The earliest members of this **Audley** family were born at Thurleigh in Bedfordshire, Moving to Tempsford and Biggleswade in Bedfordshire. One branch of the family moved via London to Westmoreland and to Clitheroe (*then in Yorkshire*), Skipton and Barnoldswick.

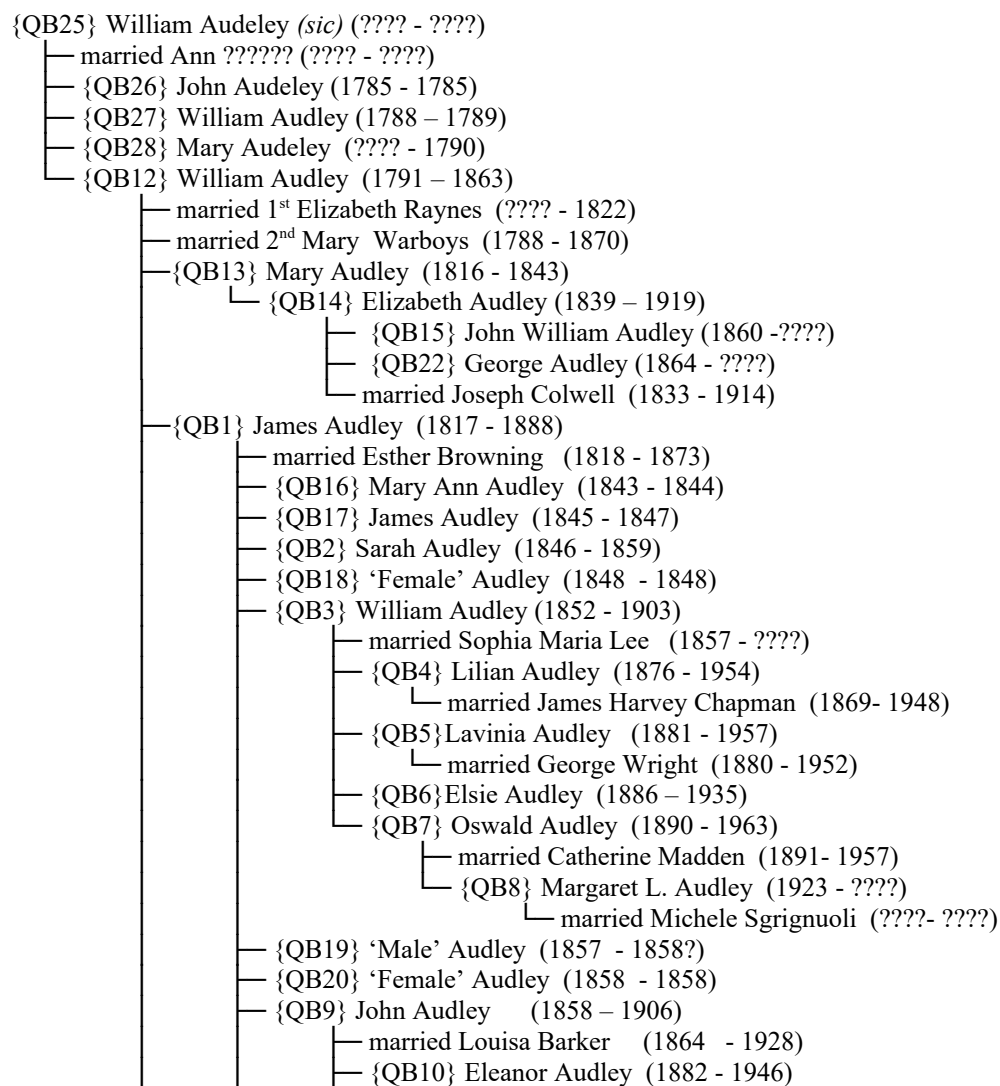
A second branch of Audley moved to Northamptonshire (*in Islip; Fancott; Far Cotton Wellingborough and Northampton.*)

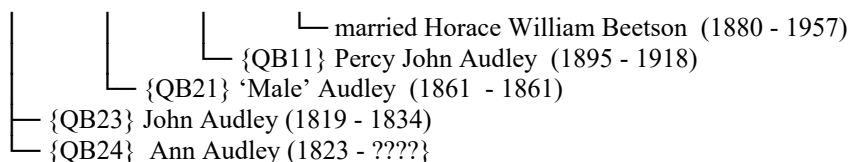

{QB25} **WILLIAM AUDELEY** Married to ANN ????, and had issue.

