkenhead, (as Margaret Ogden Ashton) in 1911. Of 15Brougham Street, Tranmere, Birkenhead, Cheshire, a Widow (as Margaret Ogden Ashton), in 1921. Of 61, Downham Road, Birkenhead C B, Cheshire in 1939. She Married on the 26th December 1906, at St. Paul's, Tranmere, to ENOCH ASHTON, of Tranmere, and Son of Thomas Ashton. He was Born on the 18th February 1879, and Died on the 17th July 1916, (Buried at Bebington Cemetery). By him she had issue. She died Q1 in 1956, aged 78 years, at Birkenhead.

Married on the 5th May 1839, at St Thomas's, Park Lane, Liverpool, to FRANCES (FANNY), HOWELL dau. of James Howell, of HM. Customs, of Sparling Street, Liverpool. She was Born about 1817, in Liverpool; Died on the 2nd January 1871, aged 54, at 35 Wolfe Street, Liverpool, and was Buried on the 4th January 1871 at Toxteth Park Cemetery, Smithdown Road, Liverpool. Of, 80, Earle Street, Earlestown, a Wagon Maker in 1881, 1891 & 1901, a Shipwright. Of 80 Earle Street, Earlestown a Joiner at Railway Wagon Works in 1911. Of 80, Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, a retired Wagon Builder, in 1921. He Died in 1937. He married on the 9th March 1874, at St· Nathaniel's Windsor, Liverpool, to ELIZA ANN PARKINSON who was Born on the 19th July 1851, Daughter of John Parkinson, of Harding Street, Liverpool. She was of 80, Earle Street, Newton-le-Willows U D Lancashire in 1939. She Died in 1944, they had issue.
 - (1) {AC23} **WILLIAM ELLIS AUDLEY**, born on the 5th August 1879; Died Q4 in 1880, Death registered at Warrington; Buried at Emmanuel Church, Wargrave, Newton le Willows, Lancashire.
 - (2) {AC24} **CHARLES PARKINSON AUDLEY**, born on the 30th March 1891; of 80 Earle Street Earlestown in 1891, 1901 & 1911. A Printer's Machinist, in 1911. At one time of 11 Collingwood Road, Earlestown, Lancashire. During World War I he served in the British Army, as a Gunner, Service No #171262. He Enlisted on the 9th December 1915, into the Royal Regiment of Artillery, (Royal Garrison Artillery RGA), aged 24 years & 9 months, at that time he was still living at 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, and his Occupation was listed as a 'Turret Hand', and his Wife Eliza was recorded as 'next of kin'. He appears to have commenced his combative Army service on the 10th July 1917, at the No 2 Depot at Gosport, Hampshire, and posted to the 67th Siege Battery, Royal Garrison Artillery. (*The Royal Garrison Artillery RGA, also had a Depot at Seaforth, near Liverpool.*) On the 24th July 1917, he appears to have been attached to 476th Siege Battery whilst still at No 2 Depot, Gosport. He was Injured and appears to have become an official casualty in France on the 10th May 1918. On the 22nd November 1918, under the authority of the Officer

Commanding 67th Siege Battery sent on leave to the UK to the Royal Garrison Artillery - RGA, No 1 Depot, at Fort Burgoyne, Dover. On the 27th January 1919, he was posted to Prees Heath, near Whitchurch, Shropshire, into the Royal Artillery Section, 3rd Echelon, G.H.Q, of British Expeditionary Force. On the 2nd March 1919 he was Transferred to Class 'Z' Army Reserve, and Demobilised. His home address was recorded as 16, Patterson Street, Earlestown, Lancs. (He was awarded Campaign Medals of: Victory Medal and British War Medal, which was a normal event for all Armed Forces Service personnel during WW1). Of 11 Collingwood Road, Newton Le Willows, Lancashire, a Letterpress Printer, in 1921. He was of 75, Victoria Road, Newton-le-Willows, a Letter Press Printer in 1939.In March 1952 according to his Daughter {AC111} Jean's Marriage Certificate; Also His Occupation was a Cashier at a Confectionery Manufacturers. He Died 3rd April 1966 and was Cremated on the 7th April 1966, at Wilford Hill Crematorium in Nottingham. At the time of his death he was living at 35 Abingdon Drive, Ruddington, Nottingham. He married to ADA EMILY EVANS, who was Born on the 22nd February 1892, at Warrington, Daughter of William Henry Evans, of Earlestown, on the 25th November 1918, at Baptist Chapel, Earlestown. She Died 14th December 1981 and was Cremated on the 18th December 1981 at Wilford Hill Crematorium Nottingham. At the time of her death she was living with her daughter Jean at 8 Melrose Gardens, Wilford Hill, West Bridgford. Nottingham. They had issue

