Introduction

With the research information contained within this 'Unconnected' Audley file of Ireland, there are many other connected Audley Family references of Ireland available for research, such as those contained in the Audley Family narratives identified by the alpha letters of 'E' 'F' 'G' 'IA' 'ID' 'IF' 'IR' 'IR' 'IU', see the website Audley Family Trees section.

The purpose of this 'Unconnected Audley's of Ireland, is a List of references to act as a 'holding file' until the individuals in this file can be connected to any of the documented 'Audley Families' or sufficient information has been identified to create a new 'Audley Family'.

(The spelling of the AUDLEY surname appears to be flexible. The spelling mainly appears to be interchangeable with examples:- Adley, Addley, Aidley, Allday, Oddily & Odley and also with other 'close' name variant being spellings.)

In addition to the notes above some of the records contained within this file may match others in the established 'Connected Audley Family files noted above, but due to the often limited information and record gaps, particularly the Irish Chancery records, detailing British rule in Ireland going back to the 14th century and grants of land by the crown, these were also destroyed during the Civil War along with thousands of wills and title deeds. As were the records of various Chief Secretaries to Ireland and centuries of Church of Ireland parish registers lost in the Public Records Office fire on the 30th June 1922 in Dublin. Also a large section of genealogical records were lost such as The Census returns for 1821, 1831, 1841 and 1851 were, for the most part, destroyed in 1922.

Further, whilst we make every effort to ensure accurate transcription, errors exist in both the original registers and can do so in the transcription, Suggest if there is any uncertainty regards the noted research information, then please verify any results, if possible, with information sources other than those noted.
