Introduction

The information for the Audley of Waterford Ireland & Liverpool was initially taken directly from the information in Chapter 20 of the Audley Pedigrees by A. L. Reade. In that publication the author A. L. Reade refers within Chapter 20 to the Audley's of Waterford, but never wrote up that section. Additional information has been taken from the original research records of A. L. Reade that are kept in the 'Special Collections Unit in the Sydney Jones Library at Liverpool University, Liverpool, England, also E-mail correspondence has been exchanged in recent times with members of the family living in Australia, Canada, and New Zealand.

Links to other families both within Audley Family 'E' and other Audley Families

There are four families in this section, the link between two of them is described in the Will of **Bridget Audley, Wife {E1}** who Died a Widow. In the Will (*see Audley Pedigrees by A. L. Reade*) She refers to her Cousin **John Audley {E16}** of Williamson Street, Liverpool.

In a letter dated 24th March 1928 from {E73} Frederick Audley to A L Reade he makes the following comments:

- On one occasion being in Liverpool, summered at the end of a voyage to St Helena, in the South Atlantic Ocean. I visited the Widow of {E16} John Audley, of Williamson Street, this John Audley, during his lifetime used to visit us at Waterford every summer, and I was told by my Mother that he was my Father's {E29} Cousin.
- In the same letter he writes I have no proof, but am of opinion that my {E29} Father was related to the George Audley of Inistioge, County Kilkenny, because I can remember my Mother speaking of relatives named Audley who lived in that County

One possible link has been identified between **Family 2** of **Audley Family 'E'** and another branch of the Audley Family (*non - Family E*). This link is based on the information from the Baptism of **{E20} Sarah Ann Audley**, who was Baptised on the 2nd November 1851, at St Nicholas (*Roman Catholic*) Church, on Copperas Hill, Liverpool. The Baptism record gives **Sarah Audley's** God Parent's as **Samuel Audley** and **Jane Audley**

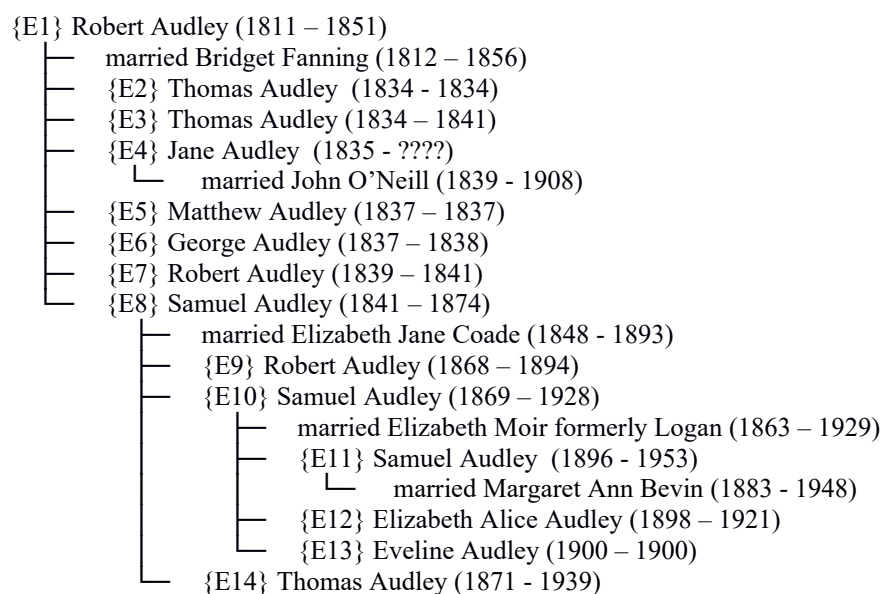

As far as can be identified there are two candidates for this Samuel & Jane Audley as follows:

- **Samuel Audley**, could be {E8} and **Jane Audley** could be {E4} of **Family 1** in the **Audley Family 'E'**. In this case {E8} **Samuel Audley** and {E4} **Jane Audley** would be the Brother and Sister aged 10 and 15 respectively at the time of the Baptism of {E20} **Sarah Ann** in 1851.
- **Samuel Audley** could be *{A9} and **Jane Audley**, could be his Wife Jane Audley, (*nee – Poole*). If this alternative is correct Samuel & Jane Audley would have been aged 48 & 45 respectively at the time of the Baptism in 1851.