A) {QB26} **JOHN AUDELEY** Christened on the 13th December 1785, at Thurleigh in Bedfordshire, and was Buried on the 16th December 1785, at Thurleigh in Bedfordshire

B) {QB27} **WILLIAM AUDELEY** Christened on the 6th January 1788, at Thurleigh in Bedfordshire and was Buried on the 12th March 1789, at Thurleigh, in Bedfordshire.

C) {QB28} **MARY AUDELEY** She was Buried on the 25th January 1790, at Thurleigh, in Bedfordshire.

D) {QB12} **WILLIAM AUDLEY**, Christened on the 13th December 1791, at Thurleigh, Bedfordshire. Of Tempsford, Bedfordshire, an Agricultural Labourer in 1841. He was of Langford End, Tempsford, Bedfordshire, an Agricultural Labourer in 1851. In the 1861 Census of England, living at Langford End, Tempsford, Bedfordshire, William, an Agricultural Labourer, and his Wife, Mary are shown as having living with them their Grand Daughter {QB14} Elizabeth Audley, Born about 1840, and also their Great Grand Son {QB15} John Audley Born about 1860. He died Q3 in 1863 aged 70 at Biggleswade. He married firstly to an ELIZABETH RAYNES or BACIS on the 11th January 1815. His 1st Wife, Died and was Buried at Tempsford on the 3rd March 1822. He Married 2nd to a MARY WARBOYS on the 1st July 1822, at Great Barford (4 miles from Tempsford). She died Q1 in 1870, aged 81 years in Biggleswade. By both Marriages he had issue.

(Comment: There appears to be two references to his 1st Marriage one is to an Elizabeth Raynes and the second reference of Marriage is to an Elizabeth Bacis on the same day at the same place. These two references are not understood, but it could be that his 1st Wife was previously married and one reference is to her Birth name and the other is to her Married name.)

I) {QB13} **MARY AUDLEY**, Daughter of {QB12} by his 1st Wife, and Born about 1816. She was of Tempsford, Bedfordshire, in 1841, living with her Father {QB12} William and her Daughter {QB14} Elizabeth in 1841. She was Buried on the 23rd May 1843, aged 27 at Tempsford.

(Comment: The relationship between {QB12} and {QB13} is not certain. It is believed that they are Father and Daughter as they were at the same address in 1841, although there is a slight possibility they are Father and Daughter in Law.)

1) {QB14} **ELIZABETH AUDLEY**, Born Q4 in 1839 at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. Of Tempsford, Bedfordshire in 1841, and living at the same address as her Mother and Grandparents. Of Langford End, Tempsford, Bedfordshire, and living with her Grandparents in 1851 and 1861. In 1861 she is described as a Lace Maker. She Married to a JOSEPH COLWELL, a Railway Labourer, on the 8th May 1870, at St Paul's Church, Parish of Winchmore Hill, Edmonton, London. Of 92 Hut Helm, Ormside, Westmorland (*as Elizabeth Colwall (sic)*) a Railway Labourer's Wife in 1871. Of Rimington near Clitheroe Yorkshire (*as Elizabeth Colwell*) in 1881. Of Higher House, Paythorne near Clitheroe Yorkshire (*as Elizabeth Colwell*) in 1891. Of Hollings, Brogden and Admergill, near Skipton, Yorkshire (*as Elizabeth Colwell*) in 1901. Of Hollins Farm, Brogden, Barnoldswick (*as Elizabeth Colwell*) in 1911. She died Q2 in 1919 aged 80 at Clitheroe. He died Q2 in 1914 aged 81 at Clitheroe.

(Comment:

- *In her Birth registration she is recorded as a Female, with no name recorded. Her Mother's maiden name is not recorded suggesting that she is Illegitimate.*
- *On the Marriage Certificate she gives her Father's name as William although it is more likely that she gave her Grandfather's name as that of her Father.)*