- a) {AC111} **JEAN AUDLEY**, born 1925-1926 at St Helens.(based on her marriage record) Married by Licence according to Particular Baptists Rites on the 22nd March 1952, at the Baptist Chapel, Crown Street, Earlestown, Newton-in-Makerfield, (Known as Newton-le-Willows.) to KENNETH MORGAN. At the time of her Marriage, aged 26, a Secondary Modern School Teacher, she was living at 75, Victoria Road, Newton-le-Willows. Her Husband aged 34 a Junior School Teacher had been previously married to Sylvia Morgan (nee George), from whom he had obtained a Divorce, and was then living at 12 Larkdale Street, Nottingham. (Comment: Her Birth registration has not been identified.)
- b) {AC25} **IRENE AUDLEY**, born on the 8th December 1926 at Warrington, and she Died on the 3rd November 1929; Buried at Emmanuel Church, Wargrave, Newton le Willows, Lancashire.
- (1) {AC26} **FRANCES ALICE AUDLEY**, born on the 31st December 1874, and Baptised on the 14th March 1875 at St Clement, Toxteth. Living at 9, Isis Street, at the time of her Baptism. Died Q2 in 1879³, Death registered at Warrington; Buried at Emmanuel Church, Wargrave, Newton le Willows, Lancashire.
- (2) {AC27} **ADA LOUISE AUDLEY**, born on the 16th June 1877; of 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, in 1881, & 1891, (a Scholar), in 1901 & 1911. Married on the 26th March 1914, at St. John's, Earlestown, to HENRY SAUNDERS, of 70 Earle Street, Earlestown, and had issue. She Died Q3 in 1962, aged 85 years, at Warrington.
- (3) {AC28} **ANN ELIZABETH AUDLEY**, born on the 27th January 1882. Of 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, a Scholar in 1891; of Haydock Lodge, Haydock a Domestic Servant *(Scullery Maid)* in 1901. Of 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, in 1911. Died on the 16th April 1913, unmarried, and was Buried at Newton-in-Makerfield Cemetery, Lancashire.
- (4) {AC65} **ALICE EMMA AUDLEY**, born on the 8th August 1884. Of 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, a Scholar in 1891; of Haydock Lodge, Haydock a Domestic Servant *(Lobby Maid)* in 1901. Of 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, in 1911. Married on the 4th November 1915, at St. John's, Earlestown, to HARRY BENNETT, of 13 Collingwood Road, Earlestown, and had issue
- (5) {AC29} **AMY BLANCHE AUDLEY**, born on the 8th February 1887; Baptised on the 20th March 1887, in Newton in Makerfield. Living at 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, in 1891, 1901 & 1911, Described as a Machine Feeder in Printing Works in 1901 and, a Printer's Machine Feeder at

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- Printing & Stationery Works in 1911. Of 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, a Lady Clerk at Printers, in 1921. She was of 80 Earle Street, Newton-Le-Willows U D, Lancashire in 1939, (as Amy B Pickham), her Husband was described as a Railway Wagon Builder. Married on the 24th September 1921, at St John's, Earlestown, to CHARLES EDWARD PECKHAM. He was Born on the 17th August 1890. They had issue. *(Comment:- The 1939 Register Surname spelling does not agree with their Official GRO Index Marriage record) She Died Q1 in 1959, aged 71 years, at Newton, Lancashire.
- (6) {AC30} AGNES EMILY AUDLEY, born on the 17th November 1888. Living at 80 Earle Street, Earlestown, in 1891, 1901 & 1911. Described as a Printer's Machine Feeder at a Printing & Stationery Works in 1911. Of 80, Earle Street, Earlestown, Lancashire, a Printers Feeder in 1921. She was of 80 Earle Street, Newton-le-Willows a Printers Feeder in 1939, and Died aged 95, Q2 in 1983, at Halton, Lancashire.
- 5 {AC31} **WILLIAM AUDLEY**, of Liverpool, Born on the 17th June 1853, and Baptised on the 26th August 1855, at St Peter Liverpool. At the time of his Baptism was living in Toxteth Park. Of 21 Frank Street, a Scholar, in 1861. He Died on the 26th January 1877, Unmarried; and living at 44, Wolfe Street, Liverpool, when he was Buried on the 31st January 1877 at Toxteth Park Cemetery, Smithdown Road, Liverpool.
- {AC32} FREDERICK JAMES AUDLEY, born on the 14th May 1862, at 21 Frank St Liverpool. 6. Baptised on the 7th June 1875 at Holy Trinity, Toxteth Park, Liverpool. Living at 35, Wolfe Street, Liverpool, at the time of Baptism. Of 35 Wolfe Street, Toxteth Park, Liverpool a Scholar in 1871. Of 45 South Chester Street, in 1881 a Shipwright Apprentice, he was one of several lodgers including Charles Audley {AC18}. He served in the 4th Regiment of Foot, which became the King's Own Royal Regiment (Lancaster). Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp, Aldershot, a Private in the Kings Own Regiment, in 1901. Served in the 4th King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment, seeing service in Malta, Hong Kong, Singapore and India. Afterwards in a canteen at Aldershot. Stationed in Newcastle upon Tyne in 1907. He was discharged on the 21st February 1908 after 25 years service on a Pension. He was granted permission to reside in South India (Calcutta), in the Nilgiri Hills, where he became a Superintendent at the Malabar Timber Yard's, in India. He died on the 16th August 1910 aged 48 and was buried on the 17th August 1910 at St Mark's Cemetery in Madras. He Married on the 24th October 1886, at the Rotunda Church Farnham, Surrey, to BLANCHE ROSSITER, who was Born 1868/9 in Devon? She was the Daughter of.Rossiter, of London. She married second on the 7th November 1911 to CHARLES STANLEY RICHARDSON at the Emmanuel Baptist Church, Rangoon, Burma. She died on the 12th August 1915, her age being stated as 39, and was Buried at Holy Trinity Cathedral, Rangoon, Burma. Frederick and Blanche had issue. (Comment: It is speculated that the Wife of {AC32} Blanche Audley nee Rossiter returned to England arriving on 6th May 1910 at London aboard the Bibby Line "SS Warwickshire" but on the passenger list she is recorded as' Mrs Audley' and appears to be travelling alone. This Mrs Audley appears to have boarded the "SS Warwickshire" at Rangoon. There is an inconsistency in the information about {AC32} in that the information above says that he retired to reside in South India (Calcutta) in the Nilgiri Hills. Calcutta is in North India not South India. If one lives in Calcutta in North India it is appears sensible to travel back to England via Rangoon, Burma however if one is living in Southern India, the Nilgiri Hills, Malabar, or Madras, it would seem more sensible to pick up a boat from Colombo in Ceylon that had sailed from Rangoon in Burma (as the" SS Warwickshire" did) rather than travel to pick up the boat. If this person was the Wife of {AC32} then she arrived in England 3 months before her First Husband had Died in India. The Wife of {AC32} is linked to Rangoon, Burma, in that she married her Second Husband there.
 - (1) {AC33} VIOLET BLANCHE AUDLEY born on the 20th April 1887, at Earlestown, Lancashire. Baptised on the 25th December 1887. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot in 1901, and Died on the 14th December 1962. Married⁴ on the 8th March 1906 at Kalimpong, Darjeeling, West Bengal, India, to WILLIAM STENNETT. He was Born 1874 and Died on the 28th August 1924.Army Service Records have their Marriage registered in 1906 at Darjeeling, West Bengal.