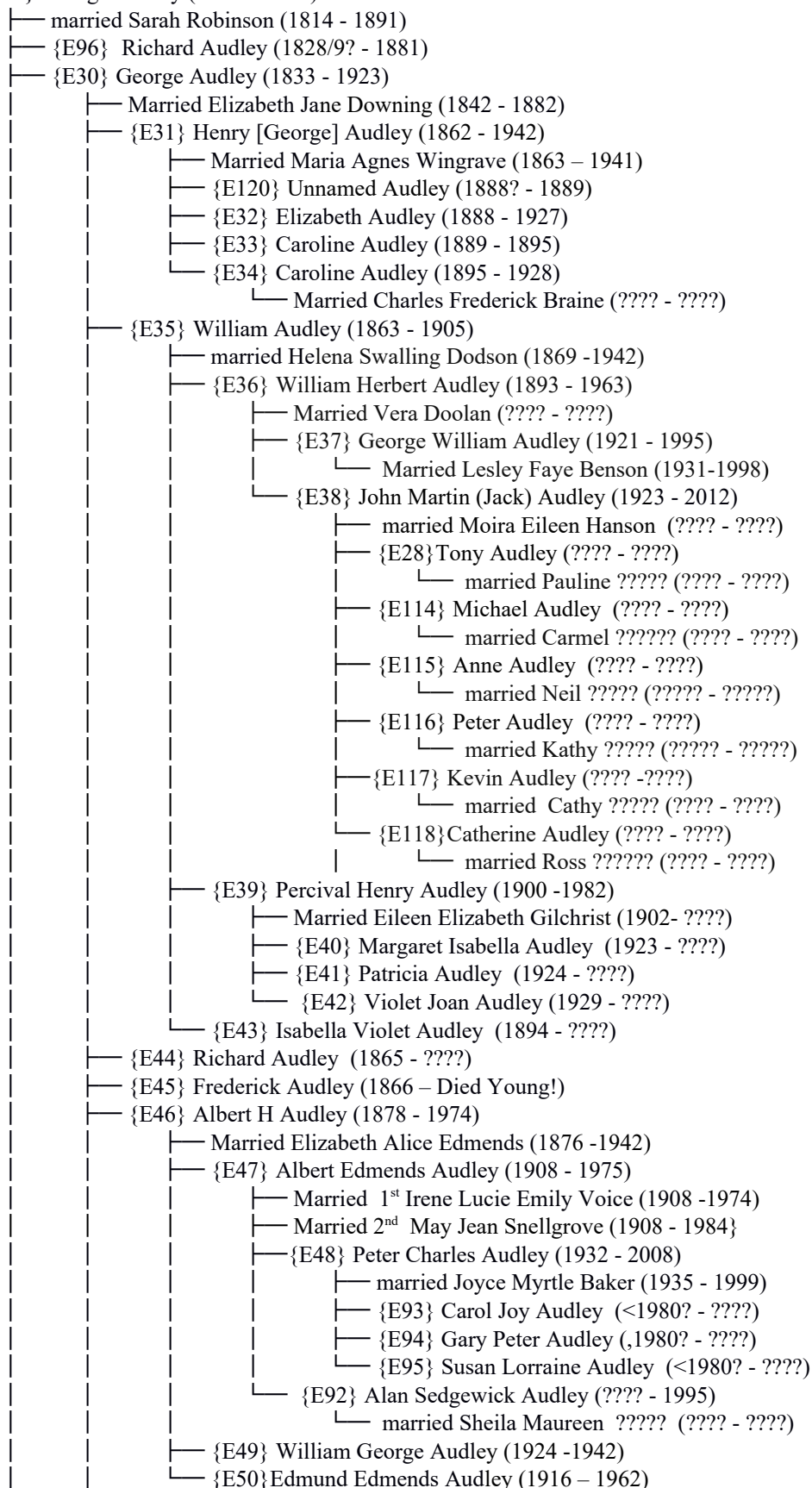

{E1} **ROBERT AUDLEY**, born about 1811 at Waterford, a Cordwainer, (*Shoemaker*), of North Street, 19 Bent Street, and also 2 & 4 Dawson Street. Of, North Street, Liverpool, a Cordwainer, in 1834, (*from the Baptism of {E2} Thomas Audley*). Of Bent Street, a Cordwainer, in the 1841 Census; Of, 64 Saltney Street, a Shoemaker Journeyman, in the 1851 Census. Died on the 30th July 1851, aged 40 at 64 Saltney Street, Liverpool. He Married 1833 to BRIDGET FANNING (*Possibly Fannon or Fannan*) (*Fanning, according to the Marriage Licence record issued in Waterford & Lismore, Ireland.*). She was Born about 1812; in the 1851 Census of England she is described as a Provisions Dealer, at 64 Saltney Street, Liverpool. She Died on the 27th October 1856, aged 44 at 28 Marybone, Liverpool and described as a Provisions Dealer. Her Will was dated the 29th September 1856, and proved in Chester on the 2nd December 1856. They had issue

- I. {E2} **THOMAS AUDLEY** of North Street, Baptised, on the 12th October 1834, St Nicholas Church, Liverpool. Living in North Street, Liverpool, at the time of his Baptism. Must have Died prior to the Birth of {E3} in December 1834
- II. {E3} **THOMAS AUDLEY** born December 1834 Baptised on the 29th November 1835 at St Anthony's (R C) Church, Scotland Road, Liverpool. Of Bent Street, Liverpool, in 1841. Died on the 5th July 1841 at 19 Bent Street, and Buried on the 7th July 1841 aged 7 at St Mary, Liverpool
- III. {E4} **JANE AUDLEY** born on the 5th December 1835. Baptised on the 9th February 1836, St Anthony (RC) Church, Scotland Road, of Bent Street, Liverpool, in 1841; of 64 Saltney Street, Liverpool a Scholar in 1851. Of 83-85 Park Lane, Liverpool, (*as Jane O'Neill*), in 1871. Of 61 Park Lane, Liverpool, (*as Jane O'Neill*), a Clothier, in 1881. Of 19 Jasper Street, Liverpool, (*as Jane O'Neill*) in 1891. Of 17 Jasper Street, Liverpool, (*as Jane O'Neill*) in 1901. (*Is she the Jane O'Neil, living at the 'Little Sisters of the Poor (Home for the Aged) at Plymouth Grove West, Chorlton upon Medlock, Manchester in 1911?.*) Married to JOHN O'NEILL on 16th May 1858, at Holy Cross Chapel (RC), Standish Street, Liverpool, a Clothes Dealer. He was Christened on the 9th August 1838, at Newry, County Down, Ireland, and Son of a John O'Neill, also a Clothes Dealer. He Died and was Buried on 15th April 1908.
- IV. {E5} **MATTHEW AUDLEY** Twin Brother of {E6} George Audley. Born on the 5th July 1837 and Baptised on the 9th July 1837 at St Anthony (RC) Church, Scotland Road, and Died on the 27th July 1837 aged 3 weeks, at 2 Dawson Street, and was Buried on the 28th July 1837 at St Mary, Liverpool.
- V. {E6} **GEORGE AUDLEY** born on the 5th July 1837, and Baptised 9th July 1837, at St Anthony (R C) Church, Scotland Road, Liverpool. One of his Godparent's is Catherine Fannon¹. He Died on the 12th February 1838, aged 7 months, at 4 Dawson Street, and was Buried on the 14th November 1837, aged 7 months, at St Mary, Liverpool Twin Brother of {E5} Matthew Audley.
- VI. {E7} **ROBERT AUDLEY** born on the 17th January 1839, 19 Bent Street, Baptised on the 10th February 1839, at St Anne's. Richmond Cazneau Street, Liverpool, and Died on the 28th June 1841, aged 2 ½ years, at 19 Bent Street. The informant of this Death was Catherine Audley address 19 Bent Street. Of Bent Street, Liverpool, in 1841.
- VII {E8} **SAMUEL AUDLEY**. He was probably Born on the 28th February 1841, according to the record of his second Baptism. It is believed that the date on his Birth Certificate of the 30th May 1841, at 19 Bent Street Liverpool, is incorrect. (*It should be noted that his Birth was registered in Q3 in 1841. The informant was his Mother, who signed the official record with an X*). It would appear that he was Baptised twice, firstly on the 15th March 1841, at St Peter's (Church of England) Liverpool, and secondly on the 1st November 1846, at St Joseph's (Roman Catholic Church), Liverpool. Of Bent Street, Liverpool, in 1841 Census. His age is given as 6 months in the 1841 Census, this suggests that he was probably Born in February 1841 and not May 1841 as the 1841 Census was taken on the 6th June 1841. Of 64 Saltney Street Liverpool in 1851 Census a Scholar; of the District Military Hospital, Stoke Damerel, Devonport, a patient and a Private in the 2nd Battalion of the 12th Regiment of Foot, (The Suffolk Regiment), in the 1861 Census. Of 13 Richmond Street, Liverpool, a Draper, in 1871 Census. He Died on the 22nd February 1874, at Church Road, Stanley, near Liverpool, and was Interred in the Ford "Roman Catholic" Cemetery, on the 24th February 1874.aged 33. (*His Son Robert was Interred in the same Grave*). He enlisted in the 2nd Battalion of the 12th Regiment of Foot on 1st May 1860 at Liverpool; his trade on enlistment is described as a Tailor. He was discharged from the Army on the 18th June 1862 at the Curragh, Co Kildare, Ireland. His Regimental number was 919. He was in hospital for 8 days during the 1st Quarter of 1861; presumably this coincided with the 1861 Census. He was in hospital for 47 days during the 2nd Quarter of 1861. He was on board a ship for three days during the 3rd Quarter of 1861. He was on Furlough (*Leave*) from the 1st December to 31st December 1861. He was on detachment at Youghal, Co Cork, Ireland, during the 1st Quarter of 1862. He was in hospital for 22 days and on a march 11 days during the 2nd Quarter of 1862, before being discharged. (*See at end of narrative on Pages 14/15 a brief history of the 2nd Battalion of the 12th Regiment of Foot, the information of Samuel Audley from the*

One of the Godparent's of George Audley {E6} is Catherine Fannon, presumably she is the Sister of Bridget Fanning, the Wife of {E1} Robert, and is presumably the same person as Catherine Audley who was the informant of the Death of Robert Audley {E7}. No evidence has been identified that Catherine Fannon, married an Audley.

