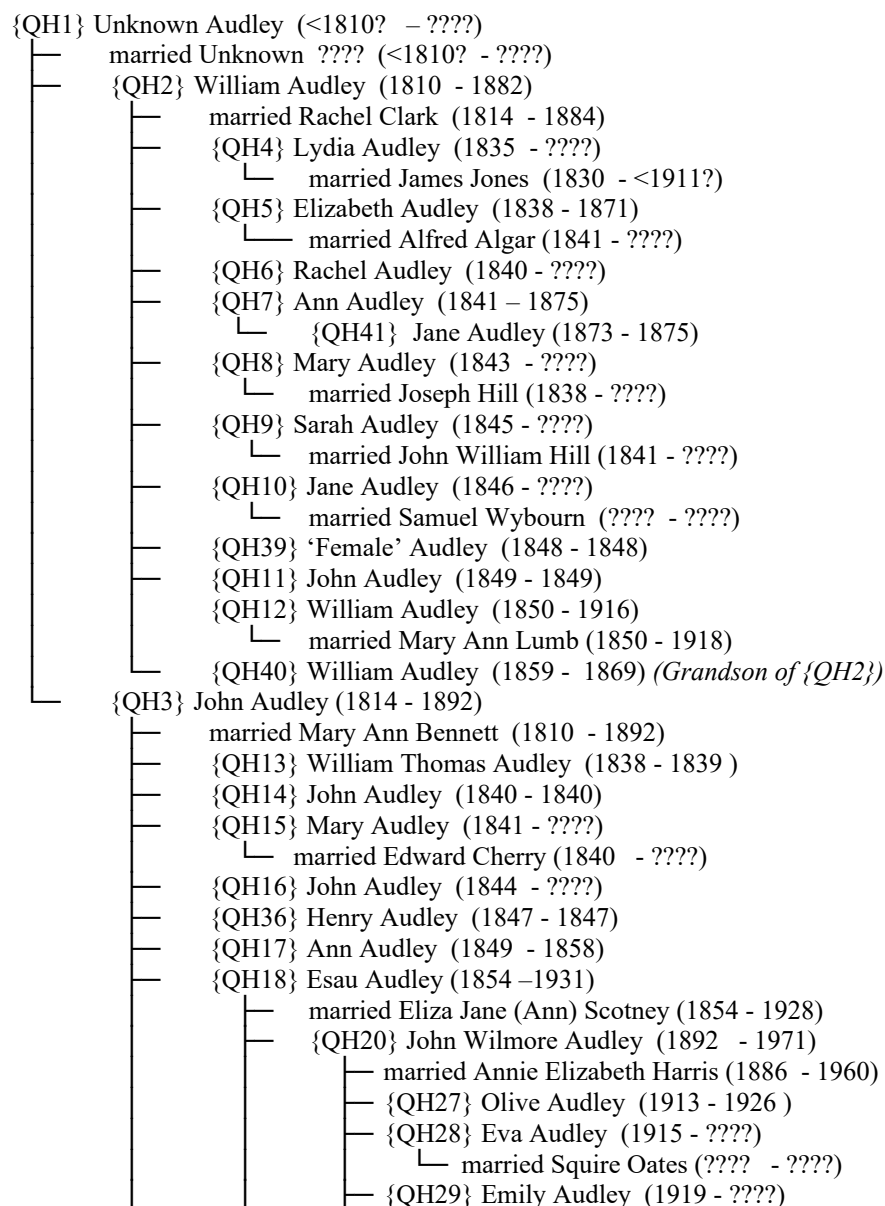
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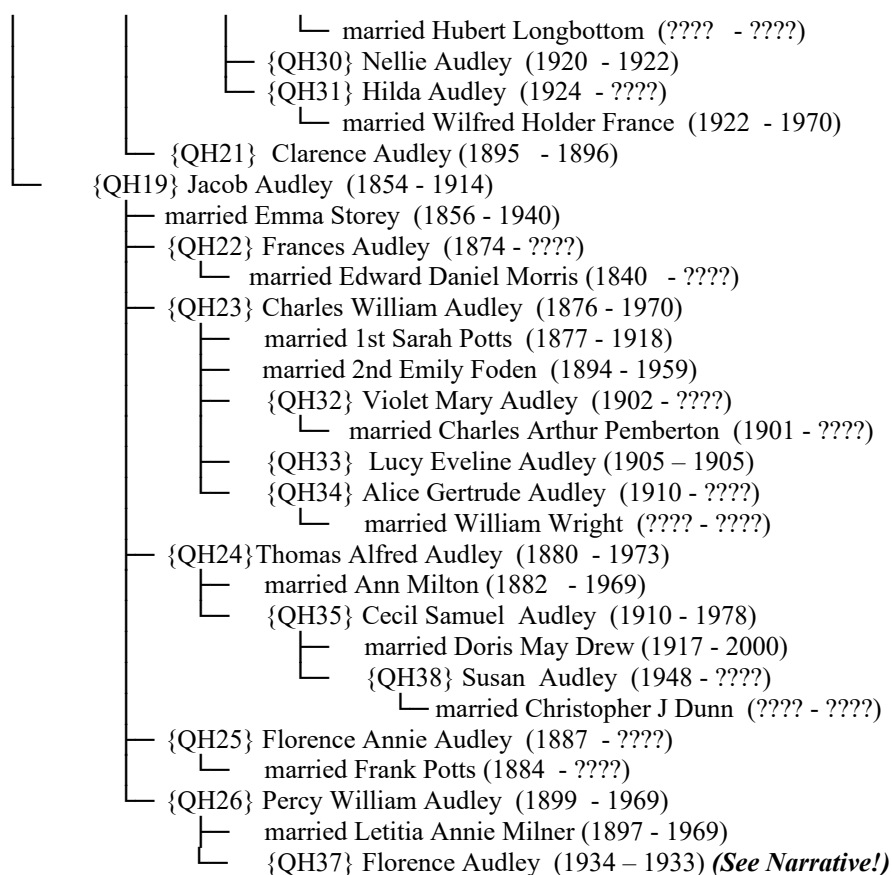

