## Introduction

This family history contains details of 2 families and is the smallest of all the Family Histories on [www.audleyfamilyhistory.com](http://www.audleyfamilyhistory.com) & [www.audley.one-name.net](http://www.audley.one-name.net). it contains 3 males named Audley/Adley and all 3 males has the forename Peter.

The Audley Family 2 must be closely linked to Audley Family “AB” as {AK2} **Peter Audley** was living at the time of the 1851 Census of England with members of Audley Family “AB” in Portsea, Portsmouth.

It is not known whether Audley Family 1 and Family 2 are related. In some records Family 1 is recorded with the Audley surname and others with the Adley Surname. In the only two records for this family where a signature is required, the individuals sign with an (X).

No reference has been found, to the Birth or Christening of Peter Audley {AK2}, even though in both the 1851 and the 1861 Censuses of England he gives his place of Birth as Liverpool. Equally no reference can be found to either of two people called Peter Audley (Father and Son) in the 1841 Census of England.

## **Detailed Narrative**

### **Family 1a**

{AK3} **PETER ADLEY/AUDLEY** He is recorded in Gores Directory of Liverpool for 1794, as Peter Audley, a Mariner of Hurst Street. He was Buried on August 2<sup>nd</sup> 1796, at St Peter's Church, Liverpool, He is described as a Mariner of Hurst Street in his Burial record. He married, by Licence dated 18<sup>th</sup> April 1785, and took place as Peter Adley, a Mariner. His spouses name on the Marriage Licence is ALICE CURSEY. The marriage took place on the 19<sup>th</sup> April 1785, at St Nicholas Church, Liverpool and the spouses name on the Marriage Certificate to ALICE CURPHY. In the Parish Register they both sign with an (X), and in the Marriage Licence he signs with an (X). She is recorded as Mrs Alice Audley of 25, Hurst Street, Mersey Street in the 1800 Gores Directory of Liverpool, Mrs Alice Audley, Bake House Keeper, 25 Hurst Street, Mersey Street in the 1803 Gores Directory; Mrs Alice Audley, Bake House Keeper, 45 Hurst Street, Mersey Street, in the 1804 Woodward's New Liverpool Directory; Mrs Alice Audley, Boarding House, 53 Hurst Street, in the 1805 Gores Directory and; Mrs Alice Audley, Boarding House, 9, King Street, in the 1807 Gores Directory.

### **Notes with regard to the above family**

- There is the Burial of a Jenny Adley on the 31<sup>st</sup> March ??? described as the Daughter of Peter Adley a Sailor at St Peter's Church, Liverpool. This burial is before the marriage of the above Peter Adley to Alice Cursey or Curphy. This entry is complicated in that there is a Baptism of a Jinny Adley in 1557 but her Father is described as Patrick Adley, a Sailor.
- There is the Burial of a Catherine Adley at St John's Church, Liverpool on 17<sup>th</sup> July 1771. Could it be that this Catherine Adley was Peter Adley's first Wife and that Jenny was their Daughter. There are a number of other Adley burials at Liverpool St John's Church but this is the only one prior to 1875 when Peter Adley married Alice Cursey or Curphy.

### **Family 1b**

This is the only other Adley /Addley Family that could possibly link to Family 2

**RICHARD ADLEY** married **MARY** ??????. They had issue.

**THOMAS ADLEY/ ADDLEY** He was baptised 22<sup>nd</sup> June 1806, at Maryport, Cumberland,, as Thomas Adley. He is recorded in the Gore's Street Directory of Liverpool for 1853, described as a Mariner of 58 Lowther Street. He received a 'Masters Certificate of Service issued at London on 27<sup>th</sup> May 1851 (certificate number 35174). This masters certificate gives his date and place of birth as May 1806 at Maryport, Cumberland. Of 25 Bedford Atreet, Toxteth Park, Liverpool, a Warehouseman in 1861, as Thomas Addley. In the 1861 census his place of birth is given as Cumberland. He married HANNAH METCALF. On 22<sup>nd</sup> December 1829 at Crosscanonby, Cumberland. She was of Rice Street, Liverpool, in 1841. She was of 58, Lowther Street, Liverpool in 1851, as Hannah Adley, and described as Seamans wife (Hudband at Sea). In the 1851 census her place of Birth as Brigham, Cumberland

