James Audley was Born in Great Wakering, Essex, England. The family lived mainly in Chadwell St Mary and Orsett in Essex, England. Other places this family lived were Thurrock & Chelmsford in Essex, and in London. Part of the family emigrated to Ontario, Canada, Separately to this we have added an **Appendix 'A'** Unconnected references to the **Audley** surname, which appears to be interchangeable with flexible spellings of **Audly**, **Adley**, **Awdeley**, in Essex

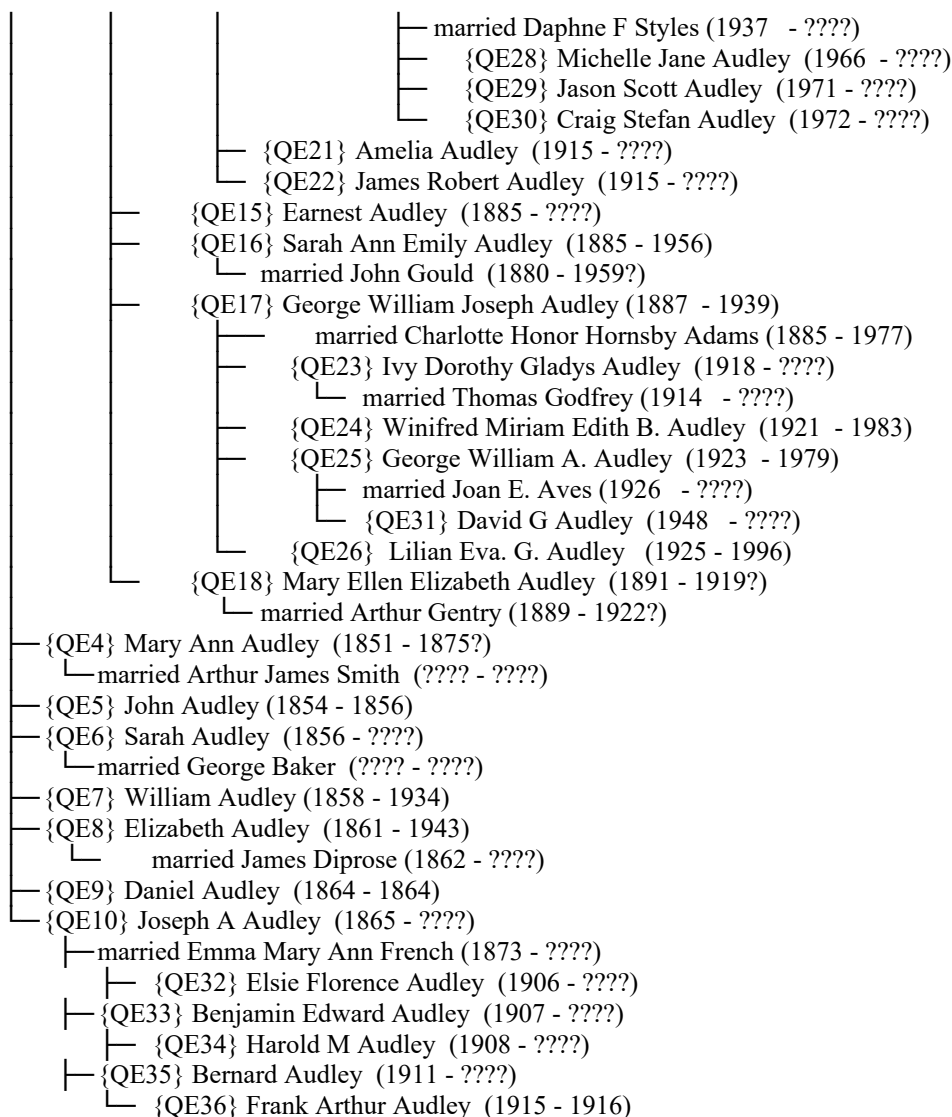

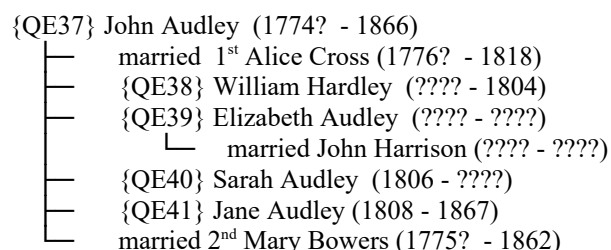

Family 1 of Great Wakering, Chadwell St, & Orsett

{QE1} **JAMES AUDLEY**, born in 1820, in Great Wakering, Essex. Married to **MARY ANN FRENCH**, who was born about 1825, Q2 in 1847, in Orsett in Essex. In the 1841 & 1851 Censuses he is living in Chadwell St Mary, Essex as an Agricultural Labourer. In the 1861 Census he is an Agricultural Labourer living with his family at Plantation House, Chadwell St Mary. In 1871, living with his family at Bagging Heath, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In 1881, living with his