Introduction

The earliest members of this family lived in Buckden , Huntingdonshire, England. Other places they lived in include St Neots, Diddington in Huntingdonshire; London; Chiswick in Middlesex, England. Part of the family moved to Halifax, Mirfield, Dewsbury and Eland in Yorkshire, England. A second part of the family moved to Congleton in Cheshire, England. A third part of the family moved to Biggleswade in Bedfordshire. *(Comment: It should be noted that the 'Audley Family QB' also lived in Biggleswade, Bedfordshire, but no connection has been identified between that family and this family)*

{QH1} **Unknown Audley?**, born before 1810, who Married an Unknown ????, before 1810, and had issue.

I) {QH2} **WILLIAM AUDLEY**, born in 1810, in Buckden, Huntingdon Married to a RACHEL CLARK, possibly in 1834/5?, who was Born in 1814. In the 1841 to 1881 Censuses, William is recorded as an Agricultural Labourer, living with his family at Hardwick, Buckden, Huntingdonshire. Only in the 1881 Census, William's Wife Rachel has an Occupation as a "Lace Maker". He Died Q1 in 1882, at St Neots in Huntingdon, Aged 72 years, and She Died Q2 in 1884, also at St Neots in Huntingdon, aged 70 years, and had issue.

- a.) {QH4} **LYDIA AUDLEY**, born in 1835, in Buckden, Huntingdonshire Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1841; Of Village, Buckworth Huntingdonshire (As Lydia Audly) a General Servant in 1851. Of Fairlawn Villa, Acton Middlesex, (as Lydia Audly) a Cook in 1861. Of 8, Gom??? Place, Albion Road, Hammersmith London, (as Lydia Jones) in 1871. Of 68 Dalling Road, Hammersmith, London (as Lydia Jones) in 1881. Of 2 Glendon Villas, Douglas Road, Long Ditton, Surrey (as Lydia Jones), a 'Monthly Nurse'. She appears to be not living with her Husband in 1891. Of 7 Union Court, Hammersmith London (as Lydia Jones) in 1901 she was living with her Husband. Of Hammersmith Workhouse, Ducane Road, Shepherds Bush (as Lydia Jones, a Widow) in 1911. She Married on the 12th April 1866, at Shepherds Bush St Stephen, at Hammersmith and Fulham, London, to JAMES JONES, Born about 1830, and was a Widower, and Son of James Jones, a Labourer.
- b.) {QH5} **ELIZABETH AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1838, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1841 and 1851 In 1861 living at 11, Park Villas, Hammersmith, London as a Servant. Married Q4 in 1866, in Huntingdon District, to ALFRED ALGAR (*Alger*), who was born Q2 in 1841, in Huntingdon. She Died Q1 in 1871, in Huntingdon, aged 32 years.

- c.) {QH6} **RACHEL AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1840, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1841, & 1851. In 1861 living at Market Place, St Neots, Huntingdonshire, as a House Servant.
- d.) {QH7} **ANN AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1841, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1851. Of Bakers Lane, Buckden, Huntingdonshire, a Nurse in 1871. Died Q4 in 1875 aged 33 years, at St Neot's She was Buried on the 15th November 1875, at St Mary's Church, Buckden, Huntingdonshire on the same date as {QH41} was buried. It is for this reason that {QH7} and {QH41} are believed to be Mother and Daughter.
- 1.) {QH41} **JANE AUDLEY** She was Born Q1 in 1873 at St Neot's and Died Q4 in 1875 at St Neot's She was Buried on the 15th November 1875 at St Mary's Church, Buckden, Huntingdonshire on the same date as {QH7} Ann Audley was Buried. It is for this reason that {QH7} and {QH41} are believed to be Mother and Daughter.
