

This is a small family tree consisting of 4 individuals who lived in the Lewisham, Deptford and Tower Hamlets areas of London and briefly of Brighton in Sussex.

Whilst this 'Audley Family SB' narrative is brief, there are other connected and unconnected Audley Family references available for research regards the noted areas above, contained in the Audley Family narratives identified by the alpha letters of 'E', 'F', 'N', 'QH', 'T', 'V', 'UC', 'UE',. In Addition specific references to Audley Families who lived in other areas of London are contained in the Audley Family narratives of, 'G', 'M', 'QB', 'QE', 'R',

Detailed Narrative

{SB1} WILLIAM WADE AUDLEY He was Born 1781 to 82, based on his age at Death. He is described as a Linen Draper in Greenwich, Kent in 1812, from the Baptisms of {SB2} & {SB4}. He is described as a Grocer, of Old Street in 1814, from the Baptism of {SB6}. He is described as a Wool Stapler of Charterhouse Lane in 1816, from the baptism of {SB7}. He is described, in 1819, as a Green Grocer from the Baptism of {SB2}, and living at Seymour Street, St Pancras, London. He is described, in 1821, as a Beadle of Johnson Street in the Baptism of {SB5} He was declared bankrupt (as Wade Audley) on the 6th January 1830, and described as a Victualler, Dealer and Chapman, in No 29 Grafton Street East, Middlesex in 1830. According to Robson's London Street Directory of 1830, he was living at London University Hotel, 29 Grafton Street, East, Tottenham Court Road. He Died and was Buried at St Mark's Church, Kennington on the 6th September 1830 aged 48. He married JANE TURTILL on the 1st September 1807, at Christ Church Southwark. In their Marriage record he is described as of the Parish of St Andrew's, Holborn, London Esquire. She Died and was Buried on the 7th May 1841, at St Giles' Church, Camberwell, London. Her abode on the burial register is Grove Lane, which is the same address that {SB2} gave for his abode at the time of his marriage.

- 1. {SB3} **JANE ANN AUDLEY** She was Born on the 10th December 1809, and Baptised on the 19th July 1812 at St Alfege Church, Greenwich, Kent. (Comment: It is believed that she was a witness to the marriage of {SB2} Alfred Audley in 1841.)
- 2. {SB4} MATILDA AUDLEY She was Born on the 27th June 1812, and Baptised on the 19th July 1812 at St Alfege Church, Greenwich, Kent. Of 4 Warwick Place, St Giles, Camberwell, a Family Servant in 1841. In 1841 she was living at the same address as her Sister {SB7}. Of 2, Waterloo Cottage.,Tormoham, (*Torquay*) Devon a Lodging House Keeper in 1851. In 1851 she was living with her Sister {SB7} Of 11 Crawley Street, St Pancras, with no occupation in 1861. In 1861 she appears to be living at a Decorators shop which was occupied by four families. Of Camberwell House Lunatic Asylum, Camberwell, Surrey with no occupation (*as Matilda Addley*) in 1871. She Died Q1 in 1878 at Wandsworth and was Buried on the 21st February 1878 at Newham.
- 3. {SB6} **WILLIAM TURTILL AUDLEY** He was Born on the 11th October 1813 and Baptised on the 4th March 1814, At St Luke's Church, Finsbury, Old Street, Islington. At the time of his baptism he was living at Old Street He Died on the 11th November 1814, and was Buried at the Bunhill Fields Burial Ground, City Road, London aged 1 year. At the time of his death his abode is given as Old Street.
- 4. {SB7} **EMMA AUDLEY** Baptised on the 25th February 1816 at St Sepulchre's-without-Newgate, Church, London. At the time of her Baptism she was living at Charterhouse Lane. In 1841 she was living at the same address as her Sister {SB4}. Of 2, Waterloo Cottage, Tormoham, (*Torquay*) Devon, no occupation recorded in 1851. In 1851 she was living with her Sister {SB4}. She Died Q4 in 1851 aged 31, at Newton Abbot, and was Buried in the Parish of Upton, Devon on the 25th October 1851 aged 24 (*sic*)
- 5. {SB2} ALFRED AUDLEY He was Christened on the 21st November 1819 at Old Church, St Pancras, London Of 28, Fort Street, Borough of the Tower Hamlets in the Liberty of the Old Artillery Ground. A Labourer in 1841. Of 3 Baker Street, London Road, Brighton, Sussex a Railway Clerk in 1851. Of 13, Frances Street North, Deptford St Paul, Kent a Locomotive Foreman in 1861. Of 23, Strickland Street, St Paul's Church, Deptford, London. A Locomotive Inspector in 1871. Of 13 Batsford Road, St Paul, Deptford, Greenwich, Kent, a Railway Loco Inspector in 1881. Of 11, Ruthin Street, Lewisham, London, a retired Locomotive Inspector in 1891. Of 126, Brookdale Road, Lewisham, London, living on own means in 1901. He Died in May 1905, aged 84 at Lewisham. And was Buried on the 27th May 1905 at Brockley & Ladywell Cemeteries, Lewisham, London in the same grave as his Wife. His abode at the time of his Death is given as 64 Albacore-Crescent, Catford, Kent. Probate was granted 5th June 1905 to Walter Fred Boucher a Commercial Clerk. He married MARY ANN