family at Southfield Cottage, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In 1891 still living at Southwell Cottage, Chadwell St Mary, with his Son {QE10} Joseph, and Grand Son's of {QE2} Lydia and {QE3} Robert. In 1901, recorded as a Sexton, Church Officer, and living with some of his family, and Grand Son {QE15} Earnest, A Straw Binder, at Cottage Opposite School, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In the 1911 Census they are living at 1, Bryanstone Road, West Tilbury, Essex, with their Daughter, Elizabeth {QE8}, and her Husband and their family, and James was noted as an Old Age Pensioner. He Died Q1 in 1912 at Orsett, in Essex, aged 92 years. She Died Q4 in 1914, also at Orsett in Essex, aged 88 years, and had issue.

I) {QE2} **LYDIA AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1847, at Orsett in Essex, and Baptised on the 11th July 1847, at St Mary the Virgin Church, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. She Married Q4 in 1865, to FREDERICK GOULD, in Orsett. In 1871 Census noted on "Next Entry" (Dwelling) to her parent's living with her Husband and Family at Bagging Heath, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In 1881, living with her Husband and family at Biggow Row, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. She Died aged 38 years Q3 in 1885, at Orsett, and had issue.

II) {QE3} **ROBERT AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1849, at Chadwell St Mary in Essex, and Baptised, in a Private Baptism, on the 6th May 1849, at St Mary the Virgin Church, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In 1881, an Agricultural Labourer, he was living with his Wife and family in the next cottage to his parent's, Biggow Cottage, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In 1891, an Agricultural Labourer living with his family at Shepherd Cottages, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In 1901, an Agricultural Labourer living with his Wife and family at Hutts House, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In the 1911 Census of England they are living at Chadwell St Mary, Essex, and he was a Labourer on a Farm. Of 2 The Cottage, Chadwell St Mary, Essex a Farm Labourer in 1921. In 1921 he was a Widower and living with his Son, {QE14} James and his family. He Died Q1 in 1935, in Orsett, aged 85 years. He Married Q3 in 1875, to SARAH ANN BENNETT, and Daughter of James Bennett, at Gravesend in Kent, She was Christened on the 27th March 1853 at Shorne, in Kent. She Died Q2 in 1911, in Orsett, aged 58 years. They had issue:

i) {QE11} "**MALE**" - **AUDLEY**, born and Died Q2 in 1878, at Orsett in Essex,

ii) {QE12} **ARTHUR JAMES PUDNEY AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1879, in Orsett in Essex. Of Southfield Cottage, Chadwell, St Mary, Essex in 1881 and 1891..He Died Q1 in 1898 at Billericay in Essex.

iii) {QE13} **AMELIA AUDLEY**, born on the 5th April 1880, in Orsett in Essex. In 1891, living with her Maternal Grand Parent's, at 3, Prospect Cottages, Shorne, Kent. . In 1901, living with her Husband and family at 1, Ivy Cottages, Shorne, Kent. In 1911, living with her Husband and family at Stone Cottages, Lower Shorne, West Gravesend, Kent. Of 40 East Terrace Gravesend M B, Kent in 1939. She died in Q2 1941 aged 61 at Chatham. She married Q1 in 1900, to JOHN JAMES BATCHELOR, in Orsett. 1876. He was born on the 9th February 1876, and he Died Q2 in 1959, aged 84 years, at Dartford, Kent.. They had issue.

iv) {QE14} **JAMES ROBERT AUDLEY**, born on the 4th May 1884, in Orsett in Essex. Of Shepherd's Cottages, Chadwell St Mary , Essex, in 1891.In 1901, a Teamster Agricultural Worker, living with a family of 9 plus a Boarder at Kings Farm Cottage, Shorne, Kent. In the 1911 Census of England, they are living with a Daughter of school age, and of {QE2} Lydia Gould (*nee Audley*), at Sandy Lane, Chadwell St Mary, Near Grays Essex, he was a Horseman on a Farm. During World War I, he served in the British Army, in the Hertfordshire Regiment, as a Private, Service No #269242, also served in the Labour Corps, as a Private, Service No #597416. (*Comment: His service record has been identified based on his name and on the basis that he is not the same person as another person named as James Robert Audley.*) Of 2, The Cottage, Sandy Lane, Chadwell St Mary, Essex, a Horseman, in 1921. He was of 185, Rectory Road, Thurrock U D, Essex a Horseman Carman in 1939. He Died aged 71 years, Q2 in 1955, at Thurrock, Essex, Married 1st to ROSETTA FOWLER Q2 in 1910, at Orsett in Essex, She was Born about 1882, at Whitechapel in London, and she Died Q1 in 1932, aged 48 years at Orsett. He Married 2nd to HARRIETT ALICE RICHARDSON, Q4 in 1932, at Orsett in Essex, and who was Born there on the 12th April 1893. She Died Q2 in 1978 aged 85 years, at Thurrock, Essex (as Alice Brooks). Following the Death of {QE14}, his 2nd Wife married (*as Alice Audley*) Q3 in 1956 at Thurrock to George R Brooks. With his 1st Wife they had issue.

