Introduction

The earliest member of this Audley family is {AH1} John who is the Son of John Winstanley and Ann Hughes prior to her Marriage to {AB20} William Audley. {AH1} John appears to have been Baptised in 1838 as Winstanley, recorded in the 1841 Census of England as Hughes; as Audley in the 1851 & 1861 Censuses of England. He married in 1867 as Winstanley. The family used the Audley surname in 1871, 1881 and 1891 Censuses of England before changing to the Winstanley surname. (Comment: see 'Supporting Evidence' in Birth's & Baptism's note on Official Records for {AH7})

On his Marriage Certificate he is recorded as John Winstanley with his Father being John Winstanley a Miller. In the 'Supporting Information' section of this file is a reference to two John Winstanley's both Millers in the 1841 Census of England entries. It's possible that one of these two John Winstanleys is the biological Father of {AH1} John.

Narrative

{AH1} **JOHN WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY** Baptised on the 11th March 1838 at St Peters Liverpool as John Winstanley; parents John & Ann Winstanley of Waterloo Road, Liverpool, Father was described as a Miller. (*Also recorded in Pedigree “B” as {AB21}*) His Mother later Married William Audley {AB20} in May 1842 Of Back Queen Anne Street, as (*John Hughes*) in 1841; Of 1 Back Queen Street as (*John Audley*) in 1851; of 3 Back Queen Ann Street, a Cooper as John Audley in 1861; of 64 Hall Lane West Derby, a Cooper, as (*John Winstanley*) in 1871; of The Heath Sandbach, Cheshire, England a Cooper, as (*John Audley*) in 1881. At Park Lane, Sandbach, a Chemical Cooper, as (*John Audley*) in 1891. Of 86, Rydal Street, Everton, Liverpool, a Cooper in 1901 (*as John Winstanley*). Of 13, Cadogan Street, Liverpool a Cooper at Brewery in 1911, (*as John Winstanley*). Married to ELEANOR KILLEY on the 17th January 1867, at Saint Thomas, Douglas, Isle of Man. She was of Douglas Street, Peel, Parish of St Germans, Isle of Man in 1851 and 1861. She was baptised 13th Jauary 1843 in the Parish of St Germans, Isle of Man. She Died and was Buried as Eleanor Audley on the 23rd May 1884 at Elworth, Near Sandbach, Cheshire, at St Peter and had issue. (*Comment; We have not managed to identify the Death registration for {AH1} John we know he was living at the time of the 1911 Census of England at 13 Cadogan Street, Liverpool, and is recorded as the next of kin of {AH6} in the WW1 Attestation papers of {AH6} Robert dated the 4th April 1916. and {AH1} was living at 46 Hatherley Street, Liverpool There is the Death registration of a John Winstanley in Toxteth Park Q1 in 1920, Vol 8b page 270. The death registration indicates that the person who died was 59 years of age, whereas {AH1} would have been 82 years of age!! Possibly the street directories of the above addresses might help to resolve the issue.*)