- 1.) **MARY ADDLEY** born about 1831 based on age in the 1841 Census of England. Baptised on the 6th February 1831, at Maryport, Cumberland. (as *Mary Adley*). Of Rice Street, Liverpool in 1841, (as *Mary Addley*). Of 58 Lowther Street a Straw Bonnet Maker in 1851
- 2.) **ANN ADDLEY** born about 1835 based on age in the 1841 Census of England. Of Rice Street, Liverpool, in 1841.
- 3.) **JOHN ADDLEY** born in Maryport about 1835 based on age in the 1841 Census of England. Baptised on the 14<sup>th</sup> December 1834, at Maryport, Cumberland. (as *John Adley*). Of Rice Street, Liverpool, in 1841. (as *John Addley*). He appears to have entered the Dreadnought Seamen's Hospital Ship, at Greenwich, London, aged 14 on the 28<sup>th</sup> August 1848, and sailing out of London with 18 month service aboard the 'William V Alfred' suffering from 'Cloudy Ioncata'. He was discharged on 18<sup>th</sup> October 1848.
- 4.) **SARAH METCALF ADDLEY** born Q3 in 1840 at West Derby Liverpool. Of Rice Street, Liverpool in 1841. Of 58, Lowther Street, Liverpool, a Scholar, in 1851. Of 25, Bedford Street, Toxteth Park, Liverpool, in 1861, as Sarah Metcalf Addley
- 5.) **HANNAH ADDLEY** born Q2 in 1845 at West Derby, Liverpool, and was Baptised at St John the Baptist, Church, Toxteth Park, Liverpool. Of 58, Lowther Street, Liverpool, a Scholar, in 1851. Of 25, Bedford Street, Toxteth Park, Liverpool, in 1861, As Hannah Addley.

The purpose of the analysis in this file is to find a link between Family 2 and Audley Family {AB}. It is believed that there is a link between Family 2 as {AK2} Peter Audley was living at the same address as {AB31} George Walton Audley and his family in Portsmouth in the 1851 census. However in the census return Peter Audley is described as a visitor. It is known that Audley Family {AB} were living as Family {A} in Cheshire, England and Flintshire, Wales before moving to Liverpool. As the above family 1b appear to have lived in Maryport, Cumberland, England prior to moving to Liverpool, it is considered unlikely that Family 1b will provide a link between Family 2 and Audley Family {AB}

## Family 2

{AK1} **PETER AUDLEY** a Customs House Officer, he had issue, the only information we have regarding {AK1} is from the [Marriage](#) Certificate of {AK2}.

- 1, {AK2} **PETER AUDLEY**, was Born approx 1831 in Liverpool (based on the 1851 Census of England). Of 42 York Street, Portsea Hampshire, in [1851](#) a Boiler Maker; (Comment: It should be noted that in the 1851 Census of England this Peter Audley was living at the same address as {AB31} George Walton Audley). Of 42 Greenland Street, Liverpool, a Boiler Maker in 1854 (at time of Marriage) Of 10 Mints Terrace, Poplar, Tower Hamlets, London, a Boiler Maker in [1861](#). He [Died](#) on the 30<sup>th</sup> December 1863 aged 32 at 56 Harper Street, Liverpool, and was Buried in Toxteth Park Cemetery, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> January 1864. He was Buried in [Grave M/926](#) He [Married](#) on the 21<sup>st</sup> October 1854, at St Philip's Church, Liverpool, to JANE OPENSHAW, Daughter of Thomas & Ann Openshaw, a Cow Keeper/Gardener. She was [Baptised](#) on the 1<sup>st</sup> May 1828 at St James, Liverpool. After the Death of her Husband she was of 64 Devonshire Road, Toxteth Park, a Dressmaker, in [1871](#). In [1881](#) Living in the Toxteth Park Workhouse, Smithdown Road, Liverpool, and a Seamstress, She [Died](#) Q4 in 1883 aged 58 at Toxteth Park, Liverpool., and was [Buried](#) in [Grave 12/401](#) on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 1883 as John Audley according to the Toxteth Park Cemetery Burial records. (Comment: Her age of 58 years at Death, would have seen Her Born in approx. 1825, if equally her age of 25 on her Marriage Certificate would have seen her Born in approx. 1829.)