The IGI has 2 dates for the Death of Violet Blanche Audley; one reference has her date of Death as 8th March 1906. The other has her date of Death as 14th December 1962, with the Marriage to William Stennett taking place on the 8th March 1906, at Kalimpong, West Bengal, India.

{AC34} CHARLES FREDERICK AUDLEY, born on the 25th March 1889, Dublin, Ireland, and was Baptised in Hong Kong, on the 23rd April 1898. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot in 1901. He joined the Royal Lancaster Regiment Service No 8108 on 9th January 1904 at Calcutta with the rank of 'Boy'. In his Attestation papers he gives his parents as Frederick James Audley and Blanche Audley of Fort William, Calcutta. He became a Private in the British Army on 9th March 1907. He was detained and sentenced to imprisonment with hard labour for 112 days for committing a 'Civil Offence' on 11th December 1907, and discharged from the British Army on the 9th April 1908 for misconduct. His service record for this period survives. A Charles Audley born in 1889 admitted himself to the Portsmouth, Hampshire Workhouse from 13th to the 19th April 1909. (Based on the year of Birth this person in the Portsmouth Workhouse is likely to be {AC34}). During World War I, He served in the British Army, Royal Irish Rifles, as a Private, Service No #11186, and also 10th London Regiment, Private, Service No #424881 ((Hackney)(Originally Paddington Rifles). (Whilst an element of uncertainty exists because of others similarly named, it is predicted that this World War I service record relates to this particular 'Charles Audley'). He was of 6, Lindale Gardens South, Blackpool C B, Lancashire, a Watchman in 1939 (but see comment below). He Died Q1 in 1976, at Blackpool. He Married to ALICE BUTTERWORTH Q2 in 1915, at Old Fylde Register Office or Registrar Attended at Blackpool, where their Marriage was registered. She was Born on the 23rd September 1884. She was of 101 Highfield Road, Blackpool, Lancashire, in 1921. On the 1921 Census of England record a note has been added 'Husband in Military Hospital. She Died Q1 in 1958, at Blackpool. They had issue.

(Comment: In the General Registry Office Marriage Record for Alice Butterworth, her Husband's surname was recorded as either **Audley** or **Johnston**. It is not known why this event is recorded in this way but was significant enough to have been recorded at the time of their Marriage.

His Birth is registered in the GRO Indexes of Ireland as Frederick Audley.

The image below has been taken from the 1939 Registers and is the entry for {AC34 Charles Frederick Audley. Following advice from others it is believed that the green text indicates that sometime before the 2nd November 1959. He changed his name to J. C. F. Martin, although he appears to have died as Charles Frederick Audley.)



- a.) {AC113} **DOROTHY BUTTERWORTH (AUDLEY)** She is the Daughter of Alice Butterworth, the Wife of {AC34} Charles Frederick Audley, from her 1st Marriage. She was Born either Q4 in 1902 as Dorothy Butterworth or Q2 in 1904 at Bury 8c.610. Mother's Maiden name is not recorded. She was of 101 Highfield Road, Blackpool, Lancashire, recorded as Dorothy Butterworth Audley, a Boot and Shoe Dealers Assistant, in 1921. (Comment: It is because she is recorded in the 1921 Census of England with the surname Audley that she has been recorded here.) She Married Q3 in 1932 to Richard D Leadbetter at Fylde, Lancashire..
- b.) {AC110} **JOSEPHINE AUDLEY**, born on the 11th April 1918, at Fylde, Lancashire. Of 101 Highfield Road, Blackpool, Lancashire, in 1921. She was of 6, Lindale Gardens South, Blackpool C B, Lancashire, a Textile Machinist in1939. Married to ERIC WITT, Q1 in 1944, at Blackpool.
- (3) {AC35} **LOUISE AUDLEY**, born on the 23rd January 1891 at the Curragh Camp, County Kildare, Ireland, and Baptised in Hong Kong, on the 23rd April 1898. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot in 1901. She Married on the 20th January 1910, to ROBERT GORDON, according to 'Family Information' the married and lived in Calcutta, India.

Comment: It should be noted that in her birth registration at Newbridge, Naas, County, Kildare, the field for the child's name is left blank, and the sex of the child is recorded as female. It is concluded that this is the Birth registration of {AC35} from the names of the parents recorded on the birth registration, the sex of the child and the age of {AC35} in the 1901 Census of England. It should also be noted that her birth registration is one of 10 birth registrations on a page. Of those 10 birth registrations 7 took place at the Curragh camp and all 10 Fathers appear from their 'Rank' appear to have been serving in the Army. Of the 10 births registered on the page the child's name is only recorded for three of the children.