1. {AH2} **CATHERINE ANNIE AUDLEY WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY** born on the 17th November 1867 Soho Street, Liverpool and Baptised on the 12th January 1868, at St Nicholas Church, Liverpool, (*as Winstanley*); of 64 Hall Lane West Derby, in 1871, (*as Winstanley*); of The Heath Sandbach, Cheshire, England in 1881 (*as Audley*). At Park Lane Sandbach, a Dressmaker in 1891 (*as Audley*). Of 13 Cadogan Street, Liverpool, in 1911, (*as Winstanley*). She emigrated on the 7th December 1921 aboard the Aberdeen Line “SS. Themistocles” with her Brother {AH6} Robert, departing from London to Sydney, Australia. She recorded her last address in Liverpool as 46 Hatherley Street, Princes Avenue. She died in 1941 in the Redfern District of Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.
(*Comment: There are a number of addresses noted for her in the Australian Voters Lists in the ‘Supporting Information’ section.*)
2. {AH3} **GEORGE JAMES KILLEY WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY** born Q1 in 1870 at Liverpool. of 64 Hall Lane, West Derby, in 1871 (*as Winstanley*); of The Heath Sandbach, Cheshire, England, in 1881 (*as Audley*). At Park Lane, Sandbach, a Chemical Labourer, in 1891, (*as Audley*). Of 86, Rydal Street, Everton, Liverpool, a Cotton Porter in 1901 (*as Winstanley*). Of 13 Cadogan Street, Liverpool, a Dock Labourer, in 1911 (*as Winstanley*). He died Q4 in 1920 aged 50 in Toxteth Park, Liverpool.
3. {AH4} **ELEANOR ELIZABETH WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY** born on the 24th July 1871, (*as Winstanley*) Liverpool. Of The Heath, Sandbach, Cheshire, England, in 1881 (*as Audley*). At Park Lane, Sandbach, a Dressmaker in 1891, (*as Audley*). Of 86, Rydal Street, Everton, Liverpool in 1901 (*as Winstanley*). Of 200, Gloucester Road, Bootle, Liverpool, (*as Adamson*) in 1911. She emigrated on the 15th November 1923, aboard the P & O Line ‘SS Berrima’ sailing from London to Sydney Australia. She emigrated with her two Sons, Joseph Winstanley Adamson and Robert Cecil Douglas Adamson. They gave as their last address 6 Hillary Park, Douglas Isle of Man. She died in 1939 in the Canterbury

District, of Sydney, New South Wales, Australia. She Married Q3 in 1903 to Samuel Joseph Adamson, at St Dunstan's, Edge Hill, Liverpool,. He died aboard SS "Vedamore" a Second Officer in the Mercantile Marine aged 49 on the 7th February 1917. His death is commemorated on the Mercantile Marine "Tower Hill Memorial" in London. (*"The Memorial commemorates men of the Merchant Navy and Fishing Fleets who gave their lives and have no grave but the sea".*) They had issue. (*Comment: There are a number of addresses for her and her sons in Australia in the voter list in the supporting information section. One of her Sons Joseph Winstanley Adamson, Died in 1987 in New South Wales Australia (The New South Wales Death Indexes are only available until 1987)*)

4. {AH5} **JOHN WILLIAM WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY**, born on the 17th September in 1873 (*as Winstanley*) at Liverpool; of The Heath, Sandbach, Cheshire, England in 1881 (*as Audley*). Living at Park Lane Sandbach, a Bricklayer's Labourer, in 1891 (*as Audley*). He Enlisted in the British Army on a 'Short Service Attestation' and joined the Queen's Own Cameron Highlanders, at Inverness, Scotland, on the 13th February 1892, and classed 'Fit' at Chester on the 16th February 1892, as a Private, Service No #3067. His record noted, He was aged 18 Years 11 Months, and his Occupation was a Labourer. Religion, Church of England, and previously he was attached to the 4th Battalion of the Cheshire Regiment. (*Comment: *He recorded that he was Born in Sandbach, Cheshire, his General Registry Office (GRO) record notes he was Born in Liverpool.*) He served in various Battalions in various locations across the World, including service during the 2nd Boer War in South Africa. His Army service record shows that he was located at Home from the 12th February 1892 until the 13th September 1892. He then moved to Malta 14th September 1892 until the 18th February 1895. The location is not recorded, but appears to have served in the 'Regiment of Foot' from 19th February 1895 until the 3rd October 1897. He then served in Egypt from 4th October 1897 until the 2nd March 1900. He served in South Africa from the 3rd March 1900 until the 30th July 1902, during the "2nd Boer War", where he was awarded the King's and Queen's South Africa Medal with Clasps. He was then 'at Home' from the 31st July 1902 until the 12th February 1904, when He was Discharged from active service His Father was noted as 'Next of Kin' living at Park Lane, Park View, Sandbach, Cheshire. Of 5 Portelet Road, Stoneycroft, Liverpool, a Postman in 1911 (*as Winstanley*). Of 51 Oxtan Street, Liverpool C B a retired Postman in 1939 (*as Winstanley*). In 1939 he was living with his Sister {AH7} Eliza Mary. He died on the 10th May 1947, unmarried, at Noble's Hospital and Dispensary in Douglas Isle of Man. His Will gives his last two addresses as 16, Osborne Grove and 66 Murray Road, Douglas Isle of Man.