- e.) {QH8} **MARY AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1843, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1851; Married Q3 in 1870, to JOSEPH HILL, in St Neots, who was Born about 1838?, at St Neots, In 1871 living with her Husband at Village Cottage, Diddington, Huntingdonshire. In 1881 living with her Husband and family at Diddington, Huntingdonshire, In 1891 living with her Husband and family, at Diddington Village, Diddington, Huntingdonshire. In 1901, living with his Wife in Diddington, Huntingdonshire, and had issue.
- f.) {QH9} **SARAH AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1845, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1851; & 1861. Married JOHN WILLIAM HILL, Q1 in 1872, at Greenwich, London.
- g.) {QH10} **JANE AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1846, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1841; In 1861 living at Lucks Lane, Buckden, Huntingdonshire as a Servant to a Retired Farmer and his family. In 1871 living at Victoria Lodge, Chiswick, Middlesex, working as a Servant for a Wholesale Shoe Merchant and his family. Married on the 2nd June 1872, to SAMUEL WYBOURN, at Tower Hamlets, in Wapping, London,
- h.) {QH39} **'FEMALE' AUDLEY** born Q1 in 1848, and Died Q4 in 1848, in St Neots, Huntingdon.
- i.) {QH11} **JOHN AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1849, in Buckden, Huntingdon,
(*Comment: Was He the John Audley who Died in Q1 in 1849?>>*)
- j.) {QH12} **WILLIAM AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1850, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Of Hardwick, Buckden Huntingdonshire in 1851 & 1861; Married to MARY ANN LUMB, Q4 in 1880 at Halifax, West Riding, Yorkshire. In 1881, a Carter, living with his Wife at Langdale Street, Elland cum Greetland, Yorkshire. In 1891 still living with his Wife at 9, Langdale Street, Elland cum Greetland. In 1901, a Carter for Plasterer, and living at 10, Beech Street, Elland, Yorkshire. In the 1911 Census they were still living at 10, Beech Street, Elland, West Riding, Yorkshire, William's occupation was a Carter for a General Carrier. He Died Q4 in 1916, at Halifax, aged 66 years. She was Born about 1850, at Tonks, Elland, Yorkshire, and Died Q1 in 1918, aged 68 years, at Halifax. (*Comment: No issue found, in the 1911 Census of England, it had recorded "No Children" Alive/Dead*)
- A.) {QH40} **WILLIAM AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1859, at St Neots, Of Hardwick, Buckden, Huntingdonshire in 1861. He died Q4 in 1869, at Huntingdon. (*Comment: The parentage of {QH40} William Audley is unknown, the Mother's Maiden name is not stated in the official GRO Index records. However it is known he is the Grandson of {QH2}*)
- II) {QH3} **JOHN AUDLEY**, born about 1814, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Married to a MARY ANN BENNETT Q2 in 1840? who was Born in 1810. (*Comment: In the various Censuses of England Mary Ann's age is described between 5years and 8years older?*). In the 1841 to 1881 Censuses, John's occupation is noted as an Agricultural Labourer, and from 1851 living with his family at Buckden, Huntingdonshire.. In the 1891 Census, their Occupation was described as "Living on Charity" at the Alms Houses, in Buckden, Huntingdonshire.. He Died Q4 in 1892, at St Neots, Huntingdon, aged 78 years. She Died Q1 in 1892, at St Neots. Huntingdon, aged 82 years, and had issue.