- (4) {AC36} ETHEL AUDLEY born on the 31st July 1892 Aldershot Hants, and Baptised in Hong Kong, on the 23rd April 1898. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot, in 1901. Married on the 7th September 1913 at St Mary's R. C. Church, Rangoon, Burma, to THOMAS ROBERT SALMON.. She returned (as Ethel Salmon) from Rangoon Burma arriving in London as a 1st Class passenger aboard the "SS Kemmendine" on the 12th May 1930. She arrived in London with her Husband, Thomas Robert Salmon; her Daughter, Barbara Salmon, and Son, Dennis Salmon.
- (5) {AC37} **BLANCHE AUDLEY** born Q3 in 1894 Portsmouth, Hants, and Baptised in Hong Kong, on the 23rd April 1898. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot, in 1901. Married on the 14th March 1912, aged 18 years at the Baptist Church, Howrah, Calcutta, Bengal, India, to WILLIAM MITCHELL aged 33 years, of New Zealand, and had issue. It is believed that subsequent to and presumably after the Death of William Mitchell a Frederick Mitchell, who was a Brother of William, was also married to Blanche.
- {AC38} WILLIAM DUNDONALD AUDLEY, born on the 19th November 1895, at Malta, and (6) baptised in Hong Kong, on 23rd April 1898. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot, in 1901. (During World War I it is speculated that he served in the 38th Dogras Infantry Regiment, in the British Indian Army, as a 2nd Lieutenant. (See also {AC40} WALTER DONALD AUDLEY his Younger Brother regards this service record).) While in India he worked as Shipping Co-ordinator for the Socony (Standard) Vacuum Oil. He returned to England from Bombay, India, on board the "M.V. Circassia" of the Anchor Steamship Line as a 1st Class passenger on the 26th February 1949. After leaving India, they lived in Durban, South Africa and he Died in 1979 in Durban South Africa. He married on the 26th January 1919, at St John's Church, Calcutta, West Bengal, India, to CONSTANCE ELIZABETH HACKETT, the daughter of a Military Surgeon. She was born in 1897.On the 17th May 1929; they are recorded having arrived from Rangoon, Burma, in London. In 1933 Elizabeth returned to Bedford, England, with her two Sons {AC74} Derek and {AC87} William for them to attend school. She arrived on the 17th April 1933 on board the "SS Mantua" of the P & O Line as a 1st Class passenger. On the passenger list she gave her address as c/o Thomas Cooks, Berkeley Street, London. She was of 10, 11, & 12, Leinster Gardens, Paddington, London, of Independent means in 1939. On the 16th June 1946, Constance is recorded as having arrived from Montreal, Canada, in Liverpool. He to Liverpool, England from Bombay, India, on board the "M.V. Circassia" of the Anchor Steamship Line as a 1st Class passenger on the 26th February 1949. They visited England travelling from Durban, South Africa, arriving by ship in Plymouth, England, on the 16th July 1954. Later on in 1954, they returned from New York, America, sailing on the 'RMS Queen Mary' to Southampton, England arriving there on the 8th November 1954. She died in 1978 in Durban, South Africa They had issue
 - A) {AC74} **DEREK DUNDONALD AUDLEY** born 8th June 1921, from his WW2 service record, in Calcutta, West Bengal, India. He returned from Bombay, in India to England on the 17th April 1933 on board the "SS Mantua" of the P & O Line as a 1st Class passenger. He was educated at Bedford School for Boys, and upon graduation (14th September 1939), Emigrated to Salisbury, Rhodesia, and worked for the British Foreign Service. At the outbreak of WWII enlisted in the Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve. A Sergeant (Pilot) in the 266 (Rhodesia) Squadron, Royal Air Force, Volunteer Reserve, (Service Number #778599). He was killed in a training accident on the 24th October 1942, aged 21, in Sturminster, Dorset, whilst serving with the Royal Air Force. Buried at Warmwell (Holy Trinity) Churchyard, He was awarded posthumously Campaign Medals of: 1939-1945 War

- Medal and 1939-1945 Star. (Comment: For more information on Derek Dundonald Audley's RAF Career, see separate biography page on this Website).
- B) {AC87} WILLIAM HAROLD AUDLEY ('aka' as Robert or Bob) Born in Secunderbad, India, on the 3rd April 1923. He returned from Bombay, in India to England on 17th April 1933 on board the "SS Mantua" of the P & O Line as a 1st Class passenger. He was educated at Bedford School for Boys, and upon graduation emigrated (14th September 1939) to Salisbury, Rhodesia. He attended the Bulawayo School of Mines, and worked in the gold mines. At the outbreak of WWII enlisted in the British Army and served in Burma & Malaya. At the end of hostilities he returned to Rhodesia, and subsequently Emigrated to Tulsa, Oklahoma, USA, and studied Petroleum Engineering at the University of Tulsa. He travelled throughout the United States in conjunction with his work. He died on the 28th November 1998 at Tulsa, Oklahoma. He married FÉE NELGIS DE CHEMINAIS on the 5th June 1947. She was Born on the 19th December 1922 in Bombay, India, the daughter of Francois & Marjorie Constance Wilshire de Cheminais.. She died on the 16th September 2015. They had issue:

 - 3) {AC91} **STUART ROBERT AUDLEY** born on the 19th December 1980, at Tulsa, Oklahoma, and currently lives in Gainsville, Florida, USA. Married ???? ???? and had issue
 - i) {AC69} **ROBERT ARDEN AUDLEY** born on the July 28th 2012 in Gainsville Florida, USA.
 - b) {AC92} **ANN ELISSA AUDLEY** born on the 19th December 1955, at Tulsa, Oklahoma. Married on the 18th November 1978, to JAMES MICHAEL RALSTON, he was born on the 27th September 1954 and the Marriage was dissolved on the 1st June 2007. They have one Daughter and one Son.
- (7) {AC114} **ALICE L AUDLEY** born in 1897 at Malta. It is not known whether or not she is a twin to {AC39}, but the Birth of {AC39} and her Birth are registered on the same page. She does not appear with the family in the 1901 Census of England, therefore it is presumed that she died prior to 1901. In the index for the Armed Forces Birth's, Marriages and Deaths, both she and all the other children of {AC32} Frederick James Audley are registered as Birth's in the 4th Regiment of Foot.
- (8) {AC39} FREDERICK JAMES AUDLEY, born on the 17th August 1897, at Malta, and Baptised in Hong Kong, on the 23rd April 1898. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot, in 1901. He was of 25, Nightingale Terrace, Woolwich, London, an Explosive Worker; Shell Fitter in 1939 He Died and was Buried aged 86 on the 2nd December 1983, at Greenwich, London, England. He married on the 24th November 1921 at the Sacred Heart R.C. Cathedral, Mandalay, Burma, to IVY WINIFRED SECHUNA. She was born on the 26th October 1901; she Died on the 18th March 1985, and was Buried in Greenwich, London, on the 27th March 1985.