5. {AH6} **ROBERT COWELL WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY** born Q1 in 1877 West Derby, Liverpool (*as Winstanley*); of The Heath Sandbach, Cheshire, England in 1881 (*as Audley*). At Park Lane, Sandbach, a Tailor's Apprentice, in 1891, (*as Audley*). Of 86, Rydal Street, Everton, Liverpool, a Tailor in 1901 (*as Winstanley*). Of 13 Cadogan Street, Liverpool, a Tailor's Machinist in 1911 (*as Winstanley*). During WW1 he served in the British Army, and served in the Royal Garrison Artillery (Service no #71882) In his Enlistment papers dated the 4th April 1916 he is described as a Tailor Machinist, of 46 Hatherley Street, Liverpool and his 'next of kin' is recorded as being his Father of the same address. In his Army service record there is a request for information about emigrating to Australia. He emigrated to Australia leaving London aboard "SS Themistocles" on the 7th December 1921, bound for Sydney. He Emigrated with his Sister {AH2} Catherine. He records his last address in Liverpool as 46, Hatherley Street, Princes Avenue, Liverpool. (*Comment: There are a number of addresses for him noted in the Australian Voters Lists in the 'Supporting Information' section. The registration of his Death has not been identified from the Voters Lists in Australia, and he would appear to have died between 1963 and 1968.*). It should be noted that Cowell is Maiden name of his maternal Grandmother.

6. {AH7} **ELIZA MARY WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY** born on the 20th February 1879, at The Heath Sandbach (*as Audley*); of The Heath, Sandbach, Cheshire, England in 1881, (*as Audley*); At Park Lane Sandbach, a Scholar in 1891 (*as Audley*); of Spital Lane, Bebington, Cheshire, a Cook Domestic in 1901(*as Audley*). She was of 7 Kingsmead Road , Birkenhead (*as Eliza Barnett*) a Domestic Cook in 1911. In 1911 her Husband is not recorded at the same address but there is a Frank Barnett married living as a boarder in West Derby Liverpool. She was of 51 Oxtan Street, Liverpool C B, a Widow in 1939. In 1939 she was living with her Brother {AH5} John. She died on the 12th September 1963, aged 84 years, at the Ellan Vannin Home, Kingswood Grove, Douglas, Isle of Man, she was formerly of 40, Woodbourne Road, Douglas. She married (*as Winstanley*) Q3 in 1906 at West Derby, Liverpool, to a Frank Barnett. It is believed that he Died Q1 in 1937 aged 59 in Liverpool North. (*Comment: it is not 100% certain that the Death recorded above is the Husband of {AH7}. The street directory for 51 Oxtan Street in 1937 may*

provide the supporting evidence. Also in her Will she leaves money to her Niece. It is believed this must be a relative of her Husband.)

7. {AH8} **CECILIA ALICE WINSTANLEY ALIAS AUDLEY** born Q3 in 1880 at The Heath, Sandbach; (*Comment: her Birth appears to have been recorded twice in the GRO Index at Congleton, Cheshire, once as Winstanley and once as Audley*); of The Heath, Sandbach, Cheshire, England, in 1881 (*as Audley*). At Park Lane, Sandbach, a Scholar in 1891, (*Recorded as Amelia Audley.*). Of 4 West View, Conchan, (*aka 'Onchan'*) Douglas, Isle of Man, a Domestic Servant in 1901. & 1911 (*as Winstanley*). In both the 1901 and the 1911 Censuses of the Isle of Man, there is another Domestic Servant living at the same address some 42 years older than her with the surname Killey. This Killey could be the Sister of the Mother of {AH8}. She died in 1959 aged 78 in Douglas, Isle of Man (*as Winstanley*)