- A) {QB15} **JOHN WILLIAM AUDLEY**, Born Q1 in 1860, at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire, and as a Great Grand Son he was living with {QB12} William Audley, and his Wife, Mary in the 1861 Census of England. He was of 92 Hut Helm, Ormside Westmorland (*as John Colwall (sic)*) in 1871. Of Rimington, near Clitheroe, Yorkshire (*as John Colwell*) a Farmer's Son in 1881. Of Higher House, Paythorne, near Clitheroe, Yorkshire (*as John Colwell*), a Farmer's Son in 1891. Of Hollings, Brogden and Admergill near Skipton, Yorkshire (*as John Wm Colwell*), a Farmer's Son in 1901. Of Hollins Farm, Brogden, Barnoldswick (*as John William Colwell*) in 1911. (*Comments: * In his Birth registration his Mother's maiden name is not recorded suggesting he was Illegitimate. * John William Audley changed his surname to Colwell after his Mother {QB14} Elizabeth, Married Joseph Colwell. It is clear that John William Audley and John Colwell is the same person from the place of Birth being recorded as Templeford in the Censuses of 1901 Census and 1911 Census of England he is recorded as John Wm Colwell and John William Colwell respectively*)
- B) {QB22} **"MALE" AUDLEY (prob GEORGE AUDLEY then GEORGE COLWELL)**, Born Q2 in 1864, at Biggleswade. Of 92 Hut Helm, Ormside, Westmorland in 1871, (*as George Colwell*). Of Rimington, near Clitheroe, Yorkshire, a Farmer's Son in 1881, (*as George Colwell*). (*Comments: * In his Birth registration his Mother's maiden name is not recorded suggesting he was Illegitimate in addition in his Birth registration he is registered as 'Male' Audley. * He probably changed his surname to Colwell after his Mother {QB14} Married a Joseph Colwell. It is believed that George Colwell is the person whose Birth was registered as 'Male' Audley as his place of Birth is recorded as Tempsford in the 1871 and 1881 Censuses of England.*)
- II) {QB1} **JAMES AUDLEY**, The Son of {QB12} by his 1st Wife. Born about 1817 and Christened on the 29th June 1817, at Tempsford. Of Tempsford, Bedfordshire, an Agricultural Labourer in 1841. In 1851, an Agricultural Labourer, living with his family at Langford End, Tempsford, Bedfordshire. In 1861, an Agricultural Labourer living with his family living at Bakers Lane, Tempsford, Bedfordshire. In 1871, he was a Farmer on Farm of 237 acres, and living at Rectory Farm Little, Bedford Road, Tempsford, Bedfordshire. Of Bakers Lane, Tempsford, Bedfordshire an Agricultural Labourer in 1881. He Died Q2 in 1888 aged 71, at Thrapston, Northamptonshire.. He married to ESTHER BROWNING Q2 in 1843, at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. She was born about 1818, based on her age in the 1851 census. She Died Q2 in 1873, aged 55 years at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. They had issue:
- a.) {QB16} **MARY ANN AUDLEY**, Born Q3 in 1843, who Died and was Buried at St Peters Church, Tempsford, Bedfordshire, on the 10th March 1844, aged 7 months. Death was registered at Biggleswade. Bedfordshire.
- b.) {QB17} **JAMES AUDLEY**, Born Q1 in 1845, and Died Q2 in 1847 aged 2, at Biggleswade.
- c.) {QB2} **SARAH AUDLEY**, Born Q3 in 1846, at Biggleswade. Of Langford End, Tempsford, Bedfordshire in 1851. She died Q4 in 1859, aged 13 at Biggleswade.
- d.) {QB18} **"FEMALE" AUDLEY**, Born Q4 in 1848, and Died Q4 in 1848, at Biggleswade. (*Comment; In her Birth registration she is recorded as 'Female' but with no Christian name recorded.*)
- e.) {QB3} **WILLIAM AUDLEY**, Born Q1 in 1852, at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. Of Bakers Lane Tempsford, Bedfordshire, in 1861. In 1871, an Agricultural Labourer, living with his parents at the Rectory Farm, Little Bedford Road, Tempsford, Bedfordshire. In 1881, an Agricultural Labourer, living with his Wife and Daughter Lilian, at Islip, Northampton, and next door to his younger Brother {QB9} John Audley and his Wife. In 1891, a General Labourer living with his Wife, and Family, at Pleasant Row, Islip, Northampton. In 1901, a Horse Keeper, Foundry, living with his Wife, and Son {QB7} Oswald, at Pleasant Row, Islip, Northampton. Married to SOPHIA MARIA LEE, Q4 in 1875, at Thrapston, Northamptonshire. He Died Q2 in 1903, at Thrapston. Northampton, and had issue.