FISHER on the 25th December 1841, at St George's Church, Camberwell, London. She was Born about 1818 and Died on the 16th December1901, and was Buried on the 21st December 1901, aged 83 at Brockley & Ladywell Cemeteries, Lewisham, London

(Comments:

Whilst they did not have issue, they appear to have had their Niece living with them from being about 14 months old in 1851 to 1871 and in 1901 their Great Niece was living with them. It is therefore concluded that this branch of the Audley Family died out in 1905 as the great niece was blood relation to the Wife of {SB2} and not {SB2} Alfred Audley.

On his Marriage Certificate his Father is recorded as 'Wade Audley', and on his Baptism record his Father is recorded as William Audley; on his Father's Marriage record he is recorded as 'William Wade Audley').

{SB5} **DORINDA AUDLEY** (*sic*) She was Born on the 10th October 1821, and Baptised on the 7th November 1821, at St Pancras Old Church, her abode at the time of her Baptism is Johnson Street, St Pancras. (*Comment; There is some uncertainty of her name as the Parish Register is so Feint*)

Appendix 1 Who are Diana Price, Maud M Rose and Alice Rose

The aim of this appendix is to identify:

- Who was Diana Price who was living with {SB2} Alfred Audley and his Wife Mary Ann Audley in the 1851,
 1861 & 1871 Censuses of England and
- Who are Maud M Rose & Alice Rose who were living with {SB2} Alfred Audley and his Wife Mary Ann Audley in the 1901 Census of England.

Information

- 1.) The 1851, 1861 and 1871 Censuses all have Diana Price as having been born in Atherstone, Warwickshire, and probably in the period 1849 to 1850.
- 2.) Her Birth is registered as Dianna Price (with two 'n's') Q1 in 1850 Dianna Price Mother's Maiden name Fisher Atherstone Vol 16 page 247. It should be noted in researching for the marriage record of {SB2} Alfred Audley in the GRO Indexes it was not possible to identify the birth surname of the Wife of {SB2} as there are two brides with the same forenames listed with the same in the GRO Index for the same volume and page number. One of these surnames is Fisher. As Diana Price is recorded in the Censuses as Niece in the censuses it can be concluded that the birth surname of the wife of {SB2} is Fisher.
- 3.) Diana Price married John Rose Q1 in 1876 at Greenwich Vol 1d Page 861. The Marriage took place on the 21st March 1876, at The Church of St John's in the Parish of St John, Deptford, Kent. Diana Price gives her Father's name as John Price a Confectioner and Alfred Audley signs as a witness. This information agrees with the Baptism details of Diana Price that took place on the 3rd February 1850, with Parents John Price a Baker and mother Ellen Price.
- 4,) Maud M Rose was aged 24 in the 1901 Census indicating that she would have been Born 1876 -1877. Her birth was registered Q1 in 1877 as Maud Mary Rose; Mother's Maiden name Price at Greenwich 1d 038. It is therefore highly probable that she was the daughter of the above Diana Price
- 5.) Alice Rose was aged 14 in the 1901 Census indicating that she would have been Born 1886-1778. Her birth was registered Q4 in 1886, Mother's Maiden name Price at Greenwich 1d 977. It is therefore highly probable that she was the daughter of the above Diana Price
- 6.) In the 1891 Census John Rose and Diana Rose neé Price were living at 23 Bolden Street Deptford, Greenwich, (RG12/501/111)/14), with three Daughters and one Son; Maud M Rose (as above) aged 14; Eleanor E Rose, aged 12; John A Rose aged 6, and Alice Rose aged 4 (as above). This Census return confirms that Maud Mary Rose and Alice Rose (both above are the daughters of Diana Rose neé Price.)
- 7.) In the 1901 Census John Rose and Diana Rose neé Price were living at 23 Bolden Street Deptford, Greenwich with one Daughter and one Son namely Eleanor E Rose aged 22, and John A Rose aged 16. Their other two Daughters were living at 126, Brookdale Road, Lewisham with Alfred Audley and his wife. These two addresses appear to be 2 miles apart.

Conclusion

Diana Price, Maud M Rose and Alice Rose, are blood relatives of Mary Ann Audley neé Fisher the Wife of {SA2} Alfred Audley, and do not have any direct connections to the Audley Surname other than through marriage.

To date (September 2023) we have not been able to identify the reason why Diana Price was living with {SA2} Alfred Audley and his Wife Mary Ann Audley neé Fisher in the 1851, 1861 & 1871 Censuses.

To date (September 2023) we have not been able to identify the reason why Maud Mary Rose and Alice Rose were living with {SA2} Alfred Audley and his Wife Mary Ann Audley neé Fisher in the 1891 Census.