- A. {AC2} **DENIS JAMES AUDLEY.** He was Born on the 27th May 1922 and was Baptised in 1922 at Insein, St Lazarus Church, Bengal. Of 25, Nightingale Terrace, Woolwich, London, in 1939. He was a member of No 51 Squadron Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve. (Service Number #1337107) He was killed when the Halifax II Bomber in which he was a Gunner was shot down over the North Sea on the 30th July 1943. His name is recorded on Panel 141 at the Commonwealth War Graves Commission, Runnymede Memorial in Surrey. He married BERYL BRINTON Q4 in 1942 at Wellington, following his Death she remarried as Beryl Audley, Q1 in 1945 to Alvan J Schmedlin, at Wellington, Shropshire.
- B. {AC55} **NOEL FREDERICK AUDLEY** He was Born 22nd December 1926 in either Karachi or Lahore, India,. Of The Vicarage, The Moor, Cranbrook Kent in 1939. In the 1939 Registers he is described as 'at School; presumably he has been evacuated from London where his parents were living. He Died aged 72 years, in November 1998, at Stockport. He Married 1st MARIE PRISCILLA SIMS, Q1 in 1945 in Salisbury. They had issue. She married secondly, as Marie P Audley, in Q3 1977 at Tonbridge to Peter R Waddell. He Married 2nd to VANESSA J DONNISON Birth surname WEBB, in Q3 in 1978, at Alcester, Warwickshire. She was born Vanessa J Webb and had previously married a David J Donnison Q2 in 1972. Subsequent to her marriage with Noel Audley, Vanessa married for a 3rd time, Q1 in 1983, as Vanessa J Audley to a Paul R Gibson, Warwick & Leamington. Noel also Married for a 3rd time to LYNN SALLY MOMTAHAN Q2 in 1983, at Stockport, Cheshire.
 - {AC56} MARIA B AUDLEY The daughter of {AC55} by his first Wife. She was Born Q1 1946 at Woolwich and married Q3 1966 in Bromley to ROGER MORCUMB.
 - II) {AC58} **SUZANNE D AUDLEY** The daughter of {AC55} by his first Wife. She was Born Q3 in 1947 at Woolwich and married 1st Q2 in 1967 in Bromley to BRIAN D COLE. She married 2nd (as Suzanne D Cole) to ANDREW M PARSONS, Q2 in 1973, at Brentwood, Middlesex. She married 3rd CHRISTOPHER J PATRICK, Q2 in 1978, at Merton, London. By her 1st Husband she had issue
 - III) {AC62} **DENNIS C AUDLEY** The son of {AC55} by his first Wife. He was Born Q2 in 1949, at Woolwich and married Q1 in 1975 at Chiltern and Beaconsfield to ISABEL-MARY RUTHERFORD, who was Born Q4 in 1953, at Willesden, London. They had issue.
 - a) {AC67} **MATHEW RUTHERFORD AUDLEY** He was Born Q4 in 1975 at Aylesbury.
 - b) {AC68} **DANIEL NOEL AUDLEY** He was Born Q1 in 1977 at Aylesbury.
 - c) {AC107} **THOMAS PAUL AUDLEY** He was Born Q2 in 1979 at Aylesbury.
 - d) {AC108} **ANNE-MARIE LOUISE AUDLEY** She was Born Q1 in 1982 at Aylesbury. She married in 2011 to JONATHAN WISH, at St Mary's, Weston Turville, Aylesbury. They had issue.
 - e) {AC109} **ALICE MAIMIE AUDLEY** She was Born in October 1990 at Aylesbury Vale.
- (9) {AC40} **WALTER DONALD AUDLEY**, born on the 14th May 1900, and Baptised Aldershot on the 10th October 1900. Of Malplaquet Barracks, North Camp Aldershot, in 1901. He was educated at the Lawrence Memorial Royal Military School, Lovedale, South India. During World War I, He probably enlisted in the Army with the 7th (Queens Own) Hussars as a Mounted Policeman, in