Regimental Muster Books.). Married on the 27th January 1867, at St Joseph's Chapel, Liverpool, to ELIZABETH JANE COADE, Daughter of Thomas Coad, a Labourer. She was Born 1847/48 in Co Wexford, Ireland. At the time of Marriage, Samuel Audley was a Draper of Richmond Street, Liverpool, and Elizabeth Coad was of Cazneau Street. His Widow, Elizabeth Jane Audley nee Coad, Married 2nd on the 16th June 1883, to William George Langley at West Derby Registry Office, and the Marriage was solemnized at St Frances Xavier Church, Everton. At the time of their Marriage Elizabeth Jane Audley was living at 140 Gregson Street, Liverpool, and William George Langley was living at 10 Harwood Street, Liverpool. Samuel and Elizabeth Jane had issue:

1. {E9} **ROBERT AUDLEY**, born on the 7th April 1868, and Baptised on the 12th April 1868, at St Joseph's Liverpool. (*Stepson of {E8} Samuel Audley*). Of 13 Richmond Street in 1871 & 1881: In 1891 living at Hall Lane, West Derby. Died aged 25 at the Liverpool Consumption Hospital, and was Interred in the Ford "Roman Catholic Cemetery on the 17th January 1894 (*He was Buried in the same Grave as Samuel {E8}*)
2. {E10} **SAMUEL AUDLEY** born on the 27th November 1869, and Baptised on the 28th November 1869 at St Nicholas, Liverpool. Of 13 Richmond Street, in 1871 and 1881. Living at 3, Plan Street, Liverpool, in 1901. Of 24, Belgrave Street, Liverpool, a Hairdresser, in 1911. Of 24, Belgrave Street, Liverpool, a Hair dresser (*Out of work*) in 1921. In 1921 on Elizabeth Alice Audley's Death Certificate, he is described as a Journeyman Barber. He Married an ELIZABETH MOIR formerly LOGAN. (*Comment: in the Parish Register of St Francis Xavier, Liverpool, Baptism Record of her Son, {E11} Samuel, and Daughter, {E12} Elizabeth Alice, her surname is given as "Logan".*) at St Francis Xavier's (R C) Church, Liverpool, on the 6th August 1918. Living at 24, Belgrave Street at the time of Marriage still living at 24 Belgrave Street, in 1928 when he Died. He was Interred in the Yew Tree "Roman Catholic" Cemetery on the 29th May 1928, aged 58 years. His Wife Elizabeth, was Born in 1863 and was also living at 24 Belgrave Street, at the time of her Death, and was Interred in Yew Tree "Roman Catholic" Cemetery on the 29th November 1929, aged 66 years, both Internments where in "Public Plots". Samuel and Elizabeth had issue
 - i) {E11} **SAMUEL AUDLEY** born on the 19th May 1896 and Baptised on the 5th July 1896 at St Francis Xavier (R C) Church, Liverpool. Of 3 Plan Street, Liverpool, in 1901. Of 24 Belgrave Street, Liverpool, in 1911. Of 24 Belgrave Street, Liverpool, working for GWR Railway Co in 1921. Of 30, Fernie Street, Liverpool, a Railway Motor Driver, in 1939. He Married on the 11th October 1930 to MARGARET ANN BEVIN, a Widow aged 46 years, and Daughter of a William Sanderson, a Bricklayer's Labourer at the Liverpool Register Office. Both living at No 2 Pomona Street, Liverpool, at the time of their Marriage. (*Comment: Although Born in 1896/97, their Marriage Certificate recorded Samuel's age as 36 years, which would have his Birth year as 1894.*) He Died Q1 in 1953 aged 56 years, in Liverpool, and She was Born on the 21st June 1884, and She Died on the 8th December 1948 aged 64 years, and was Buried in Allerton Cemetery.
 - ii) {E12} **ELIZABETH ALICE AUDLEY** born on the 23rd December 1897 and Baptised on the 17th February 1898 at St Francis Xavier Church, Liverpool. Of 3 Plan Street, Liverpool, in 1901. Of 24, Belgrave Street, Liverpool, at School in 1911. Died on the 17th April 1921 at 147, Mill Road, Liverpool, (*West Derby Infirmary*) aged 22, described on Death Certificate as of 24 Belgrave Street a Spinster and Tailoress. Interred in the Yew Tree "Roman Catholic" Cemetery on 22nd April 1921 in Grave No 650 a 'Public Plot'.
 - iii) {E13} **EVELINE (EVALINE) AUDLEY** Interred in the Ford "Roman Catholic Cemetery" on the 19th August 1900 aged 7 months. At the time of her Death was living at 3 Plan Street, Liverpool.
3. {E14} **THOMAS AUDLEY**, born on the *12th November 1871, and Baptised on the 19th November 1871, at St Nicholas Church, Liverpool. (*Stepson of {E8} Samuel Audley*). Of 13 Richmond Street in 1881. Confirmed on the 25th March 1887, at Sacred Heart Church, Liverpool, aged 15. His 'Godfather at his Christening was William Knowles. Of 12, Hall Lane, West Derby, Liverpool in 1891. He Enlisted in the British Army on the 15th August 1892 on a 'Short Service Attestation', (*age recorded 18 Years 10 Months, could he have underestimated his age in Army

Records?) and joined at Canterbury on the 29th August 1892, into the 2nd Battalion Dragoon Guards, 5th Lancers, as a Private, Service No # 12552. According to his record his occupation was a Barber, and that he apparently had served previously in the 3rd Cheshire Regiment. Served in England initially, and then went on to serve in various locations across the World. from the 15th August 1892 to 30th November 1893; In Rawul Pindee, India from 1st December 1893 to 20th October 1894; In Egypt from 21st October 1894 to 3rd November 1896; Returned to Home in England 4th November 1896 to 28th April 1898. He then served in the 2nd Boer War in South Africa on the 29th April 1898, to 10th November 1901; He was dangerously wounded at Wildfontein on the 8th January 1901, during the 2nd Boer War, a Private in the 5th Lancers Battalion of the South Africa Field Force (Regimental Number 4827). He was awarded Campaign Medals of, Kings South Africa Medal & Queens South Africa Medal Clasps, (Belfast O F S) Awarded in Cape Colony, Orange Free State, Elandalaagte, for the Defence of Ladysmith South Africa in 1901. His record shows he returned again to Home in England between the 11th November 1901 until the 14th August 1914, during which time in 1903, he extended his service term after serving for 12 years in the Colours, and given permission to continue in 1913 beyond 21 years. It appears he re-enlisted again in the British Army In his second period of enlistment he appears to have been suffering from Deafness and spent three Periods in Hospital at the Curragh, Co Kildare, Ireland, (2 periods in 1917 & 1 period in 1918). In this second period of enlistment he was posted on the 24th February 1917 to 1st Reserve Cavalry Regiment at the Curragh, Co Kildare, Ireland, and on the 7th June 1917, he was noted as 'Class 2' due to Deafness. He spent time as part of the 5th Battalion of the Royal Irish Rifles during September 1918. During February 1918, he elected to receive an Army Pension whilst still serving. After service transfer, at one point in time he had the Regimental No #4872, whilst serving with the 5th Battalion Royal Irish Lancers. He was finally Discharged from Army Service on the 8th March 1919, at Canterbury. Army Records note Next of Kin as {E10} Samuel Audley, of No 3 Plan Street, Liverpool, and that his Mother was living at No 3, Smollett Street, Liverpool. On leaving the Army it is believed that his home address was 50, Duke Road, Chiswick, London, and Died Q2 in 1939, aged 67 years, in Hammersmith, London.

(Comments: (A. L. Reade's original research papers comment, "said to have descended from Devonshire Protestants, possibly indicates he accepted {E23}'s' written comments. Also in A. L. Reade's original research papers, a document suggests that a John Audley, Born in Waterford in 1817, and who Died in June 1867, was {E15} William Audley the Father of this John Audley {E16}!)

