AUDLEY OF PATRINGTON-IN-HOLDERNESS, CO. YORKS.

This is the only family of Audley I have found in Yorkshire, and its record there extends but to 50 odd years. I have assumed that Richard "Audraye," who died in 1568, was a brother of Christopher Audley, who died in 1585; and that Jennet "Audlad," widow, who died in 1597, was a sister-in-law. This Jennet may, indeed, have been mother to Christopher's brother's daughter, the Bettris Audley of 1585.

There are no entries relating to the Audleys in the Patrington register after 1622, and it would look as if Christopher Audley born 1586, and his son Christopher born 1608, left the parish.