- a.) {QH13} **WILLIAM THOMAS AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1838, in Buckden, Huntingdon, and Died Q3 in 1839, in St Neots.
 - b.) {QH14} **JOHN AUDLEY**, born and Died, Q2 in 1840, in St Neots, Huntingdon.
 - c.) {QH15} **MARY AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1841, in Buckden, Huntingdon. Married Q1 in 1868, to **EDWARD CHERRY**, in St Neots, Of Hardwick Lane, Buckden, Huntingdonshire in 1861. In 1871 living at High Street, Buckden, Huntingdonshire with her Husband and family. In 1881, 1891, 1901 & 1911, Censuses of England, living with her Husband and family at Hardwick, Buckden, Huntingdonshire, and had issue.
 - d.) {QH16} **JOHN AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1844, in Buckden, Huntingdon.
 - e.) {QH36} **HENRY AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1847, and Died, Q4 in 1847, in St Neots, Huntingdon.
 - f.) {QH17} **ANN AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1849 in Buckden, Huntingdon. She Died Q3 in 1858, aged 10 years at Huntingdon.
 - g.) {QH18} **ESAU AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1854, in Buckden, Huntingdon. A Twin with his Brother {QH19}. Of Hardwick, Buckden, Huntingdonshire in 1871. In 1881 he was living with his parent's and a Gardeners' Labourer. His Son's {QH20} & {QH21} John and Clarence in 1892 & 1895 Baptism records noted, he was a Farm Labourer and living at 25, Quebec Street, Elland, Yorkshire. In 1901, a Brickyard Labourer living with his Wife and family at 25, Quebec Street, Elland, Yorkshire. In the 1911 Census, a Market Gardner, they were still living at 25, Quebec Street, Elland, West Riding, Yorkshire. Of 25, Quebec Street, Elland, Yorkshire, a Labourer in 1921. He Died Q4 in 1931, aged 77 years, in Halifax. He Married Q4 in 1882, to **ELIZA JANE SCOTNEY**, in St Neots, who was born about 1854/5. She Died Q2 in 1928, in Halifax, aged 73 years. They had issue
- A) {QH20} **JOHN WILMORE AUDLEY**, born on the 9th March 1892, and he was Christened in St Mary the Virgin Church, Elland, Halifax, on the 5th June 1892. At the time of his Christening he was living in Quebec Street, Elland. In the 1911 Census of England he was recorded as living with his parents at 25, Quebec Street, Elland, West Riding, Yorkshire, his occupation was noted as Worsted Combing. Of 157 North Road, Ravensthorpe, Mirfield, Yorkshire, a Railway Lamp man, with The Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway (L & YR) in 1921. He was of 20, Wilson Avenue, Mirfield, West Riding of Yorkshire, a Railway Parcel Porter in 1939. He Died Q3 in 1971 in Dewsbury, West Yorkshire, He Married on the 2nd November 1912, to **ANNIE ELIZABETH HARRIS**, at St Mary the Virgin Church, Elland, Halifax. He was still living at family home of 25 Quebec Street, Elland when he married. She was Born on the 1st March 1886 and Died Q2 in 1960 in the Spen Valley, Yorkshire aged 74. They had issue.
- a) {QH27} **OLIVE AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1913, in Halifax, Yorkshire. Of 157 North Road, Ravensthorpe, Mirfield, Yorkshire, in Full Time Education in 1921. She Died Q3 in 1926, in Dewsbury, Yorkshire, aged 13 years.
 - b) {QH28} **EVA AUDLEY**, born Q3 in 1915, in Dewsbury, Yorkshire. Of 157 North Road, Ravensthorpe, Mirfield, Yorkshire, in Full Time Education in 1921. Married Q3 in 1936, to **SQUIRE OATES**, in Halifax, Yorkshire, and had issue.
 - c) {QH29} **EMILY AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1919, in Dewsbury, Yorkshire. Of 157 North Road, Ravensthorpe, Mirfield, Yorkshire, in 1921. Married Q3 in 1940, to **HUBERT LONGBOTTOM**, in Spen Valley District, West Yorkshire, and had issue.
 - d) {QH30} **NELLIE AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1920, in Dewsbury, West Yorkshire. Of 157 North Road, Ravensthorpe, Mirfield, Yorkshire, in 1921. She Died Q1 in 1922, in Dewsbury, West Yorkshire.