- I {E16} **JOHN AUDLEY** born in 1826 in Waterford, Ireland, a Tailor and Draper. Of Springwell Cottages, Marsh Lane, Linacre (Bootle), a Woollen Draper in 1861; of 32 Stanley Street, also 13 & 17 Williamson Street, and Copperas Hill, Liverpool. Described in Bridget Audley's Will, as a Cousin. Died on the 24th June 1868, aged 42 at Portland Street, Southport, and was Interred in the Ford "Roman Catholic" Cemetery on the 28th June 1868. The address in the Burial Record is given as 13 Williamson Place. *(This is inconsistent with his place of Death.)* His Will noted he left his effects to his Wife under £1500. *(Buried in the same Grave with his Wife Catherine, and Daughter, Ann Mary (E22), and Caroline Josephine (E23) and Margaret Hanlon² (Information in the research papers of A. L. Reade C 9.5).* He Married CATHERINE JOHNSON, Daughter of Thomas Johnson a Master Mariner on the 21st August 1848 at the Liverpool Register Office. She was Born 1830/31 in Ireland, of 13 Williamson Square, Liverpool, a Tailor in 1871. In 1881, 1891, 1901 and 1911 Censuses of England, of 7 Prospect Vale West Derby, described as a Dealer in Tailor's Trimmings in 1891, and living on own means in 1911. Living at 7 Prospect Vale Q4 in 1914 when she Died aged 89 years, and Interred with her Husband in the Ford "Roman Catholic" Cemetery on the 15th October 1914. They had issue.

1. {E17} **MARY JANE AUDLEY** born on the 24th December 1849 *(according to Birth Certificate)* and 25th December 1849 *(according to Baptism Record)* at 32 Stanley Street. She was Baptised on

3. {E19} **CATHERINE AUDLEY**³ born on the 11th July 1856 at 17 Williamson Street, and Baptised 10th August 1856 at St Nicholas, Liverpool. Of Springwell Cottages, Marsh Lane Linacre (Bootle) in 1861 of 13 Williamson Square in 1871 at the same address, an Assistant Tailor in 1881. She was of 90 Edge Lane, West Derby Liverpool in 1891. She Died on the 7th January 1892, and was Buried at Smithdown Road Cemetery. She Married on the 5th November 1883, to JOHN FRANCIS PARLE at St Oswald "Roman Catholic" Church, Liverpool. At the time of her Marriage she was living at 7 Prospect Vale, Liverpool, and John Francis Parle was living in Rufford Road, Elm Park, Liverpool. Her Sister, Caroline {E23} was the Witness of her Marriage. Following Catherine's death her Husband married Q2 in 1900 to Mary Ellen Mullin, in West Derby Liverpool. In 1911 he was living at 90 Edge Lane West Derby Liverpool. John Francis Parle, Died on the 14th April 1930, and was Buried at Anfield Cemetery, Liverpool. *(Comment: Catherine Audley and John Francis Parle had a Son, JOHN AUDLEY PARLE. He was Born Q4 in 1885 in West Derby Liverpool. He was of 90, Edge Lane West Derby, Liverpool in 1891 and at the same address in 1911, a Chartered Accountant. He was Awarded the Military Cross in 1917, see the Citation in the London Gazette in the supporting information of this file. He Died on the 30/11/1917 as Captain JOHN AUDLEY PARLE, aged 33, of The King's (Liverpool Regiment) United Kingdom, and Buried, II. D. 44. Honnechy, British Cemetery, Northern France.)*
4. {E20} **SARAH ANN AUDLEY** born on the 2nd October 1851 and Baptised *(as Sara)* on the 2nd November 1851 at St Nicholas's Church, Copperas Hill, Liverpool. Her God Parents were Samuel Audley and Jane Audley. She Died *(as Sarah Ann)* on the 7th August 1852, at 31 Copperas Hill, aged 10 months and was Buried at Old Swan Catholic Church. *(Comment: Who exactly were her God Parent's, could this give a link to another branch of the Audley family?)*
5. {E21} **ELIZABETH AUDLEY** She was Born on the 14th February 1854 and Baptised on the 30th April 1854 at St Peter's Priory. She Died on the 31st July 1854 aged 0, at 13 Williamson Street and Buried at St Oswald's Catholic Church, Old Swan, Liverpool.
6. {E22} **ANN MARY AUDLEY** born on the 13th January 1860 *(according to A L Reade as Birth Certificate)* or 16th January 1860 *(according to Baptism Record)* at 13 Williamson Street, Liverpool, and Baptised at St Nicholas Church, Liverpool, on the 19th February 1860. Of Springwell Cottages, Marsh Lane, Linacre (Bootle), Liverpool, in 1861. Died on the 12th December 1862, aged 3 years at 13 Williamson Street, Liverpool. Interred in the Ford "Roman Catholic" Cemetery, on the 14th December 1862, in the same grave as her Father, John {E16}.
7. {E23} **CAROLINE CHARLOTTE MARY JOSEPHINE ANGELA AUDLEY**; born on the 2nd October 1863, Tramore, Waterford, Ireland. Baptised on the 3rd December 1863, at Holy Cross "Catholic" Church, Tramore. Of 13 Williamson Square, in 1871, at the same address in 1881, and an Assistant Tailor; of 7 Prospect Vale, West Derby, an Artist Portrait Painting in 1891, at the same address in 1901 Census of England, but with no occupation recorded. Of 'Bell Vue' Lower Square Chagford, Devon in 1921. Her occupation in 1921 is recorded as 'Sketching in water colours'. In 1928 whilst living in St Omer, Pas De Calais, France, she was in correspondence with A. L. Reade, noting 'Her Father's Sister, Anne Audley, *(no Pedigree record available)*. Married a William Shell, Architect & Land Agent, they emigrated to Melbourne, Australia on the vessel "Ohio", but the vessel sank during the voyage there.) *(Also, she comments of being the only child born in Liverpool, the rest of the family Born in Ireland, also of Cousins in Waterford, and New Zealand, and that family ancestry originated in Devon, and also that they were Protestants, suggesting to A. L. Reade to contact the Protestant Clergy in Waterford for further help*'. She Died Q1 in 1936 at the Denbigh Mental Hospital, aged 73 years, and Interred in Ford "Roman Catholic" Cemetery on 30th January 1936, in the same grave as her Father, John {E16}.

{E29} **GEORGE AUDLEY** described as of Clonmel, Co Tipperary, and afterwards Waterford from circa 1856. Also says of Waterford, Born on the 19th April 1801 (*suggesting Born Waterford*) Died on the 24th April 1864 in Waterford Ireland. He was Buried at the Abbeylands, Cemetery, Waterford. Letters of Administration following his Death were granted to his Wife. He married on the 3rd July 1826 St Patrick's Church of Ireland to SARAH ROBINSON by License. His Wife is said to have been related to Sir Hercules Robinson (*but not his Daughter*). In 1871 she appears to be living in Trinity Street, St Mary's Newington, London, with her Daughter {E68} Charlotte and her Son {E71} William. In 1881 she appears to be of 136 Offord Road, Islington, London, a Lodger of Independent means with a Family named Grassman. In 1891 she appears to be of St Mary Islington Workhouse Infirmary, Islington, London. She Died and was Buried on the 15th October 1891, aged 77 in Islington, London, and had issue. It has been suggested that his parents came from England and went to Ireland and were Flour Millers

- *Sir Hercules Robinson Born on the 19th December 1824; Died on the 28th October 1897, made first Baron Rosmead in 1896. A new creation so presumably the Hercules Robinson referred to above was his Father Admiral Hercules Robinson (Born on the 16th March 1789); from Rosmead, County Meath, Ireland*
- *The Headstone of {E29} George Audley makes no reference to the later Burial of his Wife, which supports the proposal that his Wife died in London.*
- *They married by License unfortunately the Marriage licenses were destroyed by fire in 1922 so only the Index to the licenses survives).*

She Died on the 4th August 1882, and Buried at Rutherglen, Victoria, Australia, and had issue.
 - I) {E31} **HENRY [GEORGE] AUDLEY** born on the 18th January 1862 at Wahgunya Victoria Australia He was an Ironmonger. In 1929 was living at 12, Rosemont Street, Adelaide South Australia. He Died on the 23rd July 1942, Adelaide, South Australia. He Married on the 16th February 1887, at Rutherglen to MARIA AGNES WINGRAVE. She was Born on the 23rd March 1863, and she Died on the 3rd Jan 1941, at Adelaide, South Australia, She was the Daughter of George Burton Wingrave, of Rutherglen and Caroline Moss, and had issue.

