Family 1

Note that within this family the surname Addley and Audley appear interchangeable..

{IA1} **MICHAEL AUDLEY** born about 1858 in Belfast (*Based on the 1901 Census of Ireland*) or born about 1861 (*Based on age at Death*). He was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, a Carter, in the 1901 Census of Ireland (*as Michael Audley*). He Died on the 7th December 1903 (*as Michael Addley*) at the Royal Victoria Hospital from injuries received from being run over by a lorry whilst under the influence of drink. An inquest was held into his Death on the 8th December 1903. He

married ELIZABETH (*Lizzie*) ROBINSON. (*Their marriage record has not been identified; her Maiden name has been taken from the registration details of the Birth of her children.*) She was Born about 1862- 1863 in County Down (*according to the 1901 Census of Ireland*); Born 1863- 1864 (*according to the 1911 Census of Ireland*) and living at the same address in 1911 (*as Elizabeth Audley*). She was Born 1871- 1872 (*according to her Burial record*) She Died on the 6th April 1947 aged 75 at the Belfast Auxiliary Hospital in Ballymena. He abode is recorded as 33 City Street, Belfast. She was Buried on the 9th April 1947 at Belfast City Cemetery. (*as Elizabeth Audley*). They had issue: (*Comment: According to the 1911 Census of Ireland Michael & Elizabeth had 9 children 3 of whom had Died prior to 1911. We have managed to identify 8 of these children 2 of whom {IA17} and {IA19} had Died prior to 1911.*)

- 1.) {IA2} **WILLIAM JAMES AUDLEY** born about 1884 in Belfast (*Based on the 1901 Census of Ireland*). He was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, a Labourer on Tramway, in the 1901 Census of Ireland. Of 82, Donegall Road St George's Antrim, a General Labourer in 1911. He Died on the 1st November 1917 aged 32 and Buried on the 4th November 1917 at Belfast City Cemetery. He served in the British Army in WW1, as a Lance Corporal, Service No #64342, and his name is recorded on the Screen Wall at Belfast City Cemetery. He Married on the 30th March 1907 at Richview Presbyterian Church, Donegall Road, Belfast to JOSEPHINE FLORENCE MONTGOMERY. She Died on the 10th January 1965 at 14 Innishowen Drive, Belfast and was Buried on the 12th January 1965 at Belfast City Cemetery. They had issue: (*Comment: According to the 1911 Census of Ireland William & Florence had had 4 Children prior to the 1911 Census 2 of whom had Died. We have identified the two children living at the time of the 1911 Census but not those that had died*)
 - A.) {IA8} **JAMES MONTGOMERY AUDLEY** born on the 29th February 1908 (*as Addley*) at 5 Coolfin Street, Belfast.. Of 82, Donegall Road St George's Antrim in 1911 (*as Audley*). He Died aged 70 on the 5th September 1978 at 121 Kitchener Street, Belfast and was Buried on the 7th September 1978 at Belfast City Cemetery.
 - B.) {IA9} **MARY ELIZABETH ALEXANDRA AUDLEY** born on the 10th May 1910 (*as Addley*) at 63 Donegall Road, Belfast. Of 82, Donegall Road, St George's, Antrim, in 1911 (*as Audley*).
 - C.) {IA10} **JOSEPH HENRY ADDLEY** born on the 25th February 1912 at 82 Donegall Road, Belfast.
 - D.) {IA11} **MARGARET ADDLEY** born on the 1st August 1913 (*as Margaret Addley*) at 10 Morris Place, Belfast She Died on the 23rd September 1914 aged 14 months at 5 Majestic Street, Belfast, and was Buried on the 25th September 1914 (*as Margaret Audley*) in the same grave as her Grandfather, {IA1} Michael Audley.
 - E.) {IA22} **WILLIAM R ADDLEY/AUDLEY** born on the 17th October 1915 at 5 Majestic Street, Belfast (*as William Addley*). He Died as William Audley on 29th December 1988 at 123 Ulsterville Avenue and was Buried on 2nd January 1989, at Roselawn Cemetery, Belfast. He married AGNES ????? She was born about 1923 (*Based on her age at Death*). She Died on the 8th August 2007 at Greenville Manor Nursing home and was Buried on the 11th August 2007 at Roselawn Cemetery, Belfast