- e) {QH31} **HILDA AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1924, in Dewsbury, West Yorkshire. Married Q4 in 1942, to WILFRID HOLDER FRANCE, in Spen Valley District, West Yorkshire, and had issue.

- B) {QH21} **CLARENCE AUDLEY**, born on the 18th December 1894, at Halifax, Yorkshire, he was Baptised in St Mary the Virgin Church, Elland, Halifax on the 14th April 1895,. His abode at the time of his Christening was 25 Quebec Street, Elland. He Died Q1 in 1896, at Halifax, Yorkshire.

- h.) {QH19} **JACOB AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1854, in Buckden, Huntingdon. A Twin with his Brother {QH18}. Of Hardwick, Buckden, Huntingdonshire in 1861. In 1871 Census of England noted on the "Next Entry" (*Dwelling*), to his Sister {QH8} Mary, he was working as a Groom and living at Village Cottage, Diddington, Huntingdonshire. In the 1881, 1891, & 1911 Censuses they were recorded as living with his Wife and some family members at Lucks Lane, Buckden, Huntingdonshire. His occupation was noted as a Farm Labourer, (*except the 1891 Census where he was recorded as Grocer Domestic??*), and she was a Laundress. He Died Q1 in 1914, in St Neots, aged 60 years,. He Married EMMA STOREY, Q4 in 1874, in Huntingdon. She was Born on the 24th April 1856. She was of Cemetery Lane, Buckden, Diddington, St Neots a Widow, in 1921, She was of Hoo Cottages, St Neots R D Huntingdonshire, a Widow in 1939. She Died Q4 in 1940 at St Neot's, Cambridge, aged 84 years, and had issue with their Sons {QH18} Esau Audley and. {QH19} Jacob Audley being Twin Brothers.

- A) {QH22} **FRANCES AUDLEY**, born in 1874, in Brampton, Huntingdon. Married on the 4th July 1897, to EDWARD DANIEL MORRIS, in Holy Trinity, Islington, London. In 1901, living with her Husband and family at 383, Green Lane, Tottenham, London, and had issue.

