

This transcript is a copy of the pedigree published in the 'Genealogist' (New Series) xxxvi (pages 9 to 21). This transcript is as close as possible to that in the original [www.audleyfamilyhistory.com](http://www.audleyfamilyhistory.com) article in the Genealogist, however it has been more difficult than normal to produce this transcript as the article in the Genealogist like the original pedigree is written in Latin. Additional comments or additions to make this transcript more readable are added in **blue text**. Tag numbers that are used in Audley Family Z file have been included in **red text**

**A VELLUM PEDIGREE-ROLL OF THE FAMILY OF TOUCHET,  
OF NETHER WHITLEY AND BUGLAWTON, CO CHESTER  
AND TOUCHET, BARON AUDLEY OF HELEIGH, CO STAFFORD**

This pedigree, which was apparently prepared for George, Lord Audley (who was created Earl of Castlehaven in 1616 and died early in the year following) is dated 1597 and is drawn on three large skins of vellum, measuring 8 feet 8 inches in length by 2 feet 4.25 inches in width. The arms are remarkably well painted, and are, perhaps, the work of Ralph Brooke, York Herald, or of Mercury Patten, Bluemantle Pursuivant; unfortunately the pedigree is not signed. There are 116 large heater-shaped shields and one small lozenge, besides a large shield of four quarters of the arms of Touchet of Whitley and a larger shield of sixteen quarters of the arms of Lord Audley.

Beaumont printed the long title at the head of this pedigree-roll, and four generations from the body of it, in his introduction to "Tracts written in the controversy respecting the legitimacy of Amicia (*sic*) daughter of Hugh Cyveliok, Earl of Chester," which were issued by the Chetham Society in 1869.

The original pedigree-roll was lent to me by the late Sir Richard Brooke of Norton in 1877 and I copied the whole of it at that time.

The notes I to VI. Occur in the body of the original pedigree-roll, near to the places marked with these numerals; they have been put together for convenience in printing.

There is a marriage recorded on page 15 which seems to be unknown to genealogists. The second wife of James Audley KG, second Lord Audley (1317-1386) has been stated to have been either Isabel daughter and coheir of William Malbank, usually called Baron of Wich Malbank (which by the dates is of course impossible) or Isabel daughter of Roger Le Strange 5<sup>th</sup> Baron Strange of Knokyn. (See GEC's Complete Peerage, first edition Vol I p 339 and Corrigenda, Vol viii p 289, and second edition Vol I p 339; also *The Genealogist*, OS Vol vi, p 18. But in this pedigree-roll she is called Isabel, daughter of Robert, Lord Fitz-Walter. The Le Strange marriage is not mentioned in *Le Strange Records* by the late Mr Hamon le Strange where on p 323 the fifth Baron Strange is said to have "*m. circa 1350*", which is about the date of the marriage of Isabel to Lord Audley.