- F.) {IA36} **FLORENCE MARGARET AUDLEY** born on the 1st December 1917, in District Belfast No 4, Belfast. County Antrim, at 5, Majestic Street, Belfast.
(*Comment: Her Father William had passed away on the 1st November 1917.*)
- 2.) {IA3} **SARAH ELLEN AUDLEY** born about 1886 in Belfast (*Based on the 1901 Census of Ireland*), 1887 (*Based on 1911 Census of Ireland*). She was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, a Clerk, in the 1901 Census of Ireland. She was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, working in a Handkerchief Warehouse, in the 1911 Census of Ireland.
- 3.) {IA4} **MARGARET (MAGGIE) AUDLEY** born on the 28th April 1889 (*as Margaret Adley*) at 30 City Street, Belfast, She was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, a Scholar, in the 1901 Census of Ireland. She was of 6, Pembroke Street, St Anne's Ward, Antrim, and a Handkerchief Ornamentor, in the 1911 Census of Ireland. In the 1911 Census of Ireland she was living with her Aunt. She Married Michael Clarke on the 14th January 1914, at St Malachy Roman Catholic Church, of Stonalachy, Belfast. (*Comment: as she is described as a Niece in the 1911 Census of Ireland record suggests that there is a relationship with Susanna Finlay the Wife of {IA16} Joseph Addley as the Head of the Family is a Minnie Finlay*).
- A.) {IA21} **MICHAEL AUDLEY** born on the 22nd August 1913 at 33 City Street, Belfast, the Son of {IA4} Margaret, prior to her Marriage.
- 4.) {IA5} **JOSEPH HENRY AUDLEY** born on the 17th December 1891, at 30 Blackstaff Road, Belfast, (*Born as Joseph Henry Addley*) He was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, a Scholar, in the 1901 Census (*as Joseph Henry Audley*). He was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, a Bottle Maker, in the 1911 Census of Ireland (*as Joseph Henry Audley*). He Died on the 11th February 1959 aged 67, at 32 Glenalpin Street Belfast and was Buried on the 13th February 1959 at the Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*) He Married (*as Joseph Audley*) on the 3rd January 1916 at St Aidan's Church in the Diocese of Connor, Belfast to MARY LEE. She was Born about 1894-1895 (*Based on her age at Death*) and Died aged 72 on the 25th April 1967 at 32 Glenalpin Street, Belfast, and was Buried on the 27th April 1967 at Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*)
- A. {IA34} **ROBERT AUDLEY** born on the 11th April 1917, in District Belfast No 4, Belfast. County Antrim. at 22, Wesley Street, Belfast. Living at 66, Greystown Avenue, Belfast when he Died on the 17th June 2006, Aged 89 years, He is believed to have Married to EILEEN ???? in the 1940's, (*details of where and when are presently unknown,*) and had issue. She Died on the 22nd November 2005, Aged 87 years, living at 66, Greystown Avenue, Belfast, and was Interred in Grave no U1877, at Roselawn Municipal Cemetery, Belfast, with her Husband Robert and Daughter {IA35} Mary.
- a.) {IA35} **MARY L AUDLEY** She was born about 1948 (*Based on her age at Death*). She Died on the 20th July 1967, at 66 Greystown Avenue, Belfast and was Buried on the 22nd July 1967 at Roselawn Cemetery, Belfast.
- B. {IA37} **MARY AUDLEY** born on the 21st July 1919, in District Belfast No 4, Belfast. County Antrim at 22, Wesley Street, Belfast.

