Replica of Eros

More recent gifts to Liverpool by Mr. Audley was a life-size statue of Adam and Eve by Mr. Arthur G. Walker, of London, and shortly before he was taken all he arranged for the purchase of a replica of London's famous Eros statue and fountain, which he intended should be erected in Sefton Park.

Mr. Audley's numerous benefactions to the city were recognised in 1926 by his unanimous election as a member of the Arts Sub-committee of the Corporation and by his appointment to the Commission of the Peace in 1929. Mr. Audley was a bachelor and resided with his sister. He was chairman of

the Stewart-Jones Children's Evening Homes.