(*Comment: There is the possibility that she was a twin as the Birth Indexes also list the Birth Registration of an unknown female to the same parents with registration numbers that are sequential in their number.*

- c) {E34} **CAROLINE AUDLEY** born on the 1st August 1895 at Raglan, Victoria, Australia, she Died on the 5th August 1928, and Buried at Sea Lake Victoria. Married at Norwood South Australia 5th May 1927 to CHARLES FREDERICK BRAINE of Sea Lake Victoria, and had issue. She Died in 1928, at Victoria, Australia. (*Comment: The Victoria Birth Indexes note her Birth is registered as Carol ,it is assumed that this is a truncation of her name Caroline.*) (*According to the Victoria, New South Wales, Australia, Deaths record 1853 to 1988,their Son Henry Frederick Braine also Died in 1928.*)
- II) {E35} **WILLIAM AUDLEY** of Rutherglen born on the 25th July 1863 at Chilton, Victoria, Australia and Died on the 9th September 1905, Buried at Rutherglen, Victoria, Australia, and Married in 1892 at Yarrowonga, in North East Victoria to HELENA DODSON. Helena was Born about 1869 and Died in 1942 at Croxton East Victoria, Australia. She was the daughter of George Dodson (*he was Born in. 1844*) of Yarrowonga Victoria) and Ellen Louisa McGrath b, 1846, and had issue.
- a) {E36} **WILLIAM HERBERT AUDLEY** of Regent, Melbourne, Born on the 15th March 1893, at Fitzroy, Victoria, Australia. He Died in 1963 at Victoria, Australia. Living in the Parish of Yarrowonga, Moira County, Victoria, New South Wales, and a Labourer, and during World War I he enlisted on the 17th August 1914, at Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, into the Australian Army Flying Corp (Service No) SERN: #??24, at the Head Quarters of the 1st Australian Division. He also served in the 5th Australian Infantry Regiment prior to Enlistment. at Melbourne, Victoria, Australia. (*He Embarked from Melbourne, Victoria, on board HMAT A3 Orvieto on the 21st October 1914, and he Returned to Australia on the 23rd October 1918.*) (*He possibly served in the 2nd Infantry Brigade, but the record was crossed out on his Attestation Record?, also his religion was recorded as being Roman Catholic.*) His Mother Mrs. H Audley, of 102 Union Street West Brunswick, Melbourne, Australia, was listed as his Next of Kin in the Australian Armed Forces Service Records. He married at Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, to VERA DOOLAN, Daughter of John Martin Doolan of Victoria, Australia, at a time and place which is not known, and had issue.

- B) {E38} **JOHN MARTIN (JACK) AUDLEY** born on the 26th June 1923. During WWII he served in the 58/59th Australian Army, Infantry Battalion in the South West Pacific, with the rank of Corporal. (Service Number VX139772) and in 1945 was awarded the Military Medal. He died on the 25th May 2012 at the Embracia Care Home on Ashley Street in the Reservoir District of Melbourne, Victoria Australia. He married MOIRA EILEEN HANSON in 1948 at Victoria State, Australia, and had issue.

b.) {E25} **JAMES AUDLEY** born on the 18th November 1870, at Waterford. Of House 3 in Gracedieu, Morley Terrace, Waterford Urban No 5, Co Waterford, a Book Keeper at a Printing House in 1901. He emigrated to Ottawa, Canada, in 1902 on board SS Ionian. Of 46, Bellwood, Capital Ward, Ottawa, Canada, a Clerk in 1921. He Died on the 3rd September 1938, at Penticton, British Columbia Canada. He Married 1st CATHERINE (KATE) CUMMINS on the 13th September 1893, at The Roman Catholic Chapel of 'Trinity Without', Waterford. She was Born 1873-4 in Clonmel *(Based on the 1901 Census of Ireland)* She Died on the 17th November 1905, at Barrack Street, Waterford, Ireland. Subsequently he emigrated to Canada, and was a Civil Servant, aged 43 years living at 1214, Queen Street West, Carleton County, Toronto when he Married 2nd EDITH CATHERINE ANNE COOKE; aged 40 years a Designer, of 60 Northcote Avenue, York County, Toronto on the 10th April 1913, At St. Mathias Church, York County, Toronto. Canada. She was Born in 1873. He Died on the 3rd September 1938, and She Died on the 19th January 1957, at Penticton, Okanagan-Similkameen, British Columbia, Canada. by both Wives he had issue. *(Comment: No Birth Registration can be found for {E25} The Death Registration for the 1st Wife of {E23} states that she was a Widow, which is incorrect. The informant of her Death was her Father Patrick Cummins, who signs with an X.)*

A {E26} **MARY ELIZABETH JOSEPHINE AUDLEY** The Daughter of {E25} by his 1st Wife She was Born on the 5th May 1895, at Barrack Street, Waterford, Ireland. Of House 3 in Gracedieu Road, Morley Terrace, Waterford, Urban No 5, Co Waterford, a Scholar in 1901. She Died on the 27th January 1907, at the Workhouse Hospital, Waterford. Her address at time of Death is given as 103, Barrack Street, Waterford.

B {E99} **CYRIL FRANCIS AUDLEY** The Son of {E25} by his first Wife, Born on the 4th October 1898, at 36 Upper Morley Terrace, Waterford, and Died on the 3rd November 1899, at 36 Morley Terrace, Waterford.

C {E61} **JAMES PATRICK AUDLEY** The son of {E25} by his first Wife He was Born on the 23rd April 1902, at Barrack Street, Waterford.

