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This is a transcript of part of page 662 of the second edition of 'The History of Cheshire' by G Ormerod and published in 1882. The second edition is known as the Helsby edition. Page 662 contains a Family Tree titled 'Touchet of Nether Whitley and Buglawton' The description for the Family Tree states. 'From the pedigrees of Booth and Sir Peter Leycester (or Leicester), with additions [and corrections], and continued to the present time from the information of the family.' At the end of this statement there is reference to a footnote that states ' The pedigree of this ancient family is given rather as the best that can be procured, and what is most probably correct, than what can be positively depended on. The early generations are proved by deeds in Buglawton and Croxton, and the subsequent ones appear to be more correct than what is given in the printed pedigrees, which omit several descents temp. Hen III, Edw I and II. The documents of the family in the female line do not afford any means of supplying the chasm between 1594 and 1606.

Sir Peter Leycester (or Leicester) 1st Baronet lived 1614 to 1678 and was an antiquarian and historian. His major work was published in 1673 and titled 'Historical antiquities in two books'. It is assumed that the basis of the family tree in 'The History of Cheshire' and transcribed here is based on a family tree in the above publication by Sir Peter Leycester.

I have not identified who the Booth is that is referred to above.





 - I. **{ZT18} SIR JOHN TOCHET**, 23 Edw 3, a distinguished warrior under the Black Prince, contested the manor of Buglawton with Thomas, son of Robert Tochet, 29 Edw 3 Married. **{Z14} JOHANNA**, eldest daughter of James lord Audley and sister and coheiress of Nicholas lord Audley.
 - A. **{ZC1} JOHN TOCHET**, chevalier (baron of Audley 4 Hen 4), made an agreement with Thomas Touchet of Whitley, respecting the manor of Buglawton, 1 Hen 4, Inq. p.m. following year: was ancestor of the TOUCHETS LORDS AUDLEY

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