- A.) {QB4} **LILIAN AUDLEY**, Born on the 20th September 1876, at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. Baptised on the 4th March 1877, at the Church of All Saints, Sudborough, Northamptonshire. Of Islip, Northamptonshire in 1881. Of Pleasant Row, Islip, Northamptonshire a General domestic servant in 1891. In 1901, living at 47, Clinton Road, Fancott, Northamptonshire, (*as Lilian Chapman*) with her Husband, Son and also {QB6} Elsie Audley, her Sister as a Visitor. In 1911 at 47, Clinton Road, Far Cotton, Northamptonshire (*as Lilian Chapman*), living with her Husband and Sons. Of 15 Knightley Road, Northampton, Northamptonshire (*as Lilian Chapman*) in 1939. She Died Q2 in 1954, aged 77 years, at Northampton. She married JAMES HARVEY CHAPMAN, in Q3 1895, at Thrapston, Northamptonshire. He was born 9th November 1869 and died Q4 1948 aged 80 in Northampton. They had issue. (*Comment: in the 1939 Registers her date of Birth is given as the 20th September 1877 whereas her Birth was registered Q4 in 1876*)
- B.) {QB5} **LAVINIA AUDLEY**, Born on the 11th June 1881, at Thrapston. Northamptonshire. She was of Pleasant Row Islip, Northamptonshire in 1891. Of Silver Street, Wellingborough, Northamptonshire in 1901 a Domestic Cook. Of Brickyard Cottage, Brigstock, Thrapston, Northamptonshire (*as Lavinia Wright*) in 1911. Of Molesworth, Thrapston, Northamptonshire (*as Lavinia Wright*) a Shopkeeper, in 1921. Of the Post Office Molesworth, Huntingdon R D, Huntingdonshire, a Sub Postmistress in 1939. In 1921 her Sister Elsie was living with {QB5} and her Husband as a visitor. She died Q1 in 1957 (*as Lavinia Wright*) aged 75 at Thrapston Northamptonshire. She married Q2 in 1904, to GEORGE WRIGHT, at Thrapston, Bedfordshire. He was Born on the 6th September 1881 and Died Q3 in 1952 aged 72.
- C.) {QB6} **ELSIE AUDLEY**, Born Q3 in 1886, at Thrapston, Bedfordshire. A General Domestic Servant at a 14 roomed property in 1911, at Queens Park Parade, Northampton. Of Molesworth, Thrapston, Northamptonshire, in 1921. In 1921 she was living with her Sister Lavinia{QB5} and her Sister's Husband. In the 1921 Census of England her occupation is recorded as 'Home Duties'. She Died Q1 in 1935, at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire.
- D) {QB7} **OSWALD AUDLEY**, Born on the 9th October 1890, at Thrapston, Northamptonshire. Of 47, Clinton Road, Far Cotton, Northamptonshire, an Engine Pattern Maker in 1911. Of 67, Midland Road, Wellingborough, an Engineers Pattern Maker, in 1921. Of 121 Alexandra Road, Wellingborough U D, Northamptonshire, a Pattern Maker at Engineers & Iron Foundry in 1939. He Died Q1 in 1963, aged 72 years, at Wellingborough, Married Q2 in 1919, to CATHERINE MADDEN at Northampton. She was Born on the 28th December 1890, and Died Q2 in 1957 aged 66 at Northampton. They had issue.
- 1) {QB8} **MARGARET L AUDLEY**, Born Q1 in 1923, at Wellingborough, Northampton.. Married Q3 in 1949 to MICHELE SGRIGNUOLI, and had issue.
- f.) {QB19} **"MALE" AUDLEY**, Born Q3 in 1857, and Died Q2 in 1858, at Biggleswade. (*Comment: There is a concern with the above information as in the Death registration of {QB19} he is registered as 'Male' Audley with no Christian name and yet the dates suggest he must have been at least 6 months old when he Died, and therefore one would have thought that he would have been given a name. The Death registration Volume and Page numbers are the same as for the Death registration of {QB20}.*)
- g.) {QB20} **"FEMALE" AUDLEY**, Born Q3 in 1858, and Died Q2 in 1858, at Biggleswade. (*Comment: There is concern with the information about {QB20} as from her Birth & Death registrations she appears to have Died before she was Born. Also her Death registration Volume and Page numbers are the same as for the Death registration of {QB19}.*)
- h.) {QB9} **JOHN AUDLEY**, Born Q3 in 1858, at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. Of Bakers Lane Tempsford, Bedfordshire in 1861 In 1871, an Agricultural Labourer, living with his parents at the Rectory Farm Little Bedford Road, Tempsford, Bedfordshire. In 1881, a Gardner living with his Wife, at Islip, Northampton, and next door to his older Brother, {QB3} William Audley and his

Wife. In 1883, living in Thrapston, Northamptonshire, and a 'Porter', (*from the Baptism of {QB10}*). In 1891, a General Labourer living with his Wife, and Daughter Eleanor, at Pleasant Row, Islip, Northampton. In 1901, a Foundry Labourer, living with his Wife, and Son Percy, at Pleasant Row, Islip, Northampton. He Died Q4 in 1906, at Thrapston, Northamptonshire. He Married to LOUISA BARKER, Q3 in 1880, at Thirsk, Yorkshire, She was recorded as a Widow living in Islip, Northampton with her Daughter and Son, in 1911. Of 221 Mill Road, Wellingborough, Northamptonshire living with her daughter and her husband in 1911. They had issue.