A) {QE19} **ROBERT JAMES W. AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1909, in Orsett in Essex, and Died there Q2 in 1915.

- B) {QE20} **GEORGE JAMES ROBERT AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1912, at St Georges Hanover Square, Marylebone, London. Of 2, The Cottage, Sandy Lane, Chadwell St Mary, Essex, in full time education, in 1921 He Died Q3 in 1939, aged 27 years, at Thurrock in Essex. He Married Q1 in 1935 to GRACE G FOSTER at Orsett in Essex, who was Born on the 16th June 1914, at Orsett. She was of 1 Adams Road, Thurrock U D Essex, Widowed and living with her parents in 1939. his Wife, Grace, Married 2nd Q1 in 1940, to John Lynch, at Thurrock.
- a) {QE27} **ROBERT W. G. AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1937, in Orsett in Essex. He was of 1 Adams Road, Thurrock U D Essex, in 1939. Married to DAPHNE F STYLES Q3 in 1961, at Thurrock, Essex, she was Born Q1 in 1937, at Chelmsford, in Essex, and had issue.
- 1.) {QE28} **MICHELLE JANE AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1966, in Thurrock at Essex.
- 2.) {QE29} **JASON SCOTT AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1971, in Thurrock in Essex.
- 3.) {QE30} **CRAIG STEFAN AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1972, in Thurrock in Essex.
- C) {QE21} **AMELIA AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1915, in Orsett in Essex,
- D) {QE22} **JAMES ROBERT**, born Q2 in 1915, in Orsett in Essex,
- v) {QE15} **EARNEST AUDLEY**, born in 1885, in Chadwell St Mary. In 1901, a Straw Binder, living with his Grand Parents at Cottage Opposite School, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. (*Comment: Notes attributed from 1901 Census of England, and in the 1911 Census of England no trace found, Birth Source.*)
- vi) {QE16} **SARAH ANN EMILY AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1885 in Orsett in Essex. Of Shepherd's Cottages, Chadwell St Mary, Essex, in 1891. In 1911, a Farm Labourer, living with her Husband and family as Inmates in the Orsett Union Workhouse, Orsett, Essex. Of 1 Jubilee Cottage, Chadwell St Mary, Essex, in 1921. She Died Q4 in 1956, aged 71 years, at Thurrock in Essex. Married Q3 in 1903 to JOHN GOULD at Orsett.. Was he born Q3 in 1879 at Orsett, and Died Q4 in 1959, at Thurrock, aged 79 years? They had issue. In the 1921 Census of England he is recorded as
- vii) {QE17} **GEORGE WILLIAM JOSEPH AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1887, in Orsett in Essex. Of Shepherd's Cottages, Chadwell St Mary, in 1891. In the 1911 Census of England he is recorded as a Labourer at Docks, and he also was living with his Parent's at Chadwell St Mary, Essex. Of Bull Sdall (*sic*), Chadwell St Mary, Essex a Labourer at Sewage Works, in 1921. At the time of the 1921 Census of England the Daughter of his Wife from her 1st Marriage was living with them. He died Q1 in 1939 aged 52 years at Romford. He Married to CHARLOTTE HONOR ADAMS, Q4 in 1917, at Orsett, and He later Divorced her, post 1921. She was Born on the 11th February 1885 (*as Charlotte Honor Hornsby*), at Chelmsford, and had previously married John W Adams Q2 in 1914 at Chelmsford., She was of 30 Church Road, Tilbury U D, Essex in 1939. She Died Q4 in 1977, at Thurrock, Essex. They had issue. (*Comment: In the 1939 Registers the Birth date of Charlotte Honor Audley is incorrectly given as 11th February 1886.*)
- A) {QE23} **IVY DOROTHY GLADYS AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1918, in Orsett in Essex. Of Bull Sdall (*sic*), Chadwell St Mary, Essex, in 1921. Married Q4 in 1937, to THOMAS GODFREY, at Orsett in Essex, who was Born in 1914, and had issue.
- B) {QE24} **WINIFRED MIRIAM EDITH B. AUDLEY**, born on the 19th March 1921, in Orsett in Essex. Of Bull Sdall (*sic*), Chadwell St Mary, Essex, in 1921. She Died Q1 in 1983 aged 62 years, at Hackney in London.
- C) {QE25} **GEORGE WILLIAM .A. AUDLEY**, born on the 29th September 1923, in Orsett in Essex. He was of 30, Church Road, Tilbury Thurrock U D, Essex, a Farm Labourer in 1939. He Died Q1 in 1979 at Thurrock. He married Q2 in 1945, to JOAN E. AVES, at Thurrock in Essex, and had issue.,