(Comment:

- It is believed he emigrated aboard the Canadian Pacific Steamship vessel "Lake Manitoba" arriving in Quebec on the 8th August 1908. He would have been 6 years old when he emigrated. On the passenger list he is the only Audley and is described as 'Joining Father'. The "Lake Manitoba" Sailed from Liverpool to Quebec via Belfast. The passenger list indicates that he was Born in England but under where in England it states 'could not say'.*
- In the 1921 Census of Canada, there is a James Patrick Audley at the 'Tuxedo Barracks' in Winnipeg, Manitoba as a very young girl*
- {E62} Sheila Mary Audley had vague recollections as a very young girl of a half-Brother named "Jimmie" visiting her family from Ottawa.*

- D {E62} **SHEILA MARY AUDLEY** The Daughter of {E25} by his second Wife. She Born on the 11th March 1914 in Ottawa, Ontario, Canada. Of 46, Bellwood, Capital Ward, Ottawa, Canada a Student in 1921. She Died on the 14th November 1987. She Married on the 4th September 1937, in St Saviour's Anglican Church, Penticton, British Columbia to ALBERT AUBREY SHIPTON, who was Born on the 29th August 1911 at Indian Head, Saskatchewan, Canada, and Died on the 28th March 2004 in Westside Care Centre, Westbank, British Columbia
(See comments after {E25} James Audley narrative).
- c.) {E63} **FRANCIS PETER AUDLEY** born on the 29th January 1874, at Barron Strand Street, Waterford, and Died on the 24th March 1875, in Waterford, Ireland. His Death appears to have been registered twice, firstly on 29th March 1875 by his Father and also on 10th April 1875 by a Margaret Taylor. This Margaret Taylor signs with an X and is recorded as being 'present at death'. Whereas his Father on the 1st Registration of his death his father is recorded as being 'being in attendance during last illness'
- d.) {E64} **JOHN LINDSAY AUDLEY** Died in 1866 aged 0 at Waterford (*Comment: both the Irish Genealogy and Ancestry websites have the Death of a John Lindsay Audley Q3 in 1866 and the Birth of a John (Lindsay) Audley in 1867. We have therefore assumed that as one child had Died the next child was given the same name.*)
- e.) {E65} **JOHN LINDSAY AUDLEY** Born on the 30th November 1867 at Lady Lane, Waterford Ireland
(Comment: See comment under {E64} narrative.)
- f.) {E98} **WILLIAM AUDLEY** Born on the 18th November 1870 at Broad Street Waterford.
- g.) {E100} **DAUGHTER NAME UNKNOWN** Born probably in June 1864 The only evidence for this child is from two references in the Births section of a Mrs. Henry Audley of Thomas Street having a Daughter. (*For details see the newspaper section in the supporting evidence section.*)
(Comment: No evidence that {E60} had Daughters, however in a letter written by {E73} Frederick Audley in approx 1930, it indicates that {E60} Died about 1875 leaving Widow and several Sons and Daughters).
- h.) {E101} **KATHLENE AUDLEY** She was born in 1866-7 at Waterford (*Based on the 1901 Census of Ireland*) or 1860-1 (*Based on the 1911 Census of Ireland*). She married on the 20th March 1901 to ALBERT WALTER REYNARD, a Salesman, at St Mathias Church in the Parish of St Peter in the City of Dublin. Her Address at the time of her Marriage was 11 Peter's Place, Adelaide Road, Dublin. She was of Peter's Place, Fitzwilliam, Dublin (*as Kathlene Reynard in 1901*), and of 34 Rathgar Avenue (Rathmines & Rathgar, West Dublin), in 1911. Also in 1911 she is described as a House Keeper and a Widow.
- g.) {E102} **HENRY AUDLEY**
(Comments:
- Little is known of this person he is included here as in the issue of the Waterford Mirror dated 11th March 1897, he is recorded as attending the Annual General Meeting of 'The Waterford Boat Club' and being elected Honorary Secretary. It is considered unlikely that the Henry Audley who attended that annual meeting was {E60} Henry Audley who died on 15th July 1897 of Senile Decay' (*It is also believed however in a letter from {E73} Frederick Audley in approx 1930 indicates that {E60} Died about 1875 leaving Widow and several Sons and Daughters*)
 - Believed that it is this Henry Audley who was recorded in the 1894 Slaters Directory of Waterford, as being an Agent of the 'Suir Navigation' at their Office in Bridge Street, Waterford.)
6. {E66} **SARAH WILHEMENA ROBINSON AUDLEY** Born reputedly in 1839. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, County Tipperary, Ireland, although no record has been identified. Emigrated to Australia in 1867 aboard the "SS GREAT BRITAIN" (*Source A.L.Reade*). No reference to the Death of Sarah Wilhemena Robinson Webb had been identified. Married SAMUEL HENRY WEBB in Melbourne in 1869. Samuel Henry Webb was born in March 1845 in New Walk, Leicester, Leicestershire, England, He emigrated with his family in 1855/1856 aboard the 'HCMS Mermaid' sailing from Liverpool, England to Melbourne, Australia.. He would appear to have been a Storekeeper, Locksmith and Gun Keeper in Victoria, Australia, also Vancouver, Canada, and Honolulu, Hawaii. He appears to have been in England in the 1891 Census at the address of his Sister Fanny Sweet. He Died on the 8th August 1920 at 15th Street, Kaimuka, Honolulu. He married

2nd Mrs. Mary Ann Davis (formerly Fleming née Draper) in 1910. (Comment in one of the letters sent to A. L. Reade around 1930 suggests that Samuel Webb was a Judge. That suggestion is incorrect.)

7. {E67} **ELIZABETH MARY AUDLEY** born on the 7th December 1839. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, on the 19th April 1855, on the same day as 5 Siblings, abode at time of her Baptism, Melbrook, Clonmel, Father's occupation Mercantile Clerk. She Died in Cape Town, South Africa in 1916. She Married on the 7th June 1864 to THOMAS JAMES SIMPSON PEARCE at the Cathedral Church in the Parish of Trinity in the City of Waterford. They had issue. Of 3 Sons and 2 Daughters.
(Comment: There are two issues with this person's marriage.
 - Firstly, her age on the Marriage Certificate is given as 20 which suggests that she was Born in 1844 and not 1839
 - Secondly Her Father's name is recorded on the marriage certificate as John Audley, deceased, in fact her fathers name should have been recorded as George Audley, who was deceased.
Conversely the witnesses to this marriage are her Sister {E69} Isabella S Keary and her husband Thomas S Keary.)
8. {E68} **CHARLOTTE AUDLEY** reputedly Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, although no record has been found. In 1871 she was of Trinity Street, St Mary, Newington, London a Dressmaker. In 1871 she appears to have been living with her Widowed Mother and her younger Brother {E71} William Audley. In 1881 she was living as a Lodger with a family named East at 19, Queensbury Street, Islington London, she is described as a Dressmaker, she Died and was Buried on the 9th August 1900, Unmarried. Aged 55, at Islington, London. (Comment: There is the possibility that in 1891 she was an Inmate at the St Mary's 'London Female Reformatory' in Islington, London.)
9. {E69} **ISABELLA AUDLEY** born on the 6th December 1841. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, on the 19th April 1855, on the same day as 5 Siblings, abode at time of her Baptism, Melbrook, Clonmel, Father's occupation Mercantile Clerk, Died in Dublin Married THOMAS SNOWE KEARY, at the Cathedral of the Most Holy Trinity (RC), Waterford, on the 20th January 1863,. A witness at the marriage was a Henry Audley it is assumed that this was her elder Brother {E60}. They had no family.
10. {E70} **JOSEPH AUDLEY** born on the 14th January 1845. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, on the 19th April 1855, on the same day as 5 Siblings, abode at time of his Baptism, Melbrook, Clonmel, Father's occupation Mercantile Clerk. Drowned at sea Unmarried in 1869 from the "Bonita".
11. {E71} **WILLIAM PRICE AUDLEY** born on the 13th May 1848. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, County Tipperary, on the 19th April 1855, on the same day as 5 Siblings, abode at time of his Baptism, Melbrook, Clonmel, Father's occupation, a Mercantile Clerk. In 1871 He was living in Trinity Street, Parish of St Mary, Newington, London, with his Mother and his Sister {E68} Charlotte and described as a Grocer.. He Died in Waterford, Unmarried. It is he believed he Died on the 26th July 1873, aged 22, at 'The Leper Hospital, Waterford. In his Death registration he is described as a clerk. (Comment: It has been suggested by a family member that he Died in 1878 however the only possible Death found for him at Waterford is the date of death given above and with more information in the 'Supporting Evidence' section of this file).
12. {E72} **ALBERT EDWARD AUDLEY** born on the 17th March 1850. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, on the 19th April 1855 on the same day as 5 Siblings, abode at time of his Baptism, Melbrook, Clonmel, Father's occupation Mercantile Clerk. He drowned at sea Unmarried, on the 8th November 1877, he was a Mate on the Ocean going ship the "Thames", and operated to Canadian Ports by the 'Temperley Line', and his place of residence is given as Clonmel, Ireland.
13. {E73} **FREDRICK AUDLEY** of Coromandel near Auckland New Zealand, at onetime an Officer in the mercantile marine for 'The Peninsular and Oriental Steam Navigation Company', (More Commonly known as 'P & O'), and for 4 years a Harbour Master of Coromandel. The youngest child. (Source: **ALR**). Born on the 21st December 1854. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, on the 19th April 1855 on the same day as 5 Siblings, abode at time of his Baptism, Melbrook, Clonmel, Father's occupation Mercantile Clerk (Sources: **PR** & **ALR**) at Clonmel, Ireland. Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, (Source: **ALR**) (Left Ireland in 1880 and went to Australia on the 29th June 1880 on board the "Chrysomene" then on to New Zealand in 1881. In 1929 living at Coromandel New Zealand (Source: **ALR**). Married on the 22nd October 1879 at