- B {QH23} **CHARLES WILLIAM AUDLEY**, born on the 27th December 1876, at Buckden, Huntingdon. In 1891, living as a Boarder, with the Publican's family of the Globe Inn, Barham, Huntingdonshire, and described as an Errand Boy. In 1901, a Groom, living with his Wife and her parents at Beamish Lane, Lower Withington, Cheshire. Of Davidsons Yard, West Street, Congleton, Cheshire, a Coachman (*Chauffer*) living with his 1st Wife and family in 1911. During World War I, he Enlisted on the 11th December 1915, in the British Army, Royal Army Service Corps, as a Private, Service No #M2/191107, and also served in the Motor Transport, as a Private, Service No #M2/191107. He is believed to have served Overseas, and was Discharged from British Army Service on the 14th January 1919. Reason given for discharge: 'Discharged on medical grounds having been taken seriously ill/sickness'. He was Awarded Silver War Badge. (*Comment: This Army Service Record has been attributed and identified based on his name only*). Of 13 Priestly Fields, Congleton, Cheshire, an out of work Motor Driver and Disabled Soldier in 1921. Of 13 Priestly Fields, Congleton M B, Cheshire a Chauffer (*Disabled*) in 1939. He Married 1st Q4 in 1900 to SARAH POTTS at Chelford, St John the Evangelist, in Cheshire. Sarah was Born Q1 in 1877 at Macclesfield and Died Q2 in 1918 aged 41 at Congleton, and had issue. He Married 2nd on the 15th April 1922, to EMILY FODEN at Congleton, St James. She was Born on the 24th April 1894. Emily passed away in Q4 in 1959, at Congleton, and Charles William who Died Q2 in 1970, at Congleton, and had issue. (*Comment. In the 1939 Registers his Birth date is given as 25th December 1876.*)
 - a) {QH32} **VIOLET MARY AUDLEY**, born Q2 in 1902, at Alderley (Siddington). Of Davidsons Yard, West Street, Congleton, Cheshire, in 1911. Of 13 Priestly Fields, Congleton, Cheshire, a Button Machinist, in 1921. Married on the 25th February 1922, at St Peter's Church, Congleton, Cheshire, to CHARLES ARTHUR PEMBERTON, aged 21, Son of Charles Pemberton, and had issue.

 - b) {QH33} **LUCY EVELINE AUDLEY**, Daughter of {QH23} by his 1st Wife. She was Born Q4 in 1905, at Congleton, Cheshire, and was Christened on the 21st October 1905. On her Christening record her abode is given as Davidsons Yard She died Q4 in 1905, at Congleton, Cheshire. And was Buried on the 24th October 1905 aged 1 month at St Peter's Church, Congleton.

- c) {QH34} **ALICE GERTRUDE AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1910, at Congleton. Of Davidsons Yard, West Street, Congleton, Cheshire, in 1911. Of 13 Priestly Fields, Congleton, Cheshire, in Full Time Education, in 1921. Married Q3 in 1936, at Congleton, St Peter to WILLIAM WRIGHT, and had issue.

- D) {QH24} **THOMAS ALFRED AUDLEY**, born on the 26th December 1880, in St Neots, Huntingdon. In 1901, a Waiter, living as a Boarder with a family of 7, at 34, Mayton Street, Islington, London. In the 1911 Census, a Railway Platelayer, and they were recorded as living at Shortmead Street, Biggleswade, Bedford, with his Mother in Law, and a Female General Domestic Servant. Of 30 Shortmead Street, Biggleswade, a Railway Platelayer with the Great Northern Railway in 1921. Of 30, Shortmead Street, Biggleswade U D, Bedfordshire a Railway Permanent Way Length man in 1939. He died Q1 in 1973, aged 92 years in Bedford. He Married Q4 in 1909, to ANN MILTON, in Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. She was Born on the 22nd October 1879, and Died Q3 in 1969, aged 90 years, at Biggleswade. They had issue.
 - a) {QH35} **CECIL SAMUEL AUDLEY**, born on the 3rd October 1910, in Biggleswade, Bedford. Of Shortmead Street, Biggleswade, Bedfordshire in 1911. Of 30, Shortmead Street, Biggleswade, in full time education in 1921. Of 25, Banks Road, Biggleswade U D Bedfordshire a Printers Machine Minder in 1939. During WWII he served in the British Armed Forces with Service Number 13070470. He Died Q1 in 1978. He Married to DORIS MAY DREW Q4 in 1938, at Biggleswade; she was Born on the 27th May 1917 and Died in March 2000 aged 82 at Hitchin & Stevenage, Hertfordshire. They had issue.