1917. He rose from a Private, Service No #35947, (11th Indian Cavalry Brigade Mesopotamia Cavalry Division, Service No 35947) to the rank of Major, Service No # P17260, and saw active service in Mesopotamia, Persia, Iraq and India. (It is speculated that he served in the British Army, Indian Defence Force, as a Corporal, Service No #3562). (It is further speculated that he also served in the 38th Dogras Infantry Regiment, in the British Indian Army, as a 2nd Lieutenant). (See also {AC38} WILLIAM DUNDONALD AUDLEY his Older Brother regards this service record).) In the 1921 Census of England he is described as a Lance Corporal in the Army Military Police, stationed at, GHQ British Army in Constantinople. (Comment: Constantinople is known today as Istanbul, in Turkey.). In the 1921 Census his recorded age suggests he was Born in May 1898, whereas he was actually born in May 1900; perhaps he gave an incorrect age on enlistment into the British Army during WW1. In 1926 he is described as an Engineer in India. In 1928 he is described as a Commercial Traveller in Blackpool, England. Incoming Passenger Lists show having arrived with his Wife, and Daughter {AC93} Barbara aged 1 year, from Bombay, India, in London on the 27th October 1927, and also arriving from Duala, Cameroon, in North West Africa. He is listed as sailing from Liverpool to Bombay India in 1931 with his Wife and two eldest children. Born on the 22nd December 1864, at 125 Park Street, Toxteth Park, Liverpool, and Baptised on the 25th January 1866, at St. John the Baptist Church, Toxteth Park. Of 25 The Elms Toxteth Park, in 1871; of 27 Higher Lane Walton On Hill in 1881 a Commercial Clerk; of Moss Lane, Broadfield, Orrell & Ford, a Chemical Broker, in 1891; of 29 Trafalgar Road, Birkdale, an Export Beer Bottler in 1901. Of 29, Trafalgar Road, Birkdale, Lancashire, a Home & Export Beer Bottler, in 1911. Of 1 Lulworth Road, Birkdale, Lancashire, a Retired Whiskey Distiller, in 1921. Though his Grandfather had worked himself up from the position of a working Shipwright and without capital to a Partnership in a leading firm of Shipbuilders, and his Father had also engaged in the same business as a Principal, the family fortunes had rather declined again. The firm of Cato Miller and Co., in which John Audley was a Partner from about 1848 to 1867, were too much ahead of their time: they embarked on the construction of Iron Ships and paid the common penalty of pioneers by losing all their fortune, though they were able to pay their creditors in full.⁵ After this calamity, which necessitated his leaving the house to which he had moved in Cressington Park, he joined with his son William in forming a new firm, taking in Charles Mead, the firm becoming Audley, Son and Mead. But Mead soon let the firm down, and went to Australia. Father and son then, about 1870, took into partnership George H. Willmer, a fellow apprentice of the Father's, under the style of Audley, Son and Willmer. Things, however, did not prosper: ohn and William Audley seem to have dropped out about 1877; leaving Willmer to carry on alone in the same yard in Jordan Street. William Audley started a small coal business, but never restored the family to prosperity, so that his children had to depend mainly upon their own exertions for any advancement in life George Audley was educated first at Dr. Nathaniel Bushell's private academy at 50 Devonshire Road, Liverpool, which he left in 1876, for Kingston. School, Yeovil. After three years there, he was apprenticed to Messrs. John Swire and Sons, London Merchants and Ship Owners, at their branch office, 32 The Temple, Dale Street, Liverpool, having failed, as he would recall with a certain amount of satisfaction, to pass the test for the Royal Insurance Company's office, through some stupid mistake in spelling. When the firm closed their Liverpool office, he transferred to Messrs. J.P. O'Brien and Co., in the same building, Mr O'Brien was a cousin of the Swires, and his firm traded as general merchants, but specialised in the export of beer and stout. George Audley's whole business life was spent with the firm, which in 1902 removed their office to 5 Pall Mall, a few streets away, some five years later changing to 10 Pall Mall, where they still carry on. The bottling stores were then moved to their present situation in Tariff Street, Vauxhall Road. (This Company information is no longer valid, although was in 1930's) Without special ability, in the scholastic sense, he entertained as a youth very restricted ambitions as to his financial future. He was always a very modest and retiring man, who never pushed himself forward in any way. But in addition to much shrewdness he possessed boundless industry and in his early business days, when all sorts of difficulties confronted the firm, he thought nothing of working twelve or fourteen hours a day, alternating with night journeys to Glasgow and Dublin. His energy, combined with his tact, brought the firm through various troubles, and eventually he rose to be Managing Director. This position ensured him a comfortable security, but it was through a business deal for which he claimed little credit himself that he acquired the fortune which quite altered his circumstances. In March 1918 his firm entered into a contract for the purchase of the old-established business of Wright and Greig, Ltd., Distillers, of Glasgow, the consideration being in the neighbourhood of one-and-a half-million pounds. This deal was negotiated by George Audley with Mr. Duncan McLeod, now the Laird of Skeabost, in Skye, who was then Managing Director of Wright and Greig. Mr McLeod joined the board of O'Brien's, as Director, to deal with the newly acquired whisky interests. About February 1920 O'Brien's made another move, entering into negotiations for the purchase of the business, distilleries and immense whisky stocks of Bulloch, Lade and Co, Ltd, of Glasgow, the figure involved being close on two million pounds. Very soon after the completion of this huge deal, O'Brien's decided to dispose of all their newly acquired distilleries and whisky stocks, and for this purpose it was necessary to put the company into voluntary liquidation, which became effective on 31st March 1920. The parent business, of home and export bottling, was disposed of

to a company that still carries on under the old name, at the same addresses.

Mr. John Audley tells me that his Grand Father designed and his firm built, a number of the fast Australian clippers, and that the Bella, in which Roger Tichborne, Son of Sir James Francis Doughty Tichborne 10th Baronet, cause of one of the most famous trials of the last century, is supposed to have gone down off the coast of South America in 1854 was one of his ships

It was the business genius of Mr. McLeod, which lay behind these big deals, but considerable credit must belong to George Audley in connexion with them. He was not a man, probably, who would on his own initiative have ventured schemes of such magnitude, yet he saw his opportunity and had the courage and enterprise to accept it and profit by it. At any rate, he came out with a substantial fortune of £180,000, which enabled him to retire in the prime of life, to devote himself to furthering those various philanthropic and artistic causes that he had so very much at heart. In fact, henceforth, his was a dedicated life, though he would hardly have thought himself of claiming it as such. The collection of pictures became his great hobby, when he had the means to indulge it, and in 1924 he presented fourteen valuable paintings to the Walker Art Gallery in Liverpool. The first gift by which he became well known to the public was the result of his interest in art. In 1925 Sir Frederick Bowring, then Mayor of Liverpool, who had already given £10,000 to the fund for extending the Walker Art Gallery, undertook to match any further donation, and George Audley responded to the challenge with a promise of £10,000, which was thus automatically doubled.

In this same year he added forty-three pictures to his previous gift, mostly by Victorian artists. Over a period of some fifteen years he continued to present a large number of pictures to the same Gallery, from the collection he had formed, mostly representative of the English school, the best known, perhaps, being Sargent's "Vespers," which he gave in 1928. In the completed Gallery one of its fine rooms was named the "Audley Gallery." He also gave to the Corporation a number of pieces of statuary, including John Gibson's "Garland Dance," which stood in the entrance hall of Allerton House, the life-size figures of Adam and Eve, by Arthur G. Walker, A.R.A., and Spence's statue of Flora Macdonald, stood in the Sefton Park, Palm House. A handsome gold clock for the Liverpool Town Hall entrance was another gift. But the gift by which he became best known to the public of Liverpool, and its young people particularly, was that of a replica of Sir George Frampton's statue of Peter Pan in Kensington Gardens, costing nearly £2,000, the local site chosen being in Sefton Park. Before his death he had arranged for another replica at a much higher cost, to be placed in Sefton Park, of the famous statue of Eros in London, with a fountain. There were some complaints from artists that he did not commission fresh work instead of getting replicas of existing pieces, but he was following his own taste in the matter and associating it with that of the public whose pleasure was his principal care. To Stanley Park, Liverpool, he gave a children's garden with a floral clock and other attractive features. His interesting collection of "Toby" and other jugs were given to the Liverpool Museum.