a) {QE31} **DAVID G AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1948, in Thurrock, Essex.

{D) {QE26} **LILIAN EVA G. AUDLEY**, born on the 3rd October 1925, in Orsett in Essex. She died unmarried in November 1996, aged 71 years, at Southend on Sea.

viii) {QE18} **MARY ELLEN ELIZABETH AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1891 in Chadwell St Mary in Essex. Married Q3 in 1911, to ARTHUR GENTRY at Orsett. Was she the Mary Gentry who Died aged 27 years Q2 in 1919 at Orsett?, and was he the Arthur Gentry who Died Q2 in 1922 aged 36 years at Orsett?>

III) {QE4} **MARY ANN AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1851, at Chadwell St Mary in Essex. In 1871, living at Stile House Farm, Orsett, Essex, as a Servant, to a Farmer and his family. She Married Q3 in 1874, to ARTHUR JAMES SMITH, in Orsett, (*Comment: Was She the Mary Ann Smith who Died Q2 in 1875, aged 23 years, at Orsett?.*)

IV) {QE5} **JOHN AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1854, at Chadwell St Mary in Essex. He Died Q1 in 1856, in Orsett.

V) {QE6} **SARAH AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1856 at Chadwell St Mary in Essex. Of Plantation House, Chadwell St Mary, Essex in 1861. In 1871 she was a Servant, and working for a Grocer and his family living at 6 Hamer Street, "Grocer's Shop", Milton, Gravesend, Kent, She Married Q2 in 1875, to GEORGE BAKER, in Gravesend, Kent.

VI) {QE7} **WILLIAM AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1858, at Chadwell St Mary in Essex, In 1881 living with his parent's as an Agricultural Labourer. In 1891, living as a Lodger at a Cottage, in Sue's Lane, Chadwell St Mary, Essex. In the 1911 Census, He is recorded as a Labourer on Farm, and living with his Brother Robert {QE3}, and his Wife, at Chadwell St Mary. In 1921 he was living with his niece and her family at 1 Jubilee Cottage, Sandy Lane, Chadwell St Mary Essex. In the 1921 census he is described as a Farm Labourer. William Died Q3 in 1934 in Orsett, aged 76 years.

VII) {QE8} **ELIZABETH AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1861, at Chadwell St Mary in Essex. She Married Q1 in 1885, to JAMES DIPROSE, at Orsett. In 1901, a Carman and Coalman, living with his Wife and family at Boston Road, Page Building, West Tilbury, Essex. In the 1911 Census they were living at 1, Bryanstone Road, West Tilbury, Essex, with their 6 children, and also her parents {QE1} James & Mary Ann Audley. James Diprose was a Removal Contractor, and had 4 Sons who were Coalmen. She Died Q2 in 1943, aged 81 years, at Thurrock in Essex, and had issue.

VIII) {QE9} **DANIEL AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1865, at Chadwell St Mary in Essex, and also Died in the same Year Quarter, in Orsett.

IX) {QE10} **JOSEPH A AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1865, at Chadwell St Mary in Essex. He Married on the 26th December 1905, to EMMA MARY ANN FRENCH, Daughter of Daniel French, at St Agnes Church in Southwark, London. In July 1907, Joseph emigrated to Canada landing on the 5th July at Montreal from the Dominion Line "SS Ottawa". In October 1907, Joseph's Wife Elsie emigrated to Canada with their two Children, {QE32} Elsie, and {QE33} Benjamin, landing on the 20th October at Montreal from the Canadian Pacific "SS Lake Manitoba". In 1911, living in the Town of Uxbridge, in Ontario, Canada, and had issue.

a.) {QE32} **ELSIE FLORENCE AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1906, at Orsett, Essex.

b.) {QE33} **BENJAMIN EDWARD AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1907, at Orsett, Essex.

c.) {QE34} **HAROLD M AUDLEY**, born in July 1908, in Uxbridge, Ontario, Canada.

d.) {QE35} **BERNARD AUDLEY**, born in April 1911, in Uxbridge, Ontario, Canada.

e.) {QE36} **FRANK ARTHUR AUDLEY**, born in 1915, and Died aged 1 on the 6th January 1916, at Oshawa, Ontario. Canada.