Heston, County Middlesex, England, to MATILDA BYDDER. She was the Daughter of Charles Alfred Bydder, a Fleet Engineer RN (1826-1899). She was born on Portsea Island, Hampshire, England. In October 1856, and Died in-1952, and had issue.

- a) {E74} **FREDERICK CHARLES AUDLEY** born on the 27th November 1880 at Rutherglen, Victoria, Australia and died 6th February 1881 at Rutherglen, Victoria, Australia
- b) {E75} **FREDERICK ALBERT AUDLEY** of Takapuua Auckland New Zealand. He was Born on the 21st October 1887 at Coromandel, New Zealand. He Died on the 27th June 1964 at Auckland, New Zealand. He Married 1st on the 3rd January 1912, at Hamilton, New Zealand, to ALICE TURNER the Daughter of George Turner of London, she was Born on the 8th March 1877, and Died in 1949. He Married 2nd to THELMA LOWE, at a time and place which is not known. She was Born on the 13th June 1903, and Died on the 1st September 1973.
 - A) {E76} **FREDERICK GEORGE AUDLEY** The Son of {E75} by his 1st Wife, He was Born on the 22nd May 1913, in New Zealand, and Died Unmarried in 1987, in New Zealand. *(Comment: Frederick appears to have travelled extensively by sea during his life time to and from Australia, England and America. (See "Supporting Evidence" for detailed information under 'Passenger Lists', pages 62 & 63 of published records of voyages he took between years 1949 to 1955)*
 - B) {E77} **STANLEY ALBERT AUDLEY** The Son of {E75} by his first Wife, He was Born on the 17th May 1916 and Died on the 30th March 1983 at Auckland, New Zealand. He married JOYCE ENID MASON, at a time and place which is not known. She was Born at a time and place which is not known, and Died on the 5th December 1992 at Auckland,, New Zealand. They had issue.
 - 1) {E103} **SANDRA AUDLEY** living in Auckland, Unmarried
- c) {E78} **ALFRED GEORGE AUDLEY** He was Born on the 27th February 1889 at Coromandel, New Zealand and Died on the 28th October 1979, at Whakatane, New Zealand. He Married on the 10th March 1913, at Auckland, New Zealand to ANNIE EDITH GEARD, Daughter of Charles Geard of Coromandel, New Zealand she was Born on the 18th December 1888, and Died on the 5th November 1970 aged 81 years at Tauranga, New Zealand, and had issue.
 - A) {E79} **OLIVE MARY AUDLEY** born on the 22nd December 1915, and Died on the 17th February 2008. She Married on the 9th September 1944 to HERBERT WILLIAM SHARP.
- d) {E80} **REGINALD BERESFORD AUDLEY** born on the 13th June 1891, at Coromandel, New Zealand, and Died on the 25th April 1959 at Newcastle, New South Wales, Australia He Married in Sydney, Australia, to BETHEL MAY RICHARDSON, at a time and place which is not known, She was Born in 1894 and Died on the 27th October 1976. They had issue.

- e) {E81} **ERNEST HENRY AUDLEY** He was a Principal School Teacher in various Schools in the South Auckland area. He wrote three books. He was Born on the 27th November 1895 in Coromandel, New Zealand. and Died on the 26th July 1973 in New Plymouth New Zealand. During World War I he enlisted on the 9th August 1917 into the New Zealand Army, Service No #79769. His religion was recorded as being Church of England. During civilian life he was a School Teacher with the Wanganui Education Board. He Married 30st December 1924 at Mount Eda Auckland, New Zealand to MARJORIE FOWLER

BILLING. She was the Daughter of Aubrey Field Billing of London?, and later of Auckland, New Zealand. She was Born on the 20th August 1900, and Died on the 2nd December 1995, in Auckland, New Zealand, and had issue. *(Comment: Ernest came by ship from Wellington, New Zealand to England arriving in Southampton on the 18th May 1953, accompanied by his Wife Marjorie.)*

- A) {E82} **DOUGLAS FIELD AUDLEY** born on the 5th October 1925, at Auckland, New Zealand, and Died on the 15th January 1982, at Mount Maunganui, Tauranga, New Zealand. He Married to LINDSAY ELIZABETH SCOTT, at a time and place which is not known. They had issue.
- 1.) {E109} **EVAN FIELD AUDLEY** born on the 26th November 1951, and living in Auckland, New Zealand.

- f) {E84} **STANLEY ARTHUR AUDLEY** of Auckland, New Zealand, and Born on the 1st November 1898, at Coromandel, New Zealand, and Died on the 21st May 1973, at Tauranga, New Zealand. He first Farmed at Coromandel, and in 1925 he joined the New Zealand Police Force. He left the Police Force in 1946 and purchased a Dairy Farm in Te Puke, Tauranga, New Zealand. He Married on the 5th October 1927, at Remuera, Auckland, to ROWENA MAY PURSER, Daughter of Edward George Purser of Wanganui & Auckland, New Zealand. Born on the 21st September 1901 Wanganui, New Zealand, and she Died on the 27th August 1982. at Rotorua, New Zealand. They had issue.

He was Born on the 4th July 1876, in England and he Died on the 21st October 1950 in Sydney, Australia. They had issue of three Sons and three Daughters.
- h) {E87} **NORAH MABEL AUDLEY** born on the 21st March 1886, at Coromandel, New Zealand, and Died on the 5th May 1940, at Auckland, New Zealand. She Married on the 16th June 1909, at Coromandel, New Zealand, to FRANCIS (FRANK) BARRACLIFFE ROBINSON He was Born on the 6th February 1884, and he Died on the 5th April 1962, at Auckland, New Zealand.. They had issue of one Daughter and 3 Sons.
- i) {E88} **MATILDA FLORENCE LILLA AUDLEY** born on the 13th June 1901, at Coromandel, New Zealand, and Died on the 4th April 1998 at Thames, New Zealand. She Married on the 15th March 1921, at Coromandel, to IRA DUDLEY (JACK) CLOTHIER of Whaugapoua, New Zealand. He was Born on the 19th June 1898 at North Canterbury, New Zealand, and he Died on the 2nd June 1984 at Thames, New Zealand. They had issue of 2 Daughters.