5.) {IA6} **ROBERT AUDLEY** born on the 22nd April 1894 at 30 Donegal Road, Belfast (*as Robert Addley*). He was of 62, Donegal Road, Belfast Antrim, a Scholar, in the 1901 Census of Ireland (*as Robert Audley*). He was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, a Bottle Sorter, in the 1911 Census of Ireland (*as Robert Audley*). He served during WWI in the British Army, Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, and Service Number #2728. British Army Service Records have him serving at Shankill, Co Antrim, in 1912. He fought at Gallipoli, Italy, and was held as a Prisoner of War in Germany. He had a Brother Charles (*possibly {IA7}*) Charles, he also was a member of the same Regiment, and His service record survives. He Died on the 28th September 1956 aged 62 at 19 City Street, Belfast, and was Buried on the 1st October 1956 at Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*). He married on the 25th December 1914 at St Aidan's Church in the Diocese of Connor, Belfast to SARAH ELIZABETH CROZIER. At the time of their Marriage the Groom is described as a Soldier of Leeman Fort, County Donegal. She Died aged 72, on 4th September 1969 at 28 Albion Street, Belfast and was Buried on the 6th September 1969 at Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*) They had issue. (*Comment: It is impossible with the limited information available to identify exactly who is part of **Family 1** and who is a member of **Family 4**. Please read the note at the beginning of the detailed narrative of Family 4 regarding who Died at 30 Blythe Street, Belfast.*) (*Note that is the abode of the Children's Hospital Falls Road, 30 Blythe Street, Belfast.*)

A.) {IA33} **ROBERT WILLIAM AUDLEY** born on the 7th June 1915 in Belfast and Baptised on the 4th July 1915 at St Anne's Cathedral, Belfast. (*Comment: This information has been taken from his Father's British Army Service Record, and has not been verified from Birth registrations.*) He served in the British Armed Forces with Service No 2276776. (*Note: As of October 2021 his British Armed Forces Service Record was still with the Ministry Of Defence awaiting transfer to 'The National Archive' as a 'Public Record'*)

B.) {IA24} **MALE** (*Stillborn*) Died on the 26th September 1926 at 27 Majestic Street, Belfast and Buried on the 27th September 1926 at Belfast City Cemetery. (*Comment: He is considered to be the Child of {IA6} as in his Burial record he is described as a Child of Robert and Sarah Audley.*)

C.) {IA27} **SARAH ELIZABETH AUDLEY** Died aged 2 years six months on the 27th May 1937 at 30 Blythe Street, Belfast and was Buried on the 29th May 1937 in Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*). (*Comment: It is difficult to identify whether she is the Daughter of {IA6}. Please see the notes after {IA25} and before the detailed narrative of **Family 4**. She has been held in this place until more research information can be identified.*)

D.) {IA25} **WILLIAM ROBERT AUDLEY** Died on the 28th April 1936 aged 3 months at 14 Ashmore Street, and Buried on the 30th April 1936 in Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*). (*Comment: It is uncertain as to whether he is the Son of {IA6} as he is Buried in the same grave as {IA28}.but their home addresses differ. In the grave in which {IA25} William Robert Audley was Buried two people with the surname Hawthorne namely Elizabeth Hawthorne aged 37 and who Died on the 3rd March 1932 and Thomas Hawthorne aged 59 and who Died on the 16th February 1949: both their address are given as 16 Ashmore Street i.e next door to where {IA25} Died;*)

The sequence of Burials in Belfast City Cemetery, Grave D1 18 is as follows:

- 5th March 1932 Elizabeth Hawthorne aged 37, of 16 Ashmore Street
- 30th April 1936 William Robert Audley aged 3 months, of 14 Ashmore Street.
- 29th May 1937 Sarah Elizabeth Audley aged 2 yrs 6 months of 30 Blythe Street
- 20th February 1943 Alice Crozier Audley aged 3 yrs 4 months of 30 Blythe Street
- 16th February 1949 Thomas Hawthorne aged 59 of 16 Ashmore Street
- 14th May 1969 Eliz Audley aged 35 of 30 Blythe Street

(It is 1.6 Miles from Ashmore Street to Blythe Street, being the abode of the Children's Hospital Falls Road, located at 30 Blythe Street, Belfast)

It is therefore considered unlikely that {IA25} is the Son of {IA6} and his details are just held in this place until more research information can be identified.)