To the beautiful Sefton Parish Church, at Sefton, a few miles from Liverpool, where his elder Brother had been confirmed, he presented a valuable copy of Botticelli's "Madonna," in a specially designed oak frame, which hangs on the south wall; and also a copy by Albani of Raphael's Tuscany "Madonna", which hangs in the priest's vestry. This was in 1927, when he also placed a stained-glass window in the north wall of the church, with other members of his family, to the memory of their father and mother. In 1926 he was unanimously co-opted a member of the Arts Sub-committee of the Corporation, in recognition of his services to art. In 1929 he was appointed to the Commission of the Peace for Liverpool. He was Chairman of the Stewart-Jones Evening Homes.

For some years before his death he had been troubled with his heart, and been compelled to "go slow." Of a fairly stout build, and inclined almost to pride himself on his physical inactivity, he rather felt that justice would have been better served by such a complaint attacking one of those people who put their hearts to severer tests. Death came to him suddenly, as he was dressing, on the 25th February 1932, in his

68th year. He was Buried at Duke Street Cemetery, Southport, on 29th February, after a service at Christ Church there, and where he had been a Sides Man.

His will, dated the 14th April 1930, with a codicil of the 23rd January 1931, was proved in April 1932. The gross value was only £55,911.6.5, and the net value £53,873.3.9 Apart from legacies, etc., to relatives and others, his principal bequest was one of £10,000 to the building fund of the Liverpool Cathedral, which was a project after his own heart, even had he not been a staunch supporter of the Church of England. He left the choice of not more than fifty of his pictures to the Corporation of Liverpool, for the Walker Art Gallery. Any residue of his estate was to go to Dr. Barnardo's Homes.

George Audley, though a genuine lover of pictures and taking a real joy in those of his own choice, was not in touch with any modern art movements, which he was quite unable to appreciate. Their manifestations, in architecture as well as in pictorial art; convinced him that he was spending the last years of his life in the "age of ugliness" The school of Victorian artists he favoured "slumped" so badly in public estimation that when the residue of his collection, consisting of 98 items, was sold at Christie's on 12th May 1932 they realised only the paltry sum of £1314·. 6. ·6. He never attempted any painting himself, though his elder Brother, before business absorbed all his energies, practised the art with enthusiasm, while their Sister Edith had a taste for painting in oils.

He had very definite ideas regarding the responsibilities of those blessed with surplus means, and when he retired it was with the deliberate intention of giving back most of his money to the city in which he had been fortunate enough to acquire it-and he never overlooked the fortunate element in his career. Being a Bachelor, he was free to act upon his principles. At Birkdale Lodge, Southport, where he removed from a smaller house in the neighbourhood after his retirement, he had a roomy and comfortable home, terribly crowded, on his own admission, with pictures and other works of art, but he was a man of simple tastes who spent comparatively little on himself. His two unmarried Sister's, who lived with him in great affection, he had provided for, and his system was gradually to denude himself of his capital, in chunks, with the result that he was looked upon as a man of much larger means than he really was, by those who thought he was giving out of his income. His will evidences how far he had travelled along the road of financial renunciation.

Though (or perhaps because) a very modest man, he took a great but simple pride in what he had been able to do for his native city, and in any recognition that, quite unsought, came his way. His frequent visits to the studios of London artists, both on his own behalf and that of the Liverpool Arts Committee, were a personal delight to him, as bringing him into friendly contact with men whose attainments he envied and admired. He was a man of quiet, very deliberate, and homely speech, whose kindly expression, and eyes twinkling from behind his glasses, were often more eloquent than his words. Slow to make up his mind, he was not easily moved from his path when he had chosen it. No one could visit him in his home without feeling attracted by his complete unpretentiousness, his quiet, pawky humour, his deep-seated spirit of kindness, his sincerity, his unselfishness, and his real desire to make the world a better and happier place, especially for children. He was prompted by pure benevolence of heart, and not by any of those envenomed principles that sometimes make philanthropists terrible even in their generosity. At the same time, he could now and again slyly discharge little shafts of sarcasm that found a billet with the sensitive.

A very feeling tribute to George Audley as a man was contributed to The Liverpool Daily Post by Mr Percy Corkhill, who as Lord Mayor's secretary came much into contact with him: --

To know George Audley, was to love him. He was not easy to know--his nature was of the retiring kind; how he hated to fuss. But his heart was of gold. Most people will remember him as the benefactor of art. His gifts were abundant, and as a donor his name will long be remembered in Liverpool as well as in the Metropolis.

Mr. Audley, had a passion for Liverpool. His mind was always on the city he loved so well. He was jeal-ous for its prestige, and he carried his dislike of other preferences to the extreme. Nothing is too good for Liverpool, he used to say, and he deplored the passing of the days when the heads of great firms were the giants of business here before the trek to the South. But most of us will remember George Audley for his love of children. He was at his best when among them. Nothing was too good for them. The poorer they were the more they attracted him. His Peter Pan is more than a piece of poetic beauty in Sefton Park-the garden at Stanley Park is more than a floral clock and collection of whimsical statuary; they are monuments to the memory of a man whose soul was moved at the starving mind and vision of the average child--and of the determination to bring some joy, day by day, into the drab existence of some at least.

Mr. Audley's last visit to Liverpool was to see his friends, and to see the site for Eros in Sefton Park, and although he was obviously unwell he paid his last visit and, so it happened, his farewell to the Peter Pan dell, when he embraced little ones who had come for their afternoon visit to fondle the tiny figures in Frampton's masterpiece. George Audley has passed, but his memory is sweet and fragrant.