 - I) {QH38} **SUSAN AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1948, in Biggleswade, Bedford. Married to CHRISTOPHER J DUNN, Q3 in 1972, at Biggleswade, Bedford.

- E) {QH25} **FLORENCE ANNIE AUDLEY**, born Q4 in 1887, in St Neots, Huntingdon. In 1901, living with her parent's {QH19} Jacob, but has been recorded as a "Daughter in Law", rather than "Daughter", though only 13 years old. In the 1911 Census she is living at High House, South Weald Brentwood, Essex, and her occupation is noted as Domestic Cook in a 9 roomed house. Married Q3 in 1919, to FRANK POTTS, at Chelford St John, in Macclesfield, Cheshire, and had issue.

- F) {QH26} **PERCY WILLIAM AUDLEY**, born on the 8th October 1899, in St Neots, Huntingdon. In the 1911 Census of England he is recorded living with his Parents {QH19}, aged 12 years, at Lucks Lane, Buckden, During World War I he served in the British Army, 3rd London Regiment, as a Private, Service No #254488. *(This person's service record has been identified based on his name)* He was of Cemetery Lane, Buckden, Diddington, St Neots, Huntingdonshire, a Farm Labourer, in 1921. He was of Hoo Cottages, St Neots R D, Huntingdonshire, an Agricultural Labourer in 1939. He was Cremated on the 23rd June 1969, at Cambridge Crematorium, Cambridge, He Married Q4 in 1924, to LETITIA ANNIE MILNER, at St Neots, Huntingdon. She was Born on the 27th September 1897 and Cremated on the 1st December 1969, at Cambridge Crematorium, Cambridge, and had issue.
 - a) {QH37} **FLORENCE AUDLEY**, born Q1 in 1934 in St Neots, Huntingdon.. Died Q4 in 1933, in St Neots. *(Comment: It is tempting to suggest that this is the same Florence that Died Q4 in 1933. There are no other Florence's Born in the area at that time who died aged 0.)*

1939 Registers of England

The 1939 Registers were created in 1939 for the issue of registration documents and ration books shortly after the commencement of World War 2. As they were produced after the start of the war they do not include people who were member of; conscripted into and volunteered for the Armed Services. Additionally After World War 2 these registers were used as the registration of people into the newly formed National Health Service. These registers were 'updated' by the National Health Service until 1991 when the National Health Service Registration was computerised.

The updates made under the National Health Service typically include; changes of surname by Marriage, corrections to Christian names (for example changing initials to full names) and recording the Deaths of individuals listed in the registers. No changes of address are recorded are the Births of new individuals are not recorded.

The records of individuals are either open or closed. Open records can be viewed by the public and Closed records cannot be viewed by the public. Records are open if one of the following conditions applies:

- * The record is open if the person was born more than 100 years ago. This is the 100 year rule and means that progressively more records will be opened each year until they all become open in 2040.
- * The record is open if the person is deceased and the person's Death is recorded in the registers. In theory this means that the record for anyone listed in the registers and Died before 1991 should be open. However not all deaths before 1991 were recorded in the registers, and people who were in the Armed Forces in 1939 are not listed in the registers.

Records that are not open are closed. However members of the public can make requests to the National Archive at Kew to open closed records. To do this they must be able to supply a copy of a Death Certificate and the National Archives must be able to relate this Death Certificate to a particular individual in the 1939 Registers. For example the Death Certificate has the address where the individual died and the 1939 Registers have the address where the individual was living in 1939 so not all requests may be successful