E.) {IA28} **ALICE CROZIER AUDLEY** Died on the 18th February 1943, aged 3 years and 4 months at 30 Blythe Street, and Buried on the 20th February 1943 in Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*). (*Comment: She is considered to be the Daughter of {IA6} as her second forename is Crozier the Maiden name of the Wife of {IA6}. Note that the place of abode of 30 Blythe Street is also the place of abode at time of Death for a number of people in **Family 4**, is being the abode of the Children's Hospital Falls Road, Belfast.*) See notes at the beginning of the detailed narrative of **Family 4** and under {IA25}).

6.) {IA7} **CHARLES AUDLEY** born on the 1st March 1897, at 64 Donegal Road Belfast (*as Charles Addley*). He was of 62, Donegall Road, Belfast Antrim, in the 1901 & 1911 Censuses of Ireland (*as Charles Audley*). He served during WWI in the British Army, in the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, Service Number #3060, along with his Brother {IA6} Robert Audley. His service record survives.

7.) {IA19} **HANNAH ADDLEY** born on the 19th September 1899, at 62, Donegall Road, Belfast, and Died on the 19th July 1900 aged 11 months at 62 Donegall Road, Belfast. The informant of her Death was a Robert Todd of 62 Donegall Road, Belfast.

8.) {IA17} **MARY ELIZABETH ADDLEY** born on the 6th November 1901, (*as Mary Elizabeth Addley*) at Belfast. She died on the 16th February 1907, aged 5 at 62 Donegall Road, Belfast. She was Buried (*as Mary Elizabeth Addley*) on the 19th February 1907, in the Belfast City Cemetery in the same grave as her Mother and Father.

Family 2

{IA23} **JOHN ADDLEY** who married, their details of where and when are not known, and had issue.

1. {IA12} **WILLIAM JAMES ADDLEY** born about 1873 (*based on the 1901 Census of Ireland*). He was of 122, Canmore Street, Woodvale Ward, County Antrim, and a Driller in Iron Works in 1901. Of 102, Benthams Street, St George's. County Antrim. A General Labourer in 1911. He died on the 17th September 1924, aged 49, at 176 Utility Street, Belfast, and was Buried on the 19th September 1924, at Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*).

He Married on the 1st June 1891 at St Anne's, Belfast to ELIZABETH McCLEAN (Comment: *Her maiden name in her Marriage Registration is given as McClean, whereas he Maiden name in the registration of her children is recorded as McLean*). She was Born about 1874 in Belfast City. She died on the 14th February 1937, (*as Elizabeth Addley*) at 4 Daphne Street, Belfast, and was Buried on the 16th February 1937, at Belfast City Cemetery (*Glenalina Extension*). They had issue. (*Comment: According to the 1911 Census of Ireland William & Elizabeth had a Child prior to the Census that had Died, this is {IA18}*).

- A.) {IA18} **JOSEPH ADDLEY** born on the 8th October 1893 at 3 Maxwell Place, Belfast. (*as Joseph Addly*) His Birth was registered by a Hannah Addly of 30 Blackstaff Road. He Died on the 12th September 1894, aged 11 months at 34 Eureka Street.
- B.) {IA13} **THOMAS JAMES ADDLEY** born on the 14th May 1892, at 15, Sturgeon Street, Belfast. He was of 122, Canmore Street, Woodvale Ward, County Antrim, in 1901. Of 102, Bentham Street, St George's. County Antrim, a Messenger in 1911.
- C.) {IA14} **LETITIA ADDLEY** born on the 15th August 1895 (*as Letitia Addley*) in Belfast. She was of 122, Canmore Street, Woodvale Ward, County Antrim, in 1901 (*as Letitia Addley*). Of 102, Bentham Street, St George's. County Antrim, A Winder in 1911 (*as Letitia Addley*). She Married (*as Letitia Addley*) to WILLIAM JOHN WALKER on the 28th February 1918, at Ekenhead, Belfast, Northern Ireland.
- D.) {IA15} **ELIZABETH ADDLEY** born on the 1st August 1897 at 11, Bright Street, Belfast. She was of 122, Canmore Street, Woodvale Ward, County Antrim, in 1901. Of 102, Bentham Street, St George's. County Antrim, a Scholar in 1911. She Married ROBERT HECTOR on the 10th November 1921, at St John's Church, Belfast, Northern Ireland..