14. {E89} **THOMAS AUDLEY** reputedly Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church, Clonmel, Ireland, but no record has been found. Buried on the 11th August 1844, at St Mary's, Church of Ireland Clonmel (Source: **PR**)
15. {E90} **NO NAME AUDLEY** reputedly Baptised at St Mary's Protestant Church Clonmel, but no record has been found. Buried in August 1839 at St Mary's , Church of Ireland, Clonmel, Co Tipperary. (Source: **PR**)
16. {E91} **MARIANNE AUDLEY** baptised 30th November 1828 at St Mary's, Church of Ireland, Clonmel, co Tipperary *(Comment It is believed that {E91} & {E58} are the same person Baptised as Marianne Audley and Buried as Anne Audley. Her age at Burial fits in closely with the date of her Baptism. {E91} & {E58} have not been combined until {E27}'s origin has been identified.)*

The information regarding the 2nd Battalion of the 12th Regiment of Foot is taken from the following records at the Public Record office at Kew. WO 12/3010; WO 12/3011; WO 12/3012

The following information is taken from the book titled 'History of the 12th (The Suffolk Regiment) 1685 – 1913' by Lieut.-Colonel E.A.H. Webb, (*refers to the Military history of {E8} Samuel Audley (1841 – 1874)*)

On the 1st July 1859, the 2nd Battalion proceeded to Aldershot, and joined the Reserve Brigade and was transferred to the 1st Brigade, under the command of Major-General A. J. Laurence C.B. [*Samuel Audley joined May 1860*]

On the 1st August 1860 the 2nd Battalion proceeded by rail from Aldershot to Portsmouth, where it embarked on board the Troopship "HMS Himalaya" for Plymouth, and disembarked on the 3rd August, furnished a detachment to Bull Point, Devon, and another to Horfield Barracks, Bristol. [*The Regimental Muster book for the period 1st July to 30th September 1860 shows Samuel Audley as being on board ship for 1 day*]

On the 22nd February 1861, Brevet Lieut.-Colonel H.M. Hamilton was promoted to the command of the 2nd Battalion, and Vice Colonel Thomas Brooke to half pay.

The 2nd Battalion was inspected at Plymouth on the 23rd March 1861, by Major-General Hutchinson, who expressed his approbation of their steadiness under arms, and for their clean and soldier like appearance.

On the 3rd April 1861, the Battalion was inspected at the Citadel, Plymouth, by his Royal Highness, the Duke of Cambridge, Commander-in-Chief, who was pleased to express his approval of their soldier like and steady bearing under arms, his remarks on perusing the Confidential Report on the prior inspection were:- "The report on the 2nd Battalion 12th Foot shows a great improvement in every respect and that it is in a most creditable state.

[*On the 7th April 1861, the date of the Census, Samuel Audley was in Hospital. In the period 1st April 1861 to 30th June 1861 he was in hospital for 47 days. During the previous quarter he was in hospital for 8 days according to the*

Regimental Muster Books. It is therefore likely that he was in hospital from 23rd March 1861 to 17th May 1861. It is therefore likely that he missed the above two inspections]

On the 11th August 1861 a letter was received from the Horse Guards directing the 2nd Battalion to be at once divided into Service and Depot Companies, preparatory to the Depot being moved to Chatham, Kent.

On 23rd August 1861, the Headquarters and Right Wing, under the command of Lieutenant.-Colonel Hamilton embarked at Plymouth on the Troopship known as "HMS Megera" and arrived at Cork, Ireland, on the 26th

[The Regimental Muster Books show Samuel Audley being on board ship for three days in the period 1st July to 30th September 1861]

On the following day, the Depot companies, which had been left behind on the departure of the 1st Division, embarked on board the Troopship "HMS Megera" for conveyance to Portsmouth.

On the 3rd September 1861 the Left Wing of the Battalion, under the Command of Major Hibbert, embarked at Plymouth, and arrived in Queenstown, Cork, Ireland, on the evening of the 4th. On the following day the Division was disembarked furnishing detachments to Spike Island, Haulbowline and Fort Elizabeth.

On the 5th November 1861, Lieut.-Colonel E.G. Hibbert succeeded Lieut.-Colonel H.M. Hamilton in Command of the 2nd Battalion, on transfer of the latter to the 1st Battalion.

On the 9th April 1862 a Horse Guards' Circular fixed the establishment of the 2nd Battalion at 10 Service Companies, consisting of 38 Officers, 47 Sergeants (exclusive of schoolmaster), 21 Drummers, and 770 Rank and File.

On the 28th May 1862, the 2nd Battalion marched to the Curragh Camp in Seven Detachments (the last one arriving 9th June) and joined the 1st Brigade under the Command of Brigadier- General the Honourable A.H. Gordon, C.B.

[The Regimental Muster Books show in the period 1st April 1862 to 17th June 1862 that Samuel Audley was on the march for 11 days and billeted on the inhabitants for 9 nights. He was discharged from the Army at the Curragh, Co Kildare, on 18th June 1862.]

{The 2nd Battalion remained at the Curragh until 30th September 1863.}

[At the end of the record for the year 1858 is the following:]

Enlistment at this time was for Ten Years – or Twelve in the case of War – the Recruit received a Bounty of £2, which was increased to £3 later on;

The pay of the Private Soldier was 1 Shilling, per day with an allowance of 1 Penny, per day termed "Liquor Money"; Out of which he paid, 8 Pennies per day for Messing, and Washing, 1 Shilling and 3 Pennies, per month, Sheet Washing 2 Pennies, Hair Cutting 1 Penny, and Barrack damages an average of 4 Pennies per month, The Soldier getting the balance by Daily Payments, which usually came to about 4 Pennies per day if no other necessities were required.



(Comment: The above Census return does not make sense as the Head is aged 35, and yet the Daughter and Son in Law are younger than the Head. It should be noted that in the 1911 Census the family were living at the same address with Barbara Ellen Bain as being the Head. See also the notes under the 1911 Census return.)

1931 Census

The 1931 Census of England was taken 26th April 1931 but was destroyed during WWII

1939 Register of England

The 1939 Register were created in 1939 for the issue of registration documents and ration books shortly after the commencement of World War 2. As they were produced after the start of the war they do not include people who were member of; conscripted into and volunteered for the armed services. Additionally After World War 2 these registers were used as the registration of people into the newly formed National Health Service. These registers were 'updated' by the National Health service until 1991 when the National Health Service Registration was computerised.

The updates made under the National Health Service typically include; changes of surname by Marriage, corrections to Christian names (for example changing initials to full names) and recording the Deaths of individuals listed in the registers. No changes of address are recorded are the Births of new individuals are not recorded.

The records of individuals are either open or closed. Open records can be viewed by the public and Closed records cannot be viewed by the public. Records are open if one of the following conditions applies:

1. The record is open if the person was Born more than 100 years ago. This is the 100 year rule and means that progressively more records will be opened each year until they all become open in 2040.
2. The record is open if the person is deceased and the person's Death is recorded in the registers. In theory this means that the record for anyone listed in the registers and Died before 1991 should be open. However not all Deaths before 1991 were recorded in the registers, and people who were in the armed forces in 1939 are not listed in the registers.

Records that are not open are closed. However members of the public can make requests to the National Archive at Kew to open closed records. To do this they must be able to supply a copy of a Death Certificate and the National Archives must be able to relate this Death Certificate to a particular individual in the 1939 registers. For example the Death Certificate has the address where the individual Died and the 1939 Registers have the address where the individual was living in 1939, so not all requests may be successful.