In an address before the funeral, The Reverend. L. J. Coursey, Vicar of Christ Church, Southport, where George Audley was for several years a sides man and a generous supporter of its social activities, emphasised the lovable simplicity of his character: -

I suppose we naturally think first of those public acts of munificence, which are familiar to all minds. George Audley lived in Southport, but his heart was in Liverpool. He was a native of that city, his ancestors had lived in it, and Liverpool to him was the place above all others. And so he took joy in doing what he could for it. In a material age he was a patron of art, and thereby he rendered no small service to the public weal. In a world dazzled by the achievements of science he remembered the greater things that men pre inclined to forget--art and beauty. Generations to come will thank God for what he did. Perhaps the biggest thing about him was that he had preserved so wonderfully the heart of a child. He presented that exquisite replica of Peter Pan. He loved to see the children playing in the park he gave them. He loved the young because he, too, was young.

His city honoured him and he strove worthily to serve it in God's sight. We have lost a great and generous friend. I thank God for his childlikeness and that other outstanding quality he had of utter simplicity. He never spent his wealth on himself.

These tributes do not lay any too much stress on his love for Liverpool, which differed so markedly from the casual friendliness felt by most businessmen for their native city. In his inarticulate way he was a romanticist, and his imagination easily warmed towards whatever helped to revive memories of the past. One little thing he did in the service of local history: in 1931 he paid the cost of reprinting the 4th edition (1773) of Gore's Liverpool Directory.

The most widely placed and permanent memorial to George Audley will be this Family History. It was at the end of 1924 that he began to feel he would like to know more about his ancestors, and got into touch with me. Though there was a family connexion between us (my Father's Brother had married his Mother's Sister) and we both belonged to Liverpool, we had never met before. I agreed to undertake enquiries, and to make a small charge for my services, as the subject was not one of personal concern to me, and the work rather interfered with my own special researches. He knew his family history as far back as his Great Grandfather, William Audley, and it is a confession good for my soul that after eight years or so of enquiry, during which most of the centralised evidences for the whole country were ransacked for evidence concerning anyone bearing the name of Audley, as well as an immense number of parish registers and other local records, not to mention all the ordinarily accessible printed sources, I was unable even to tell him that Great-Grandfather's parentage! However, he soon became interested in the growing accumulation of Audley's, past and present, and fell in with my suggestion to print the results, despite his disappointment at being left without the means of connecting himself with any of the numerous lines of the family which I was able to show had flourished in many parts of the country down to the eighteenth century. I may record that he handed over to me during the seven years of our pleasant partnership in this: work a total sum of £920, which was increased by sales of Parts I. and II, to £934 odd. He left everything entirely in my hands, as to the researches undertaken; the printing of the two Parts, and my own charges I find that roughly my charges over the whole period amounted to £220, while the printing and distribution of the two Parts cost some £240. The cost of searches, including fees, postages, stationery, and incidental charges of every kind, came to about £430 leaving a balance of £44l in hand towards the cost of printingthis Part III. The amount of work that has fallen upon me during all these years m the conduct of the searches, the sifting, sorting and arranging of the evidences, and the seeing of so much printed matter of the kind through the press, has been very heavy, but it has been a labour of love. Most of the searches in printed material have been made personally by me. Had George Audley lived he would have contributed further towards the completion of the work, but dying suddenly he was given no opportunity to make such provision as would have enabled me to carry it to a conclusion without being confronted by almost insuperable financial difficulties. It may be added that 300 copies each were printed of Parts I. and II., of which 247 were distributed free to Libraries, including all the leading ones in the British Isles (Public, University, Society, Club, etc.), and a comprehensive collection of similar ones throughout the Empire, the United States, and the principal countries of Europe. Rather more than a third of them have supported the continuation of the work by subscription.

For the memory of his parents George Audley had the greatest veneration, as well as for that of his Grandfather, John Audley the Shipbuilder, whose character and ability were an inspiration to him. He felt

that such a grandfather, however humble his immediate origins may have been, carried the impress of a superior race (his portraits certainly suggest it), and he would have been delighted, though not from ordinarily snobbish motives, if his grandfather's descent could have been proved from some of those earlier Audley's whose careers suggested the possession of qualities and capacities that are generally considered a valuable inheritance. But the characters and achievements of some "Knights of old" would probably have ill compared with George Audley's unspectacular virtues and benefactions, which added new traditions, of a peculiarly human kind, to the history of the name he was so proud to bear.

1939 Registers of England

The 1939 Registers were created in 1939 for the issue of registration documents and ration books shortly after the commencement of World War 2. As they were produced after the start of the war they do not include people who were member of; conscripted into and volunteered for the Armed

Services. Additionally After World War 2 these registers were used as the registration of people into the newly formed National Health Service. These registers were 'updated' by the National Health Service until 1991 when the National Health Service Registration was computerised. The updates made under the National Health Service typically include; changes of surname by Marriage, corrections to Christian names (for example changing initials to full names) and recording the Deaths of individuals listed in the registers. No changes of address are recorded are the Births of new individuals are not recorded.

The records of individuals are either open or closed. Open records can be viewed by the public and Closed records cannot be viewed by the public. Records are open if one of the following conditions applies:

- * The record is open if the person was born more than 100 years ago. This is the 100 year rule and means that progressively more records will be opened each year until they all become open in 2040.
- * The record is open if the person is deceased and the person's Death is recorded in the registers. In theory this means that the record for anyone listed in the registers and Died before 1991 should be open. However not all deaths before 1991 were recorded in the registers, and people who were in the Armed Forces in 1939 are not listed in the registers.

Records that are not open are closed. However members of the public can make requests to the National Archive at Kew to open closed records. To do this they must be able to supply a copy of a Death Certificate and the National Archives must be able to relate this Death Certificate to a particular individual in the 1939 Registers. For example the Death Certificate has the address where the individual died and the 1939 Registers have the address where the individual was living in 1939 so not all requests may be successful