Family 3

{IA20} **MICHAEL ADLEY/ADDLEY** born 1840- 1841 a Blacksmith. (*Based on his age at Death*). He died on the 15th March 1913, at 51 Lisburn Road (*Belfast City Hospital*) (*as Michael Addley*) and was Buried on the 16th March 1913, at Belfast City Cemetery, Belfast aged 72. The Informant of his Death was his Son Joseph {IA16}. He married HANNAH TOWNLEY. and she Died before 1913?.. They had issue: (*Comment: His surname is recorded as Adley on the Birth Registration of his Son {IA16} and Addley on his Death Registration and the Marriage Registration of his Son {IA16}*.)

1. {IA16} **JOSEPH ADDLEY** born on the 9th May 1864 (*as Joseph Adley*) at 20 Gordon Street, Belfast, or born 1867-1868 (*Based on age in 1901 Census of Ireland*) in Belfast. He was of 6 Watson Street, St Georges Ward, Belfast, and an Iron Driller in 1901. He Married 1st on the 21st September 1895 at Trinity Church, Belfast to SUSANNA FINLAY, who was Born about 1870. It is speculated that she Died on the 6th July 1908 and was Buried on the 9th July 1908 in Belfast City Cemetery in Public Ground as Susan Addley aged 40. (*Comment: This information has been taken from the Cemetery records; no death registration has been found to match this Burial record.*) At the time of her death her abode was recorded as 131 Urney Street. It is believed that he Married 2nd to a SARAH JANE ?????. She was Born about 1871 based on her age at Death. She died on the 11th September 1952 and was Buried on the 12th September 1952, in Dundonald Cemetery, Belfast. The evidence for her being the 2nd

Wife of {IA16} is that she is Buried in the same grave as {IA16} and their Burial records record the same abode, 60 Upper Canning Street, Belfast.

Family 4

The following people in the list are all recorded as having Died at, 30 Blythe Street, being the abode of the Children's Hospital, Falls Road, Belfast.

- 27th May 1937 (IA27} Sarah Elizabeth Audley aged 2yrs 6 months grave D1 18
- 5th July 1937 (IA26} 'Stillborn' (Female) child of William & Elizabeth Audley
- 18th February 1943 {IA28} Alice Crozier Audley aged 3 years 4 months grave D1 18
- 13th September 1948 {IA29} 'Stillborn' (Female) child of William & Elizabeth Audley
- 12th May 1969 Wife of {IA30} Eliz Audley aged 53, grave D1 18

*(Comment: It appears that 'Stillborn' babies were Buried in a 'Public Grave', whereas young children were Buried in private graves. It is speculated that closely related families used the same grave. As for example {IA28} Alice Crozier Audley, her second forename is the maiden name of Sarah Elizabeth Crozier who married {IA6} Robert Audley in December 1914. It therefore makes it difficult with the known information to decide who part of **Family 1** and who is part of **Family 4**.)*

{IA30} **WILLIAM AUDLEY** married ELIZABETH ???? And had issue: It is speculated that she was Born in 1916 and Died on the 12th May 1969 at 30 Blythe Street and was Buried on the 14th May 1969 in Grave D1 18 at Belfast City Cemetery, Glenalina Extension.

1. {IA26} **FEMALE (Stillborn)** Died on the 5th July 1937 at 30 Blythe Street, Belfast and Buried on the 10th July 1937, in Belfast City Cemetery. *(Comment: the Burial record describes her as the child of William & Elizabeth Audley. Note her abode at time of Death is the same as {IA25} & {IA28}.)*
2. {IA29} **FEMALE (Stillborn)** Died on the 13th September 1948 at 30 Blythe Street, Belfast and Buried on the 13th September 1948, at Belfast City Cemetery. *(Comment: the Burial Record describes her as the child of William & Elizabeth Audley Note her abode at time of Death is the same as {IA25} & {IA28}.)*

Family 5