Family 2 Of Chelmsford Essex, previously of Ipswich, Suffolk

{QE37} **JOHN AUDLEY** He was Born c1774 (*Based on age at Death*) at Ipswich Suffolk (*Based on the 1851 Census of England*) and was Buried on the 31st May 1866 aged 92 at St Mary's Church, Chelmsford, and living at Rainsford Road, at time of Death. He was of Rainsford End a Baker Journeyman in 1841 and 1851. In. 1851 he is described as a Pauper Baker. Of Rainsford Road, Chelmsford in 1861, and described as formerly a Baker. He Married 1st to ALICE CROSS, The place and date of this Marriage has not been identified. She was Born c1776 (*Based on age at Death*) and was Buried on the 24th May 1818 at St Mary's Church, Chelmsford. He Married 2nd on the 31st August 1822 to MARY BOWERS at St Mary's Church Chelmsford. She was born c1775 (*Based on her age at Death*) and died at Chelmsford.

1. {QE38} **WILLIAM HARDLEY** He was Buried on the 25th February 1804, at St Mary' Church, Chelmsford. His Burial is recorded with the surname 'Hardley'. He is recorded as part of this family as Baptism of {QE41} Jane, is also recorded in the name of 'Hardley' and only appears to be two entries in the Chelmsford Parish Registers with the name 'Hardley'.
2. {QE39} **ELIZABETH AUDLEY** It has not been identified when and where she was Born. She Married JOHN HARRISON on the 13th November 1813 at St Mary's Church, Chelmsford. At the time of her Marriage she was a 'Minor' and Married with the consent of her Father. Her Mother was a witness to the Marriage.
3. {QE40} **SARAH AUDLEY** Christened either on the 1st January 1806 or 3rd January 1806. (*Comment: Research websites have given different dates*) at St Mary's Church, Chelmsford.
4. {QE41} **JANE AUDLEY** Born on the 14th May 1808 and Christened 7th July 1808 at St Mary's Church, Chelmsford (*as Jane Hardley*). She was of Chalk's Building, Widford, Chelmsford a Head Seamstress in 1841. Of 5 Cottage Place West, Chelmsford Essex a Seamstress in 1851. Of Rainsford Road Chelmsford in 1861, living with her parents, and no occupation recorded. She was Unmarried, when Buried aged 57 on 28th November 1867, at St Mary's Church, Chelmsford, and living at Rainsford Road, at time of Death.

The 1931 Census of England was taken 26th April 1931 but was destroyed during WWII

1939 Registers Of England

The 1939 Registers were created as the WW2 National Registration on the 29th September 1939

The 1939 Registers were created in 1939 for the issue of registration documents and ration books shortly after the commencement of World War 2. As they were produced after the start of the war they do not include people who were member of; conscripted into and volunteered for the Armed Services. Additionally After World War 2 these registers were used as the registration of people into the newly formed National Health Service. These registers were 'updated' by the National Health Service until 1991 when the National Health Service Registration was computerised.

The updates made under the National Health Service typically include; changes of surname by Marriage, corrections to Christian names (for example changing initials to full names) and recording the Deaths of individuals listed in the registers. No changes of address are recorded are the Births of new individuals are not recorded.

The records of individuals are either open or closed. Open records can be viewed by the public and Closed records cannot be viewed by the public.

Records are open if one of the following conditions applies:

- * The record is open if the person was born more than 100 years ago. This is the 100 year rule and means that progressively more records will be opened each year until they all become open in 2040.
- * The record is open if the person is deceased and the person's Death is recorded in the registers. In theory this means that the record for anyone listed in the registers and Died before 1991 should be open. However not all deaths before 1991 were recorded in the registers, and people who were in the Armed Forces in 1939 are not listed in the registers.

Records that are not open are closed. However members of the public can make requests to the National Archive at Kew to open closed records. To do this they must be able to supply a copy of a Death Certificate and the National Archives must be able to relate this Death Certificate to a particular individual in the 1939 Registers. For example the Death Certificate has the address where the individual died and the 1939 Registers have the address where the individual was living in 1939 so not all requests may be successful