(*Comment: In his Birth registration he is registered as 'Male' Audley with no Christian name.*)

- 1) {QB10} **ELEANOR AUDLEY**, Born on the 26th September 1882, at Thrapston, Northamptonshire. Baptised 1st April 1883 at St James Church, Thrapston, Northampton. Of Pleasant Row, Islip, Northamptonshire, in 1891. Of 1911, a Horse Collar Stitcher, living with her Mother and Brother {QB11} Percy at Islip, Thrapston. Of 221 Mill Road, Wellingborough, Northamptonshire (as Eleanor Beeton) in 1921. Of 5 Rock Street, Wellingborough U D, Northamptonshire in 1939. She Died Q1 in 1946, aged 63 years, at Wellingborough, She Married to HORACE WILLIAM BEETSON, Q3 in 1912, at Thrapston, Northampton. He was Born on the 10th November 1880 and Died Q4 in 1957, aged 74 years, at Wellingborough. (*Comment: The 1939 Registers state that she was Born on the 26th September 1881, whereas her Birth was registered Q4 in 1882*)
- 2) {QB11} **PERCY JOHN AUDLEY**, Born Q3 in 1895, at Thrapston, Northamptonshire. In 1911, a Yard Boy at Northants Brewery, living with his Mother and Sister {QB10} Eleanor, at Islip, Thrapston. During World War I, He served in the British Army, in the Northamptonshire Regiment, as a Private, Service No #25177. Campaign Medals Awarded: Victory Medal and British War Medal. He Died whilst serving in the Somme area of France, on the 5th April 1918, His Death is recorded on the Cemetery/Memorial: Panel 54 to 56, POZIERES MEMORIAL, Somme, France.

i.) {QB21} **"MALE" AUDLEY**, Born Q1 in 1861, and Died Q1 1861 at Biggleswade.

III) {QB23} **JOHN AUDLEY** Son of {QB12} by his 1st Wife. Baptised on the 3rd October 1819, at Tempsford, Bedfordshire. He Died aged 15, and was Buried on the 14th December 1834, at St Peter's Church, Tempsford, Bedfordshire.

IV) {QB24} **ANN AUDLEY** Daughter of {QB12} by his 2nd Wife, Baptised either on the 1st or 11th June 1823, at Tempsford, Bedfordshire/

1939 Registers of England

The 1939 Registers were created as the WW2 National Registration on the 29th September 1939

The 1939 Registers were created in 1939 for the issue of registration documents and ration books shortly after the commencement of World War 2. As they were produced after the start of the war they do not include people who were member of; conscripted into and volunteered for the Armed Services. Additionally After World War 2 these registers were used as the registration of people into the newly formed National Health Service. These registers were 'updated' by the National Health Service until 1991 when the National Health Service Registration was computerised. The updates made under the National Health Service typically include; changes of surname by Marriage, corrections to Christian names (for example changing initials to full names) and recording the Deaths of individuals listed in the registers. No changes of address are recorded are the Births of new individuals are not recorded.

The records of individuals are either open or closed. Open records can be viewed by the public and Closed records cannot be viewed by the public. Records are open if one of the following conditions applies:

- * The record is open if the person was born more than 100 years ago. This is the 100 year rule and means that progressively more records will be opened each year until they all become open in 2040.
- * The record is open if the person is deceased and the person's Death is recorded in the registers. In theory this means that the record for anyone listed in the registers and Died before 1991 should be open. However not all deaths before 1991 were recorded in the registers, and people who were in the Armed Forces in 1939 are not listed in the registers.

Records that are not open are closed. However members of the public can make requests to the National Archive at Kew to open closed records. To do this they must be able to supply a copy of a Death Certificate and the National Archives must be able to relate this Death Certificate to a particular individual in the 1939 Registers. For example the Death Certificate has the address where the individual died and the 1939 Registers have the address where the individual was living in 1939 so not all requests may be successful
